INTRODUCTION


This presentation of my family direct line genealogy started some twenty years ago with collecting of family pictures from relatives attics. Soon I found myself taking pictures of gravestones to provide accurate dates of my ancestors. As a result this is not the orthodox type of genealogy book. I have tried to show where people lived, raised their families, what their occupations were, where they are buried and as much valid information that is available.

One must realize that in the early generations information is scarce and sometimes more myth than fact as told by word of mouth and early publications. Someone had to start and publish what is available for this line of the Huff (Hof, Hoff) family. There is a separate line of German Huff's in Eastern Pennsylvania and another early origin of Huff's in New York State that are unrelated to this line of Huff's from Englebert Huff¹ (1632-1765) to Richard W. Huff, Jr.¹⁰ (1959-).

County libraries, museums, Genealogical Societies, local church records and word of mouth communication were the most profitable in gathering information. Tombstones provided needed dates.

As you read this monograph and the genealogy chart you will note that each generation is numbered from one thru eleven and can be cross referenced. I sincerely hope you are informed and enjoy reading this monograph as I enjoyed researching and writing it.

History of Englebert Huff' 1637 - - 3-21-1765 (Eglebert or Angle) (Hof, Hoff)

There is a small village in Western Germany named "Hof" and near the close of the Thirty Years War, his father (possibly named Leonhardt or Leonhard Hof) fled into Holland or possibly could have been Norway. Englebert was presumed to be born in Norway in 1637. He was a lad driving a team when news was brought to his country (Norway) that King Charles I was beheaded in 1649. Englebert then served as a soldier under the Prince of Orange, afterward King William III (King 1689-1702) of England in the time of King James II. He entered England in 1688 with William of Orange and 14,000 men. A complete history of when or how Englebert came to New Amsterdam (New York) is not known, but I presume it was about 1706. In Queen Ann's War (1702-1713) he went privateering on a ship out of New York and returned about the age of 70. Englebert married Maria (Marieta) Willenozen (born 1690) from Tarrytown, Westchester County, N.Y. She died 1732. They had the following children.

Englebert and Maria were reported to have 12 children. She died about 1732 and he was a widower for 33 years. Englebert spent his aging years from approximately 1740-1765 living on the Verplanck-Rombout property in Dutchess County, N.Y. along the east side of the Hudson River near Fishkill Landing (now named Beacon). In 1683, Gelyn Verplanck purchased this with Francis Rombout from the Wappinger Indians for \$1,250. In 1706 the tract of 85,000 acres was divided and the Verplanck holdings comprised 35,000 acres of farm and woodland with a river frontage of over a mile. Samuel Verplanck, great-great grandson of Gelyn lived in a fine Georgian Mansion on Wall Street and spent much time at Mt. Gulian, the family seat at Fishkill, on the lands secured under the Rombout patent. In later years during the American Revolution, Samuel left New York and lived at Mt. Gulian.

Englebert never used spectacles and he read fluently. His memory and senses were entirely strong until his death which was occasioned by a fall that mortally hurt his hip. His remains are buried under the east wall of the First Reformed Church, Hopewell, Dutchess County, N.Y. A silver tankard in his honor was presented January 1820 by Samuel Verplanck, Esq. To the First Reformed Dutch Church in the town of Fishkill to commemorate "Mr. Englebert Huff by birth Norwegian in his lifetime attached to the Life Guard of the Prince of Orange afterward King William III of England, he resided for a number of years in the County and died with unblemished reputation at Fishkill, 21, March 1765, aged 128 years."

Mr. Samuel Verplanck also donated a like tankard to the Trinity Anglican Church in Fishkill at the same time with similar inscription.

1, 2 etc. denotes number of generation starting with Englebert.

William Huff² (bap. 4-2-1714) son of Englebert Huff¹

William lived in the area of Tarrytown, New York. He married Elizabeth Retan in Tarrytown 9-22-1739. They had the following children:

Paul Huff³ b. 7-26-1747 d. 2-18-1813 son of William Huff²

Paul was married to Mary (Polly) Krank. He joined the British Army in 1777 with Jos. DeHancey and then Colonel Horton on Long Island. After leaving the British Army as a Lieutenant he took his family to New York to join the United Empire Loyalists who went from there in September 1783 to Sorel, Quebec, with Major Peter Van Alstine and the other U.E.L.'S. They went to the Bay of Quinte and Adolphustown in Upper Canada in June 1784. He settled in the Hay Bay area where he donated land for the first Methodist Church in Upper Canada in 1792. Also, on his land, in fact in his barn, was held the first court of Quarter sessions in the Midland District in 1794. Paul and his wife and many of his family are buried in the cemetery opposite the Hay Bay Church. Paul had the following children:

