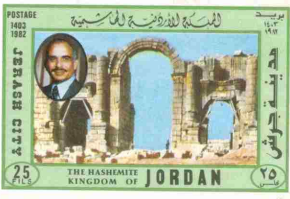


Amman Jordan

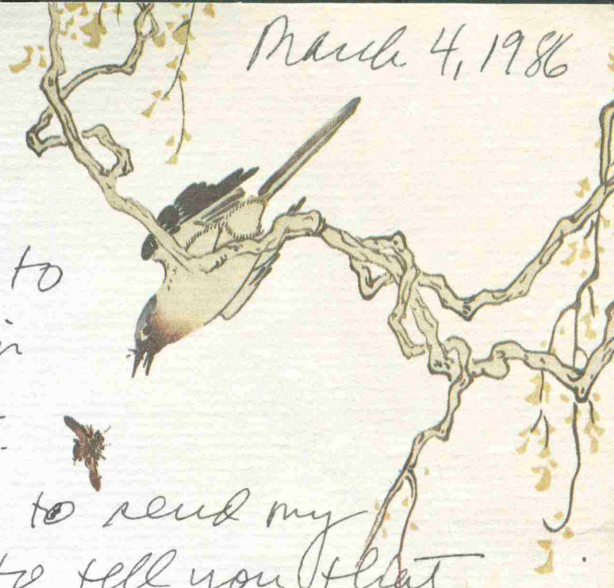

we often think with affection and re-
spect of those who, like you, made

Seeing you reminded me of staying in
Ban Righ Hall our last summer there
when Charlie Dunlop and I were invol-
ved in the model United Nations. You
woke us all up with music on your
low-Fi as you called it. I also recall
a happy visit to your island with
Pat and Charlie and George Murray.
So I believe on these and many



other occasions you had a civilizing influence on such uncouth youths as I. We haven't seen Pat and Audrey for a while but the intention is there and it will be done.

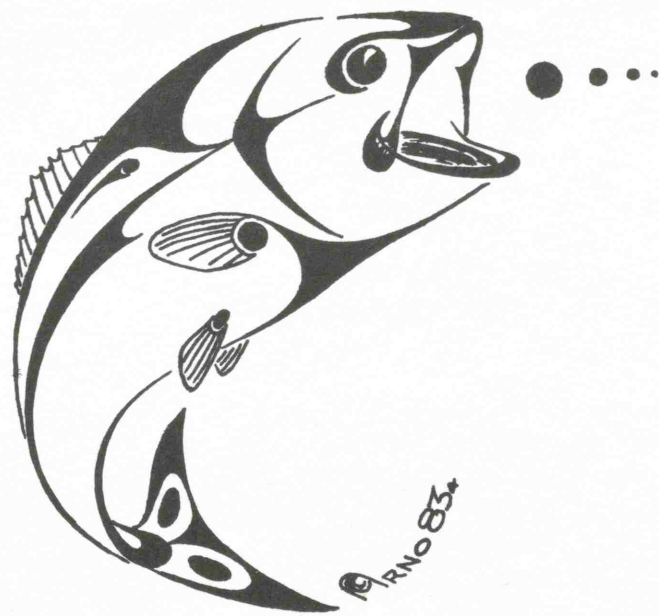
I hope that you are well and that it gives you some pleasure to know that you are remembered fondly by former students, such as us who find ourselves, some what surprised to be middle-aged!

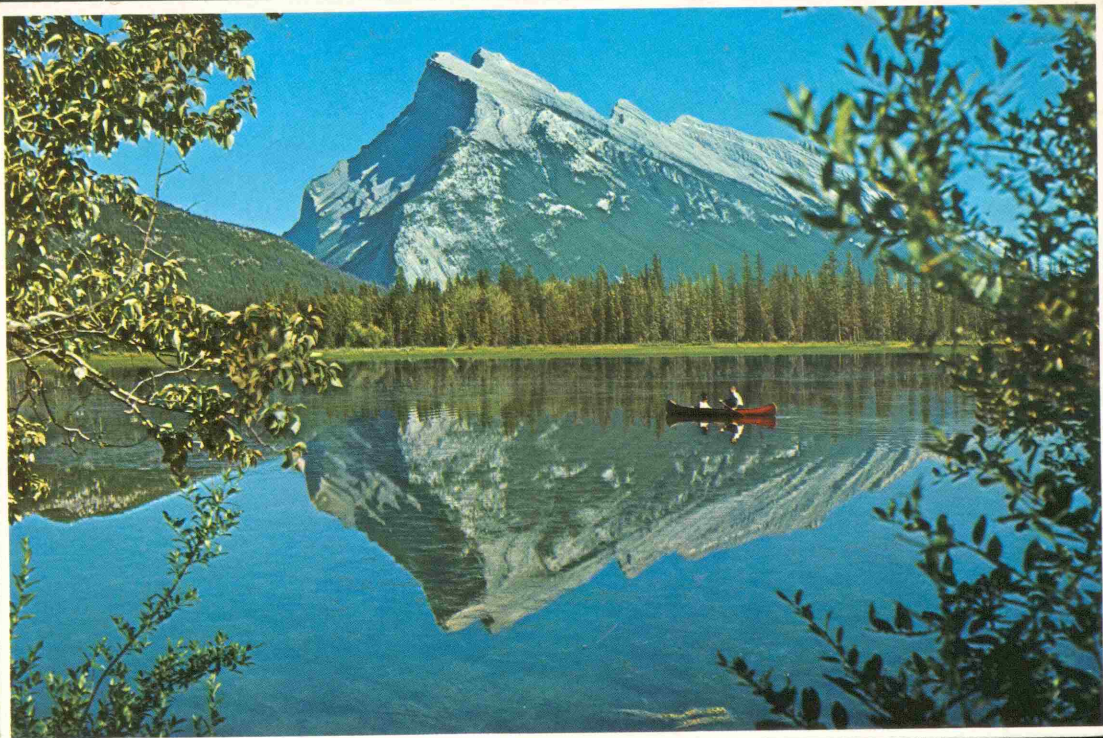
Dear VIRGIL DOUGLAS -
