History of the Howes Family Page One.

George Howes, born in Ireland in c1814, and his wife, Elizabeth, migrated to the United States, probably in the 1830's, where their sons, George and Thomas were born in c1841 and c1843. They are not on the 1851 Index of Census for Frontenac County, or Kingston, Ont.

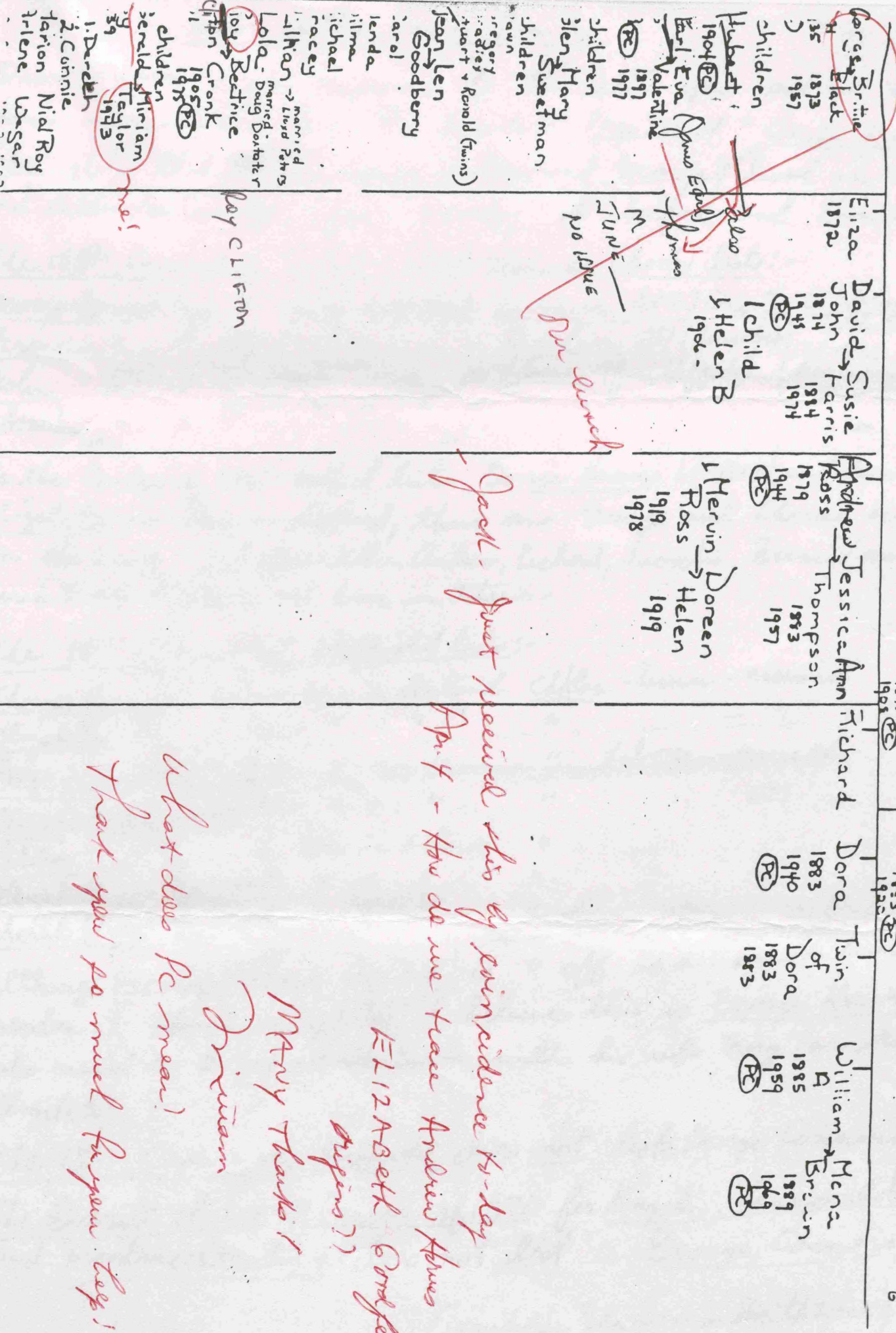

Dear Miriam: in response to the letter you sent me, I done some more research on the Howes: Page 396 of "County of a 1000 Lakes" states that the families of Andrew and George<sup>Howes</sup> lived in Lennox and Addington County before moving to Bedford and Hinchinbrooke.