Solomon Huff³ b. 1751 d. 1828 son of William Huff²

The family of Solomon³ and Eva Swade. Solomon³, the fourth son of William² and Elizabeth Retan, was born at Fishkill, Dutchess County, New York in 1751 and died in Prince Edward County, Upper Canada in 1828. He married Eva Swade in Dutchess County where she was born about 1755. Five of their nine children were born in Dutchess County, the balance were born in Sophiasburgh Township near Adolphustown. When the American Revolutionary War broke out, Solomon continued to work his 200 acre farm, part of which later became the sight of New York City without engaging in the conflict. This became unbearable at the end of the war when bands of rebels began pillaging and destroying what they did not feel like confiscating, resulting in Solomon following the lead of his older brother Paul and joining British forces after the Treaty of Peace. Solomon and Eva brought their family to Upper Canada settling for a time in Adolphustown. Solomon's³ son, Solomon⁴, operated a farm overlooking the Adolphus Reach in Marysburgh Township. Solomon³ and Eva are buried in the cemetery opposite the Hay Bay Church. Richard⁴ their eighth child and Sophia Snider were farmers in Marysburgh and had three daughters. They are buried in Rose cemetery of Marysburgh township. Solomon⁴ married Charlotte Lobdell and is buried in Picton cemetery.

Angle of Ichabod Huff³ bap. 8-25-1742 son of William Huff²

The family of Angle-Englebert³-Ichabod and Delilah Edwards. The second son of the pioneer William Huff² and his wife Elizabeth Retan seem to have been variously know as Angle-Ichabod. He was born in Fishkill, Dutchess County, N.Y. in 1746. It was in Dutchess County he met and married Delilah Edwards born 1752 in Queens County, Long Island, N.Y. Insofar as can definitely be established at this time, their family of twelve children were born and reared in Dutchess County, where no doubt, the parents died and rest. At least one son, John Edwards Huff⁴ came to Upper Canada for a short period before moving on westward into the United States to establish the Utah branch of the Huff's. Solomon Huff⁴ of Huff's Island b. 9-2-1768 d. 3-21-1842 son of Paul³

Solomon was born in Fishkill, New York 1768 and died by drowning in the Bay of Quinte near Huff's Island in 1842. He came with his parents, Paul Huff³ and Mary Krank to Adolphustown with the U.E.L.'s in 1784 and was raised on the farm near Hay Bay. He married Sarah Alger (b. 1772) from New Brunswick and she died 4-14-1865. They moved to Huff's Island in the Bay of Quinte, Ontario about the winter of 1800, having difficulties breaking thru the ice and losing household effects. They operated a large lumber business and built a nice home on Huff's Island. They had the following children:

Solomon⁴ and Sarah are buried in Mountain View Cemetery near Huff's Island. Elisha is also buried there.

Paul Huff⁵ b. 1797 d. 6-17-1879 son of Solomon⁴

Family of Paul⁵ and Jane Wright. Paul was born 1797 near Hay Bay from Solomon⁴ and Sarah Alger. He moved in 1800 to Huff's Island with his parents and was raised there participating in the

lumber business. He married Jane Wright of Hollowell (daughter of Elizabeth Huff⁴ and William Wright). They moved to Lambton County near Florence, Ontario in 1845. In a log cabin they raised the following children:

Paul died 6-17-1879 and is buried in Butler Hill Cemetery near Florence. His wife Jane Wright died 9-17-1868 and is also buried in Butler Hill Cemetery.

Solomon Huff⁶ b. 12-8-1821 d. 6-14-1905 son of Paul Huff⁵

The family of Solomon⁶ Huff and Jane Sidney Rea (Wray). Solomon⁶ was born 12-8-1821 on Huff's Island and moved with his parents in 1845 to Florence with Paul⁵ and Jane Wright to live in a log cabin. Solomon⁶ married Jane Sidney Rea in 1853. Jane and her sister Nancy came to Florence, Ontario from Pennsylvania as young women. Solomon⁶ and Jane had the following children:

Solomon⁶ and Jane built a large six bedroom farm house on 10th concession of Dawn Township west of Florence, Ontario in the late 1850's where they farmed and raised their family. Solomon⁶ Huff was an early pioneer in the area and helped establish Huff's school and church in 1870 on the Northeast corner of 10th concession and 16th sideroad. This building on his land was used for a school and church worship until 1881 when a frame church was erected on the William Congdon land on the diagonal corner. In 1925 Huff's Methodist Church joined the United Church of Canada and in 1964 amalgamated with Rutherford United Church. On October 21, 1984 a plaque was dedicated on this corner to these pioneers.

