Many people left the Palatine States of Germany in the early 1700's due to invasion by the French. Queen Anne (of 3) of England brought the Palatines (over 30,000) to England, Ireland and on to the United States starting in 1710.

PETER ALTHÄUSER (Altheiser, Althuysen) (Althouse)

This later-arriving German was discovered at 5450 Niederbieber (26 km w. of Montabaur; Chbks. begin 1655, Ref.). The grandfather of the emigrant was **Jacob Althäuser** of Rodenbach in the parish of Feldkirchen; he was listed at Rodenbach on a permanent money-interest roll of 1689 (Fürst Wied Archiv File #27-7-2), a guard money list in 1696 (File #27-7-3), and a document which gave him 1 son and 1 daughter in the mid-1690's (#27-7-4). **Wilhelm**, s/o **Jacob Althäuser** at Rodenbach, md. 11 May 1693 **Eva**, wid/o **Hans Peter Michel** at Seg(endorff); **Eva**, d/o the late **Johann Wilhelm Bauer**, had md. 10 Nov 1686 **Hans Peter**, s/o **Theiß Michel** at N. Bieber. **Wilhelm** and **Eva Althäuser** had a son **Johann Peter Althäuser**, bpt. 20 Jan 1695 - sp.: **Johannes Bauer** - brother of the child's mother, **Peter** - s/o **Johannes Mees**, and **Leyß** - d/o **Jacob Honnert**, all at Seg. **Peter Althäuser** md. 29 Jan 1722 **Elisabetha Christina**, wid/o **Johann Wilhelm Mittler**, both from Segendorff.

Peter Althäuser first appeared in American records in 1727, when his daughter **Maria Elisabetha** was bpt. at Kinderhook. **Peter Althausen** first was enrolled on tax rolls in 1728/29 in the north ward of Dutchess Co., N.Y., and his name continued to be entered on the Rhinebeck lists until Feb 1747/48 (Dutchess Co. Tax Lists). The administration papers of a **Peter Althouser** of Livingston's Manor were dated 25 Jan 1783 (*Genealogical Data from Administration Papers*, by Kenneth Scott, p. 6); however, this may not refer to the emigrant **Peter¹ Althäuser**, but instead to his possible son **Peter² (HJ)**. The ch. of **Johann Peter¹ Althäuser** and his 1st wife **Elisabetha Christina** were:

1. **Juliana Elisabetha²**, bpt. 5 Dec 1722 - sp.: **Johann Christ Fischer** and **Juliana Elisabeth Wirtgen** from Seg. (Niederbieber Ref. Chbk.). **Juliana Elisabeth Althausen** joined the Red Hood Luth. Church 13 Jan 1741. She md. **Henrich Meyer** by 1742 (HJ).
2. **Anna Margaretha²**, bpt. 8 Oct 1724 - sp.: **Anna Margreth** - d/o the late **Wilhelm Schaback**, and **Ludwig Mees**, both from Seg. (Niederbieber Ref. Chbk.). One of that name md. **Adam Eckert** by 1743; however, as this **Anna Margaretha** appears not to have joined a N.Y. church in the 1740's as did her sisters, and as I can find no connective sp. in all the bpts. of her ch. with **Adam Eckert** to the emigrant **Peter¹ Althäuser's** family, I believe this 1724 **Anna Margaretha²** may have died young (HJ).

7. **Anna Margaretha²**, b. 1 March 1735 - sp.: Claus Stickel and wife Anna Margaretha (Rhinebeck Luth. Chbk.). She md. **Benjamin Decker** by 1760 (HJ).
8. **Eva Catharina²** (HJ), md. **Jacob Proper** by 1760 (HJ).
9. **Johannes²**, bpt. 19 Aug 1739 - sp.: Johannes Snoek and Mary Keth (Rhinebeck Flats Ref. Chbk.).
10. **Christian²**, bpt. 2 March 1742 - sp.: Johan Christian Loucks and Maria Youngblood (Red Hook Luth. Chbk.). He md. **Elisabetha ...** and had issue bpt. at the Manorton Luth. Church.

ELISABETHA MARGARETHA ANHÄUSER
MARGARETHA ANHÄUSER
(Anheuser, Anhuyzer)

These women originated at 5450 Neuwied in the nearby village of 5450 Rodenbach (2 km. w. of Niederbieber; Entries in registers of Feldkirchen, which are missing). **Elisabeth Margrita Anhouwers** van Niwit joined the N.Y. City Ref. Church 21 Feb 1727; she md. **Johannes Hoffmann** 29 May 1727 (N.Y. City Ref. Chbk.). **Margrita Anhuyzer** of Rodenbag in Niwit joined the N.Y. City Ref. Church 20 Feb 1733. **Margaretha¹** and probably **Elisabetha Margaretha¹ Anhäuser** were undoubtedly related to the **Jacob Anheuser** recorded at Rodenbach in the 1690's with 2 sons and 1 daughter in his household, and who, as a resident of Rodenbach, was enrolled on a guard-money list as Jacob Ahnhäuser in 1696 (Fürstl. Wied Archiv File #27-7-3 & #27-7-4).

FRANZ ANTES
(Anthes, Antheß)

The origins of this man were at 6660 Zweibrücken (7 km. s. of Homburg). A resolution of the Zweibrücken government dated 11 Nov 1758 concerning different district bondsmen who went to America without being manumitted noted that the property of **Franz and Friedrich Antheß** of Ellweiler was to be seized for failing to give notice before emigration ("Eighteenth-Century Emigrants to America From the Duchy of Zweibrücken and the Germersheim District" by Friedrich Krebs, translated and edited by Don Yoder, in *Rhineland Emigrants - Lists of German Settlers in Colonial America*, p. 56). **Franz¹ Antes**, b. at Zweibrücken, md. 26 Feb 1758 **Dorothea Ostermann** (Schoharie Luth. Chbk.). They sp. Hieronymus Weber in 1760 at Loonenburg Luth. Church. Frans Antas was a soldier in 1767 in Lt. John M. Veeder and Ensign Gerret Banker's Co. in the Colony of Rencelarswick (*Report of the State Historian*, Vol. II, p. 818).

(Ebgert, Eggert)

Nicholas Althouse (althooser) was a United Empire Loyalist. He was allowed a farm lot in 1/9/1796. ^{He stated} ~~afterwards~~ ^{stating} (in 10/13/1797) that he joined the British Army at Ft. Montgomery and remained with them during the period of the American Revolutionary War. He sought 200 acres. He was buried Feb 24/1801. Nicholas and his wife, Lucinda, had a daughter, Sydia, died young (buried Oct 7/1803).

Nicholas came to Canada as a "late" Loyalist so wasn't on the U.E.L. list and ^{able to} make a claim. He made the claim ~~for~~ before land in 1796. Hannah Caldwell, daughter of Nicholas, prayed for land as a D.U.E. (Daughter of a United Empire Loyalist) and received 200 acres. She married John Caldwell.
