# History of the Yeomans (Yeomans) Family - Page 1

The book, "The Loyalist Trail", by R. M. Bruce has listed Arthur Yeomans, Associated Loyalist (U.E.L.) in Cataragui Township Number One (later Kingston Township).

The Burleigh Files at Queen's University Archives has a file on the Yeomans (Yeomans) family.

It says that Arthur Yeomans pioneered in Prince Edward County, where he received a land grant for 1000 acres. Also he built a grist mill on Yeomans' Creek.

Arthur Yeomans married Hannah and their children were Samuel, Mary, Sarah, David, Hannah, Elizabeth, Arthur Jr., Jemima, Jane and John. Arthur Yeomans died 25/April/1858, Age 84 years and Hannah died on 4/April/1843. Age 61 years.

Arthur Yeomans Jr. married ① Sophia and ② Fetitia Creighton. Three of his 8 children were Rev. John S. Yeomans, Sophia and Hannah.

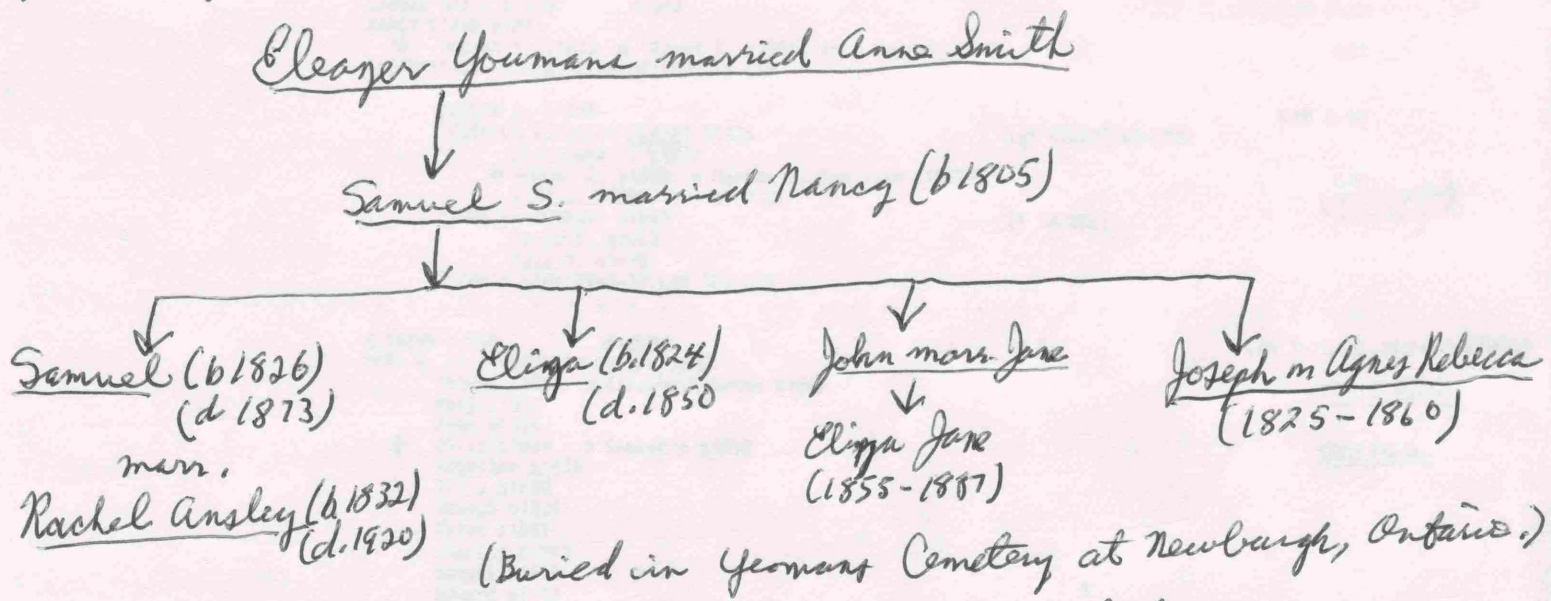