Solomon⁶ and Jane's children had variable longevity. Malcolm⁷ and Dennis⁷ died in the winter of 1885 of some flu disease, James⁷, (twin of Sidney⁷) died at two months old in October 1859. John⁷ H. died in 1865 shortly after birth. Around 1890, Robert Rea⁷ left the farm and moved

to the river road outside Chatham and purchased the Stage Coach Road House. He married Betsy Watt and had four boys, Rea⁸, Lloyd⁸, Cecil⁸ and Solomon Percy⁸. Sidney Wright⁷ left Solomon's⁶ farm in Florence in 1895 and moved to Detroit where he worked in the coal business. He married Elena Moorhouse b. 9-23-1868 d. 6- -1916 from Shetland, Ont. The two old maid sisters Eleanor⁷ and Sarah⁷ remained on the farm after their parents died until 1910 when they sold the farm to Mr. Butler. They then moved to Chatham until they died in 1932. Jane Sidney Rea died 10-9-1892 and Solomon⁶ 6-14-1905 and are buried in Butler Hill Cemetery near Florence.

Sidney Wright Huff⁷ b. 8-1-1859 d. 2-26-1939 son of Solomon⁶

Family of Sidney W. Huff⁷ and Elena Moorhouse. After Sidney moved to Detroit in 1895 and entered the coal business he sent for Elena Moorhouse from Shetland to marry him. Their first child Beatrice⁸ was born 9-24-1896 (d. 2-15-88). Marian⁸ was born 10-29-1899 and died of tuberculosis in 1922. Sidney Wright Jr.⁸ was born 9-24-1903 (d. 5-25-1972) and a second son Harold Harmon⁸ was born 10-30-1909 (d. 2-1925). Elena Moorhouse died in June 1916 from tuberculosis and is buried with Mr. Huff, Marian and Harold in Grandlawn Cemetery, Detroit, Michigan. Mr. Sidney Wright Huff remarried Georgiana Gregg from Grandville, Ohio.

Sidney Wright Huff, Jr.⁸ b. 9-24-1903 d. 5-25-1972 son of Sidney W.⁷

Family of Sidney Wright Huff⁸, Jr. and Marian Garlick. Sidney Huff, Jr. followed his father in the coal business in Detroit. He married Marian Elizabeth Garlick, Sept. 15, 1926 and a daughter Nancy Elizabeth was born April 9, 1928, a son Richard Wright⁹ was born August 26, 1930. Sidney died May 25, 1972 and is buried in Roseland Park Mausoleum.

Richard Wright Huff⁹ b. 8-26-1930 son of Sidney Huff, Jr.⁸

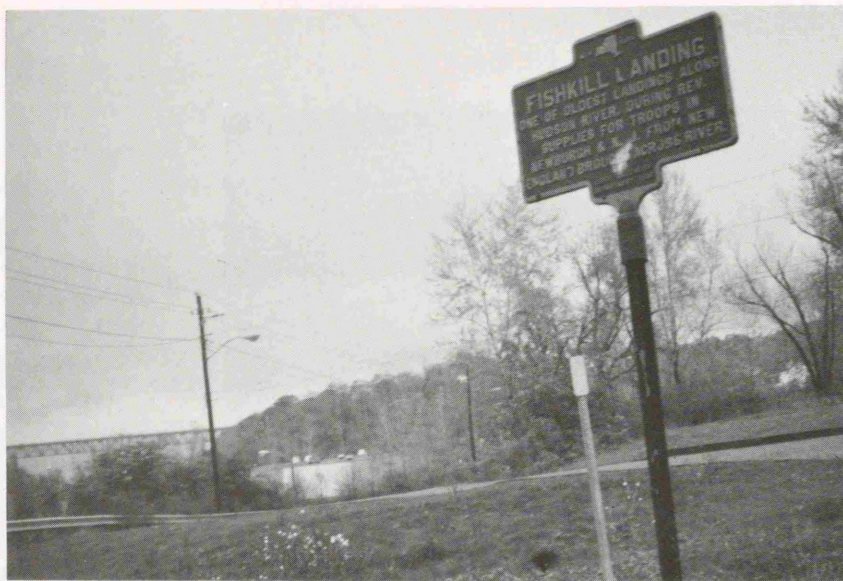
Family of Richard Wright Huff⁹ and Michaleen Telep. After graduating from Veterinary School, Richard and Michaleen were married Sept. 15, 1956. Their first born was a girl, Janice Elizabeth¹⁰, May 9, 1958 and then Richard Wright Huff, Jr.¹⁰ was born, November 3, 1959. Linda Ann¹⁰ was born November 13, 1961. Dr. Huff has continued in the practice of Small Animal Veterinary medicine to date.

