 OBITUARY: Mrs. Louisa Playfair

Mrs. Elijah Playfair Age 83. Died on July 1/1912. She was born in Liverpool, England and was the third daughter of the late John Playfair, who was the son of the noted writer, William Playfair. Her father's Uncle, the late John Playfair, was professor of Natural Philosophy at the University of Edinburgh, Scotland. Her great grandfather was the Reverend William Playfair, the Presbyterian Minister of Dundee, Scotland. Louisa Playfair came to Canada in 1843, and had settled there in 1820. At age 18, Louisa married Elijah Playfair. They had six sons and three daughters, four of whom are now dead. (Two boys, two girls). The survivors are Elijah at Carleton Place, Robert B and George at Lanark, Thomas in Victoria B.C., Mrs Samuel Bulger in Drummond Township. Her husband died in 1801. The burial will be at Elmwood Cemetery, Perth, Ont.

Obituary - Mrs John Playfair, who died at Baldur, Manitoba, on Jan 3/1900. The deceased was born in Sarny, England on 3/Aug 1814. At Age 17, he came to America and after crossing several times between Canada and the U.S.A., he finally settled at Playfair. He was an apprenticed whitesmith, but that trade was of no use in this country, so he turned to blacksmithing. In the year of 1837, he married Miss Annetta C. Playfair, daughter of Col. A. W. Playfair and had a marriage lasting 40 years. About 1854, he left the trade and moved to the Fall River, where he had a flour mill, which burned down about 10 years later. Twenty years ago, he moved to Manitoba. He leaves 8 children, 47 grand-children, and 29 great-grandchildren.
