As I was in Hfx yesterday & saw the AI parts (only one!) He had been in Sydney & met somebody up there who had read your grand article in the Atlantic. He said - "She stripped the pants off Laacock!"

Hurray for your Summer School - I think that it is a great thing to have pulled off something like that in the midst of war.

Re India - I am sad to the core - Englishmen have a haughty way with not too much honesty behind it & they will not get on with the job. They have had 1908 to 1939 or 21 years to get a solution. I am more & more convinced that the only approach to people is the approach of Jesus Christ. As a practical man his way is far ahead of every other line. In his own case it was not successful

immediately - that is he ² lost his life & did not win either his people nor the Romans. In the face of determined hatred and violence anybody may go down whose approach is that of Christ.