Returning to the family of four boys of Robert Rea Huff⁷ and Betsy Watt. The oldest child Rea W.⁸ never married and farmed on the Chatham river road with his brother Lloyd⁸. Lloyd Stanley⁸ married Emily Dewar and they had six girls, Betty, Marian, Alice, Barbara, Dorothy and Margaret. Another brother Cecil C.⁸, married Ila May Wemp and had two boys, Robert Cecil⁹ and William Duncan⁹. The last brother Solomon Percy⁸ did not marry and remained on the family homestead to farm until his death.

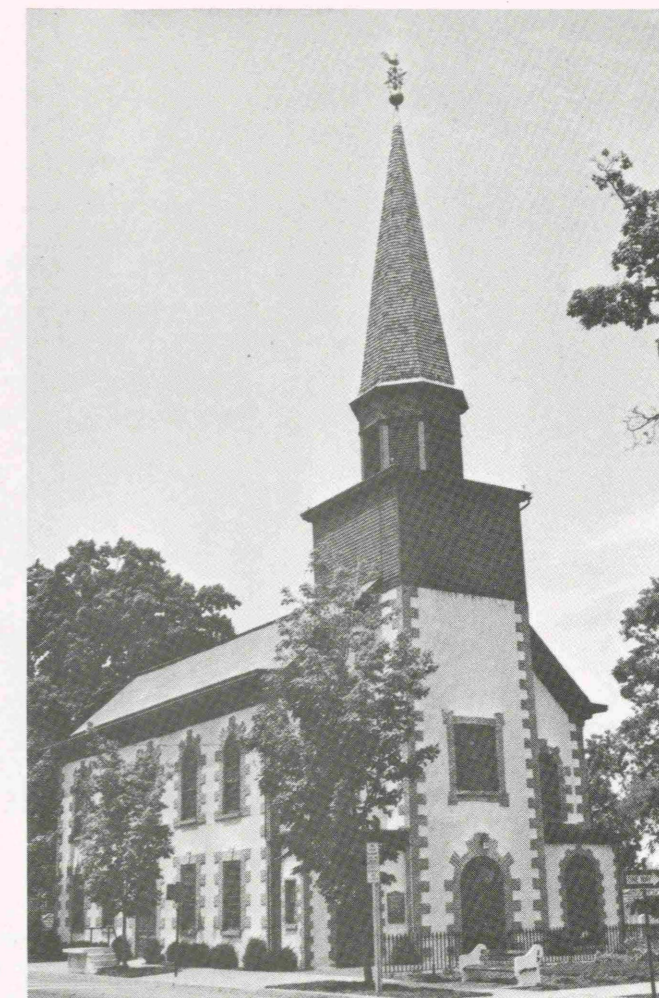


Fishkill Landing up Hudson River 60 miles from New York where Englebert Huff¹ came to live on Verplanck Estate about 1745.



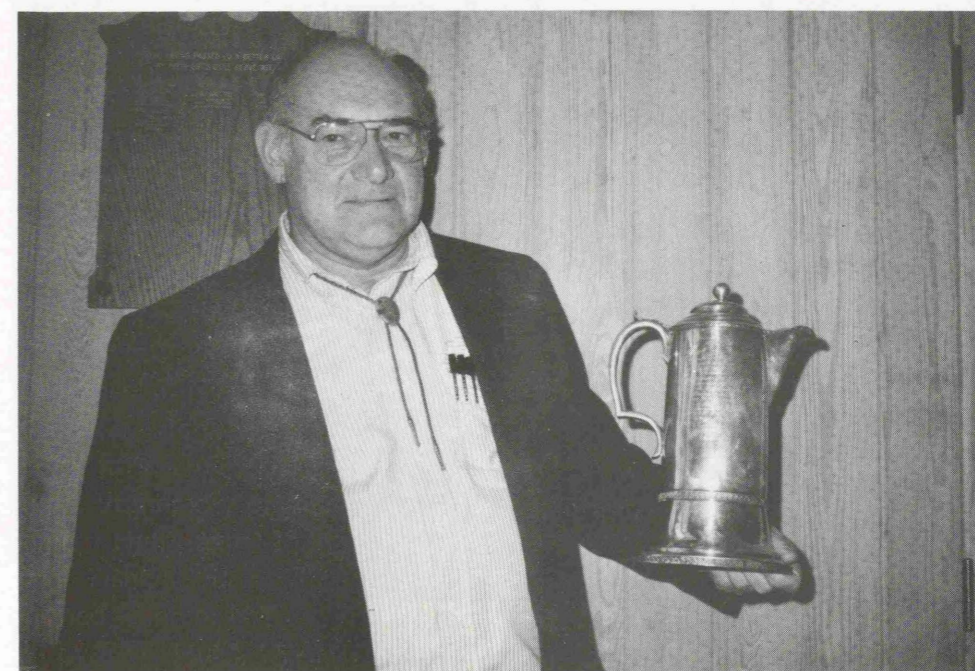
Reconstructed Verplanck Estate where Englebert spent his last years. Fishkill, N.Y. (Now Beacon) Picture 1986

