Finding JOHN HANNAH, or more exactly OUR John Hannah, is a problem because there was an abundance of John Hannahs and we don't know much about him.

We know that: he was born in Ireland; he had very little schooling and couldn't read or write; he belonged to the Church of England; and he left Sarah and his children in the mid 1880's to go to the U.S.A.

We don't know his parents' names and we aren't sure when he was born or when he came to Canada.

Early census records show c.1830-1 as his birth year, but, the 1881 census shows his age as 56 which would have meant that he was born in c.1824-5.

There were John Hannahs in Palmerston Twnshp., Frontenac County, and Elizabethtown Twnshp., Augusta Twnshp., and Bastard Twnshp., Leeds County. The possible U.S. family connection also provides multiple John Hannahs in Pennsylvania.

The three that fit what we do know are:

A John Hannah born in County Tyrone, Ireland who was brought to the U.S. in 1824 and became a naturalized citizen at the age of 21 in Philadelphia on Sept. 26, 1844. His father, William, was born July 17, 1805 in County Tyrone; emigrated to the U.S. and arrived in New York City July 20, 1823; and became a naturalized citizen in Philadelphia July 24, 1833.

Another John Hannah born in Ireland in 1826-7 is recorded in the 1851 census for Bastard Twnshp. He is living with his father, Alexander, who was born in Ireland in 1781 and a widowed sister, Martha b. 1830. His mother, aged 70, had died during that year.

Another John Hannah born c. 1830 in Ireland is also listed in the 1851 census for Bastard Twnshp. He is living with his father, William b. 1790; mother, Ann b. 1790; sister, Rebecca b. 1824; and brother, William Jr. b. 1828. Living within three concessions of their farm are James, George, Robert, and Alexander Hannah.

I believe that one of the Johns living in Bastard Twnshp. is the most likely to be our forefather.

Living in Bastard Twnshp. could explain how John and Sarah met as the township is immediately east of North Crosby and Sarah's uncle, Alfred Steel, lived within two or three concessions of the Hannah farms.

Neither John from Bastard Twnshp. is recorded in the 1861 census and this is consistent with one of them having married Sarah and moved to Bedford.

I have decided to take my premise forward to our family history and let it stand until future research can disprove it.

JOHN HANNAH was born in Ireland in c.1830 and was brought to Bastard Township, Leeds County by his family. In 1839 his father William is farming 20 acres on part Lot 6 Concession 4.

SARAH STEELE was born July 29, 1838 in Leeds County (probably North Crosby Township).

John and Sarah were married in 1859-60 and they began farming on 100 acres of W 1/2 Lot 16 Concession 9 ( Canoe Lake Road south of Fermoy, Bedford Twnshp., Frontenac County ) and living in a one story log cabin built by John.

John had "homesteaded" the land in March 1860 and the Crown granted occupancy on October 9, 1860 ( Archives Ref. 01AIV 001 099 ). On August 14, 1868 the Crown gave John patent to the property after payment of \$100.

The 1861 Census shows that in 1860 John had cleared three acres and planted two of them with "Indian" corn and the other in potatoes. He had cleared a further five acres by the May 1861 census.

The 1871 Census shows them a bit more prosperous with 21 acres clear: one acre in potatoes; one acre to pasture; nine acres in corn and buckwheat; and ten acres of hay. They had two working oxen; two milk cows; two steers; and one pig. They had sold two steers for slaughter that year.

On April 10, 1874 John and Sarah gave a deed for the property to H.J. Arnold and received \$291 on the sale of the 100 acres ( Bedford Township # C633 ).

The 1881 Census has them moved to part Lot 21 Concession 3 and living next to Sarah's brother, John Steele, at Fish Creek. This census shows John as a "farm labourer" and not as a "farmer" as on previous census.

John was apparently a man with a quick, mean temper.

Once, while walking along the railway tracks with Sarah and son William, he became involved in an argument with her and, in a fit of temper, threw young Will bodily into the marsh alongside the tracks. Sarah was left to wade in and rescue Will.

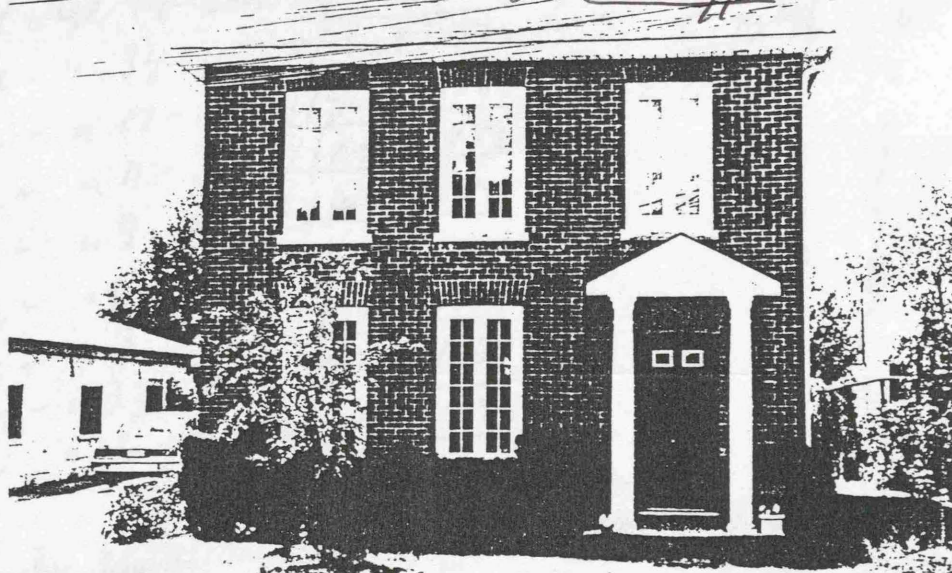
Sometime during the mid 1880's John left Sarah and their children and went to the U.S. His oldest son, John, went with him and they apparently went to "family living in the States".

In the 1891 Census Sarah records herself as a widow ???

Sarah couldn't keep the family together by herself and the 1891 Census shows: Sarah living with her brother John, his eight children, and his third wife, Lucinda; Bridget working in Snow Road Station for John and Emma Scales; Thomas, Alexander, and James also living in Snow Road Station with their sister, Levina, and her husband, James Colville; David married and living in Hinchbrook Township; William working as a domestic for Hugh Grey and his family on Lot 26 Conc. 3 Hinchbrook Twnshp.; Jane married to John LaPointe and living in Bedford Twnshp.; and George working on farms in the Fermoy area.

In her later years Sarah lived with her son, William, and died July 20, 1927 at his home, 100 John St. S., Belleville. She is buried in the Belleville Cemetery alongside William, Usher, and their sons, John and George.
