

#### History of the Snyder Family

P1

The Snyders came to America from Holland to join in the Dutch settlement of New Amsterdam. Some left after the American Revolutionary War to go to Upper Canada.

One Dutchman, <u>Henrig Johan Snyder</u> left Holland in 1709 as part of the Palatine German migration to America. He sailed with a Palatine German named Johann Schneider(Snider)

- Note! A deed for land on Lot 9 Concession 4 in Ernestown Township for 100 acres on Dec 31/1798, was given to Marcus Snyder. The next transfer of this land was from Samuel Harris et al.
- Note! Elizabeth Snyder received 6 land grants in Ernestown on Lots 27 and 31, on Concession5 in 1791c, 1801c, 1822c as U.E.L.
- Note! Marcus Snyder received 12 land grants in Ernestown Township on Lots 9 and 17, Concession 4, 6, and 7, in 1790c, 1800c as U.E.L.
- Note! The U.E.L. Rolls list Dorcas (wife of Joseph Peters) as a daughter of Marcus Snyder. (E series 1817-1843)
- Note! Ira H. Snyder of Ernestown, b. 23/Dec/1843, a son of Edward and Dianna Snyder (of U.E.L. stock) moved to Odessa, Ont. In 1865. He was 22 years old at the time. His brother stayed on the homestead.

## History of the Schneider (Snider) Family P1

- 1) The Sniders originated in Germany; Philip, John Michael, Bernhard, Johannes and Jacob Schneider left the Palatine in the early 1700's going to London, England and then on to America. Jacob and Johannes are listed on the New York Subsistence List of 1710. Johannes Sr. moved to Dutchess County, New York. After the American Revolutionary War of 1775 to 1783, most of the children of Simon Snider, grandson of Johannes Sr. came to Ernestown Township. They were soldiers under Colonel Jessup, leader of the Ernestown settlers. (From The Palatine German Families) O.G. Section Kingston Public Library
- 2) Russ Waller U.E. noted historian, in his book called U.E. Loyalist Links in L.A. County, lists the names of the Snider U.E. Loyalist settlers with their birth dates, names of their children and grandchildren and great-grandchildren.(about 10 pages)
- 3) The Napanee Museum and Archives has a Snider Family File which should be read by anyone who is interested in the Snider Family genealogy.
- 4) Dr. Burleigh of Bath, Ontario famous genealogist, collected two large files on the snider Family which can be read at the Queen's University Archives, Kingston, Ontario. It contains many family tree branches, early history, American colonial history, Revolutionary War history, Loyalist history, etc. plus correspondence files, coats of arms etc.
- 5) The Snider families can be found today all over Ontario and most Canadian provinces and are to be to be found in the Censuses of the Townships of Ontario 1851, 1861, 1871, 1881, 1891 & 1901 (available at the Stauffer Library, Queen's University in Kingston, Ontario and at the Ontario Archives in Toronto)