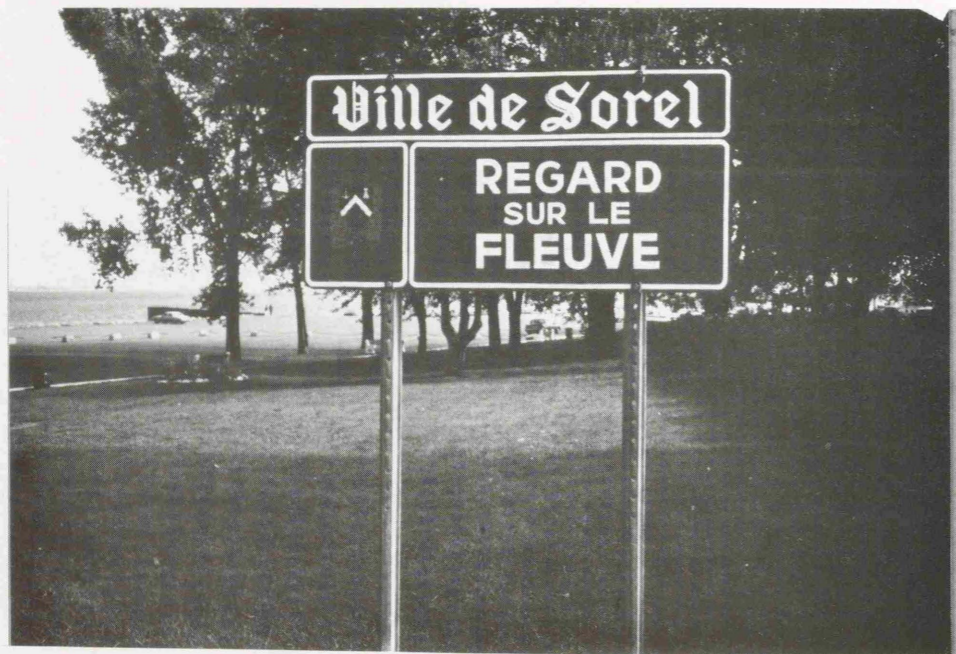

 raised his family except in the Philipstown area.



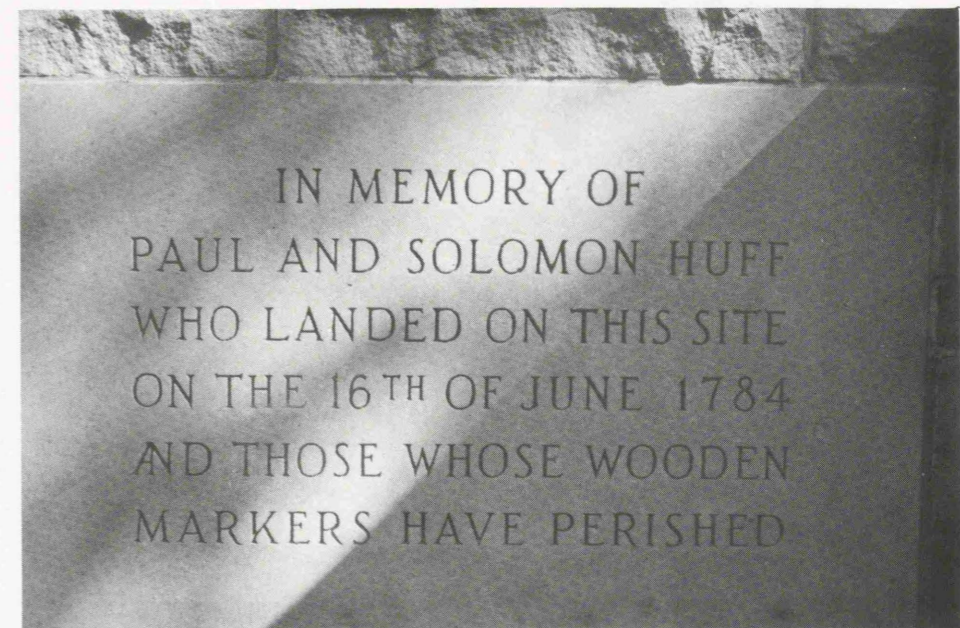
Philipstown, N.Y. area where William Huff²

