The National Bird of Jamaica is found no-where else in the world and is the most spectacular and abundant of all Jamaican Humming Birds. He has several local names but is familiarly known as "Dr. Bird.". He is much loved and admired for his beautiful colouring and graceful antics in the air. His two long, black tail feathers 8" - 10" float behind him as he darts from flower to flower at high speed, backwards, and sideways seem equally easy to him. The wind in his feathers produces the hum which gives him his name.
