## The H O F F M A N Family in Canada

Charlottetown, P.E.I. By Emma Hoffman Bogart, U. E. ASSELSTINE  
William Wesley ASSELSTINE A. Josetta 1877

The family is of Swedish origin, although the name is distinguished in Dutch and German literature as well. Large numbers of them moved to Holland around 1611-1632.

Varied spellings of name, Hoffman, Huffman, Hofman, etc.  
Cyrus ASSELSTINE

Several individual members of the Hoffman families arrived in America with some of the early migrations of Swedes. Possibly the best known of these would be Martin Hermanzén Hoffman (son of Herman Hoffman) who was born at Revel on the Gulf of Finland. Martin emigrated to America in 1657 settling in New Amsterdam where he contracted two marriages, and where two of his children were born and baptized. Later he moved to Albany and shortly after 1672 settled in Kingstown, N.Y.  
Mary ASSELSTINE

Elias Hoffman was the pioneer U. E. Loyalist who came with many other Loyalists to Canada and in particular with the Carscallen family (connected by marriage) who settled in Fredericksburg. Elias was born August 26th 1768 and as far as known had no brothers or sisters but did have some cousins, one of whom settled next to him. Elias settled on lot 15 concession 6 Fredericksburg, afterwards known as Campbell's Hill where Alexander Campbell built a fine stone house. In 1792 Elias married Nancy Reed (daughter of William and Nancy Nesbitt Reed) pioneer settlers of the Corbyville area. ~~Married in 1792 in Fredericksburg.~~ They lived a full life, raising all but the last (Isaiah) of their ten children on this farm before moving across the Napanee river to lot 19 concession 1 Richmond twp where they spent many happy years, and where their remains rest just east of the old home on the river bank in what is known as Riverview Cemetery maintained by the Grace Methodist Church to whom the site was given by their youngest child Isaiah who was born on that farm.

NOTES ON THE REED FAMILY

Mrs Ella Reed Wright's carefully prepared genealogy of the Reed family says: "Reed, Read, Reid, and many other ways of spelling the word, as Rede, Rheade, are all derived from the word RHE, having its origin in Phoenicia. The third branch of the River Tyne in the north of England, is the River Reed, and the valley through which it flows is Redesville. Close by was the baronial home of Sir Reginald Reed

The first Reed known to have come to America was John Reed who settled in Providence in 1660. Later he moved to Norwalk, Conn, purchasing a large tract of land. Carniff's Settlement of Upper Canada says: In the spring of 1780 a party of about fifty reached the Bay of Quinte, all refugee Loyalists, settling in Sidney. With them was William Reed, his wife Nancy Nesbitt, sons John, William, Samuel, Solomon and five daughters. John married Esther ETHEY; Samuel a Miss LAKE; Solomon and William wives unknown; Susan a Samuel HOUGH; Elizabeth a William FOSTER; Abigail a John SPENCER and later a Daniel WAY; Nancy a Elias HOFFMAN; Sarah a Cyrus PARKS.

The booklet "The Petworth Emigration Scheme" edited by Wendy Cameron and Mary Mc Dougall Maude. They compiled a list of the <sup>families</sup> ~~people~~ who came to Canada from Sussex, England between 1832 and 1837. Petworth was a village in Sussex. Several families named Hill ~~were~~ on this list.

Timothy Chambers bought Joseph Foster's sawmill on the Napanee River in the 1850's (where Petworth now stands). It burned and he and George Satt built a new saw-mill and grist-mill. The new village here was called "Chambers' Mills". Local legend has it, a resident of the village stood on the walls of the new gristmill and re-named it Petworth.

This probably was David Hill, as he lived with Timothy Chambers and was employed by him at the mill. See the Book "Community Spotlight" - Page 228 - written by Cora Garrison. David Hill and his family may have been from Petworth, Sussex.

Note:- The school built at Godfrey, Ont c 1840 was called Hill's School.