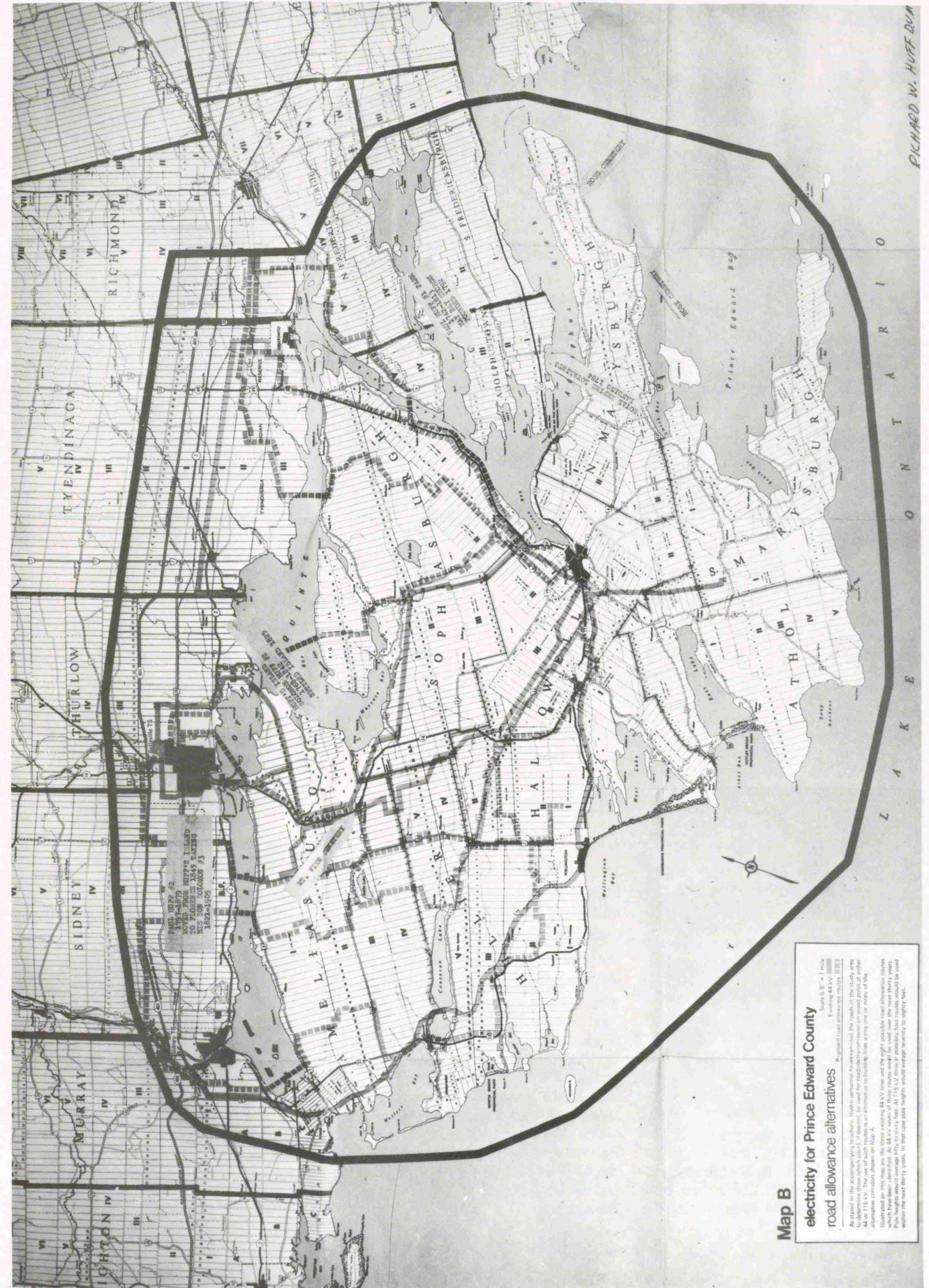
United Empire Loyalists Cemetery at Adolphustown Landing





