Peter Dulay (Dulyea) was an Associated Loyalist (U.E.L.) who fought for the British in the American Revolutionary War and migrated to Adolphustown Township, Upper Canada (Ontario) in 1784.

Township #4 was restricted in size by a shoreline of deep bays. The lots were granted to a group of Delancey's Corps under Major Peter Vanalstine. When the townships were named it became Adolphustown. A large section of Adolphustown was added later to the Township of Fredericksburgh. The original survey shows a townsite but like Fredericksburgh it has remained pleasantly rural.

Peter Dulyea^{sr} was a native of France who came to America in 1760 and settled in Bergen County, New Jersey. In 1776, he joined the New Jersey Volunteers to fight for the British in the American Revolutionary War. For this, he lost his farm of 50 acres. He signed up in New York City with Abraham Adyler's Maybe's Company Seven of Associated Loyalists. After the war, he settled in Adolphustown with his three sons, including Peter Dulyea Jr. However, his wife and a daughter who had been listed at Sorel, Quebec never made it to Adolphustown Township, Ontario.

- ① Further research on the above family reveals a Delyea (Dulyea) family file at the County Museum and Archives in Napanee, Ontario. Very small file with the following - Thomas Delyea, Bachelor Farmer, Age 26, Methodist, residing in Barrie Township, Frontenac Co., Ont. The son of Alexander Delyea, a blacksmith and his wife Arvilla (nee Anderson); was married to Alice Benny, the daughter of William Benny and his wife Jane (nee Pipe). They were married at Clinton, Kaladar Township, F. & A. County on 23/apr./1909.
- ② and Frank Delyea - born at Myers Cave in 1879. He was the son of Alexander (Sandy) Delyea, a constable of Kingston Township.
- ③ Also, in this family file is a booklet of about 10 pages entitled "The Descendants of Pierre Delyea (Dulyea)" starts out with Pierre Delyea (birth and death dates unknown) mentions his son Peter Delyea (A.B.L.) of Adolphustown and several pages of descendants of the children of Peter.