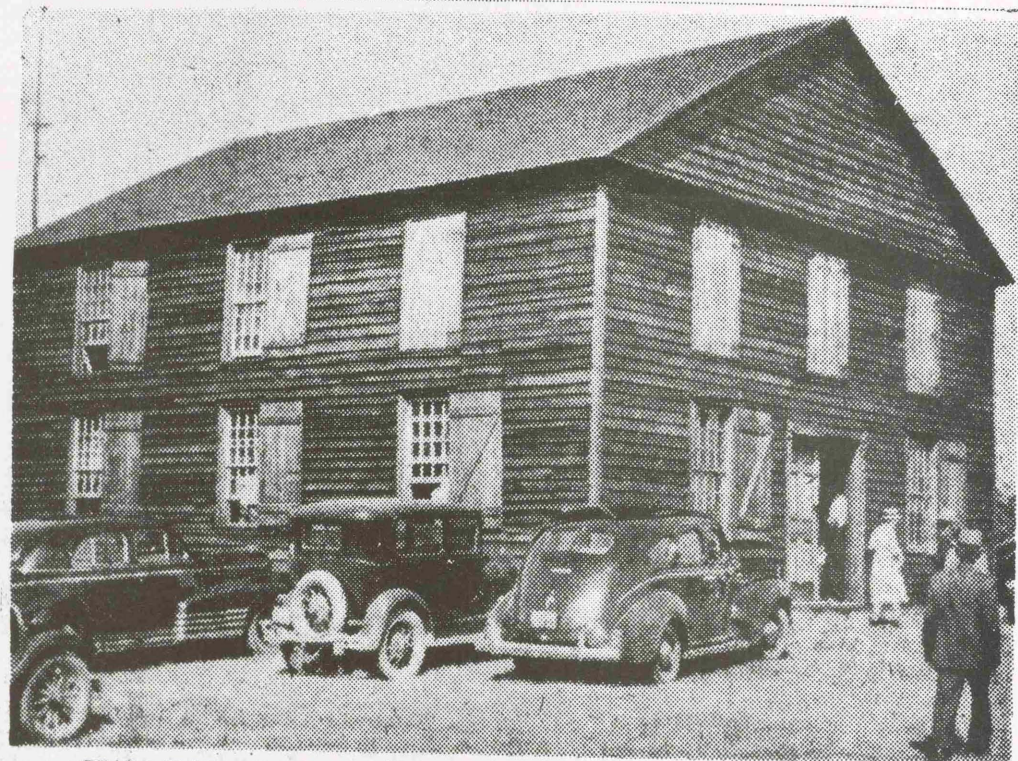

Annual pilgrimage and service are scheduled for Sunday

Cairn to honor early preacher

ADOLPHUSTOWN — An event of historical significance will take place at the Annual Pilgrimage Service, Sunday at 3 p.m. at the Old Hay Bay Church near here.

A new cairn will be unveiled in the cemetery opposite the church, honoring the Rev. William Losee (1757-1832), the first regularly appointed Methodist preacher in Ontario. Losee preached along the St. Lawrence and the Bay of Quinte during the period 1790-1793. Many Methodist classes were started and two churches built at Hay Bay and Ernestown in 1792. This year marks the 180th anniversary of his arrival.

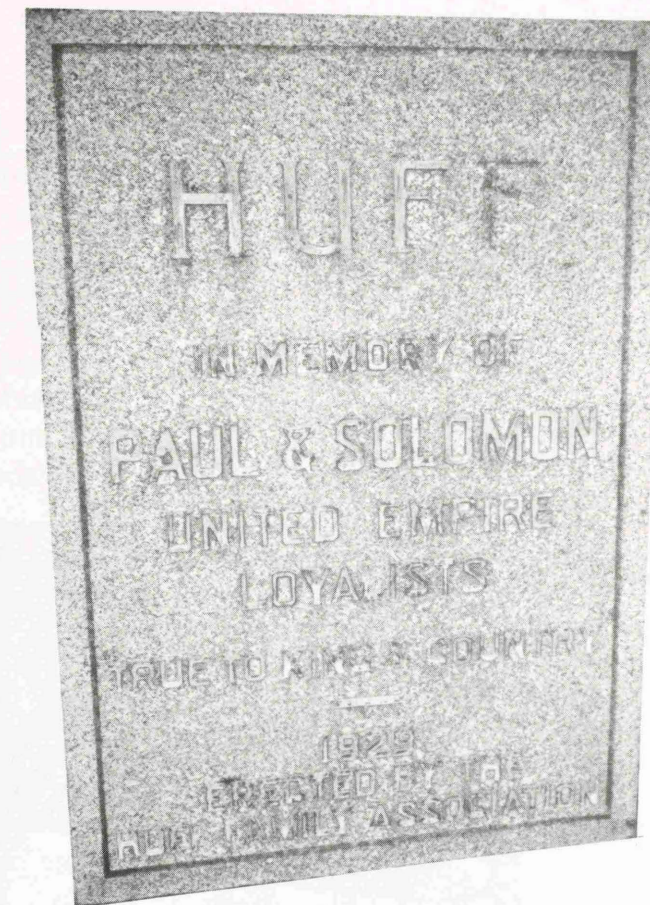
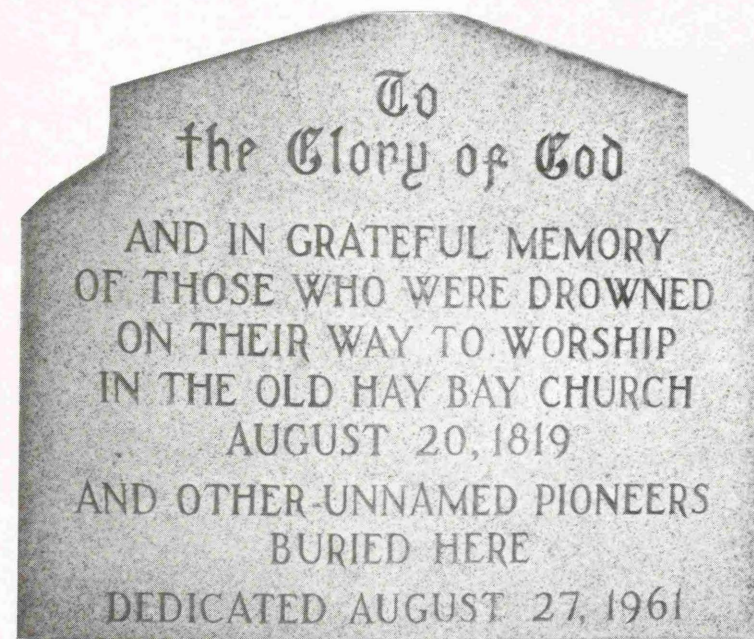
Last fall, the graves of Losee and his wife were removed, due to a highway-widening project. They had been buried in the cemetery of the

Methodist Church in Hempstead, Long Island, N.Y. Through the co-operation of the Hempstead trustee and the United Church's national committee on archives, the two gravestones were brought to Canada, and will be embedded in the cairn.

The unveiling will follow the annual service, at which this year's special preacher will be the Rev. Harold B. Neale, DD, of Hamilton. Dr. Neale has long been associated with the Hay Bay Church, and was until recently, chairman of the Board of Trustees. He is a former pastor of Holloway St. United Church, Belleville. The Rev. Newton Reed, president of the Bay of Quinte Conference, will unveil the cairn.

Solomon Huff³ and Eva Swade's arrival in the Bay of Quinte area is uncertain but certainly after the U.E.L. landing June 16, 1784. He was not a member of the British forces during the war and therefore did not qualify as a U.E.L. He operated a farm near the site of New York City.

MARYSBURGH SETTLEMENT

Following the American Revolution, Marysburgh Township was established for the settlement of Loyalists and discharged soldiers of regular regiments. Surveyed in 1784 by the Honourable John Collins, Deputy Surveyor-General, the township was named in honour of Princess Mary, a daughter of King George III. Among its earliest settlers was a small group of disbanded German mercenaries under Baron von Reitzenstein. By October, 1784, this party, numbering about 40 persons, had settled in this vicinity and begun to clear and cultivate the land. Shortly after, they erected a log chapel just west of here, and were ministered to by Lutheran missionaries. This was one of the earliest German-speaking groups to settle in Ontario.

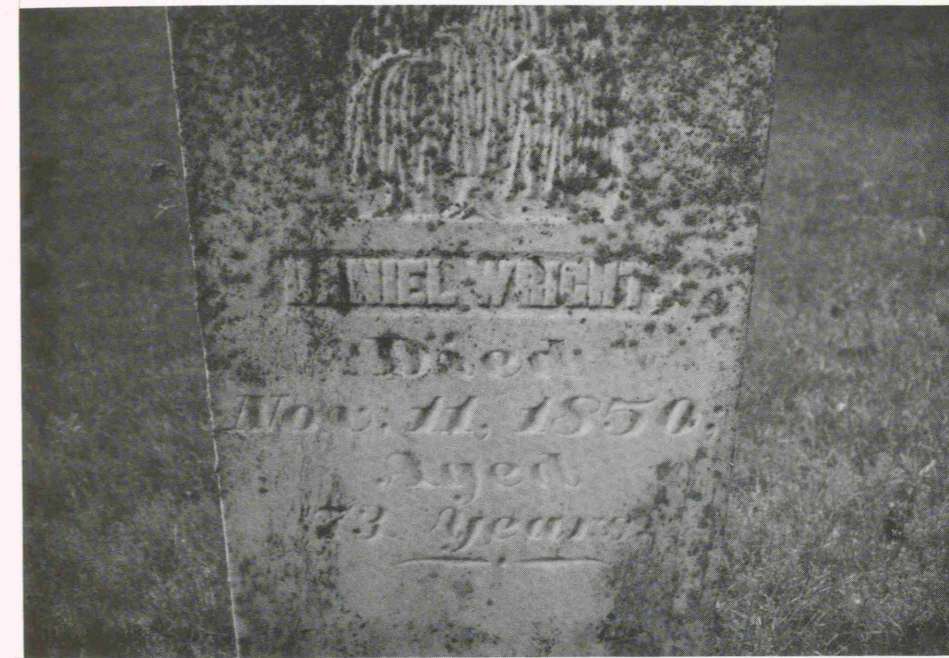
