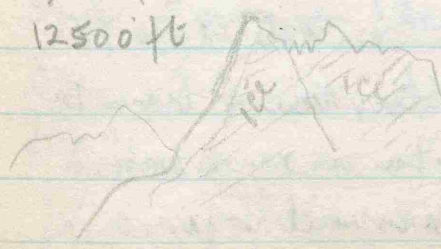



Wed Aug 13 Went to San Marco, grey
marble sq pillars + walls, some
contrast to mosaics of upper walls, arches
+ 5 domes. no stained glass at all -
galleries with prophets + Bible scenes
+ legends in mosaic. St T. Aquinas - with
Latin whomsoever would be saved -
View over sq + Orlogia tower with zodiac
+ on top large bell + 2 giants with rod
+ hammer - each strikes the hour.

View out over lagoon to S. Doge's
palace - balcony from wh. proclamation
of death was made - Bridge of Sighs
over a small canal betw. back of
Palace + Prison - walked along harbor
quays + had lunch overlooking G. Canal.

Walked in + out of little old streets + over
many little bridges. About 4 crossed Rialto
bridge with shops both sides + market beyond
very busy - scarfs, jewelry etc etc. To
Post office next door + back via St Leo's
ch. with a Titian (Doge da Compostella
so darkened with old varnish as to be
unseeable. Back by Merceria
+ San Marco + to dinner at pension.

Out at 9 to Doge's Piazzale where the
Municipal band was playing 2 hours of
Strauss, Gounod Fanst, Schubert etc etc.
stayed $\frac{3}{4}$ hr + had moca cone + then
home - crowds of citizens + tourists.

Thurs Aug 14 By ferry to Antibes centre beyond
Station. Bus at 11 to Padova 11:40 Talked to me
+ pool out student staying in Student Hostel for
450 bed + bkp! Beer + sandwich in corner
cafe. Very hot 95°F in shade of arcade.
Walked down to Univ. closed till 4pm - sent
into inner court - sqy crabs of student
on arcade ceiling + stone plaques very worn
all around walls - 2 story pillared court
like Turin on down to large sq. with
oval waterway + 4 bridges + 2 rows

of statues to great men of Padua -
Tasso, Eschiles etc. Too hot to look
for Galileo! Walked to Old Botanic
Garden in Europe - 1545 ± fine old palm
of that period in cement & brick circular build,
& a plane, huge & hollow for 20 ft up 1580
walked to San Antonia - huge basilica
5 domes, ornate choir & transepts.
In N. transept is elaborate tomb &
altar to San Antonia of Padua - a disciple
of St F. of Assisi. People leaving, vator
grips these & goes behind to place
palm of hand on back of tomb - in
black marble stone.

To Scola San Antonia on S. side

to Piazza & upstairs to lovely room
wood ceiling in square - 17 murals
of St. A's life 3 by Titian -
up through city to chapel of 13th cent in old
Roman Arena - plain rectangle, walls
completely covered by 3 rows of Giotto
frescoes - lovely pale blues, roof very blue
a quite wonderful series - life of Mary - & of
Jesus in 2 rows. Into nearly large brick
Eremita ch. - nave badly hit in war
frescoes etc in chancel & chapels. Back
by bus 5-6 pm & ferry along Piccolo
Canal a short cut to Grand Canal
taking off one long loop.
Senora at Orion said she could not find
me a room! out into blue Sat!

Fri Aug 15th Ferry to Str + repacked
large bag + registered it to
Rome. Then walked over

2 bridges + found CIAT onto terminus
+ hotel information place. After 45 min
clerk found the room for 5 days at Albagi

Graspe de Va near Rialto bridge - 2400
half pensione. Took ferry there + then

Went to Doge's Palace. Overwhelming
no. of fine rooms, halls, antichambers,
council of 10, of 40, of senators, of
3 Inquisitors, Doge's room etc. slit
in stone for written denunciations +
iron locked door in next room to
get them out. narrow dark passage
off lovely gallery of inner court +

step stairs up to Bridge of Sighs
over to Prison - Barred iron grids.

Wonderful Tintoretto's etc etc
heavily gilded + painted ceiling.
In my room has Paradise placed family in
Holding Lovely views out to lagoon from

side Audience hall + lower arcade
gallery. Inner gallery has statues
of Doges + St. Venetians. John + Seb
Caboto! Marco Polo, and by order
of Sci council of Venice bust to
Galileo + nearly one to Fra Paolo Sapri
who opposed Jesuits + Papal authority in Venice
Back to prison for lunch + the range lunch

+ packed, paid Senora + took sacks to
Graspe. Then walked over Rialto
sought 3 mosaic brooches (5000) + a

long way through narrow streets
to ch of Frari. Altar painting
large flood lit ascension of Madonna
cherubs below in cloud + around golden
sky + people below worshipping her on.

Titians "masterpiece". It is impressive
+ no wonder the Italian Catholics
welcomed the Papal decree of her
deity. A carved wood + softly
painted chapel altar by Donatello.

Adjacent is Scuola San Rocco
full of Tintoretto's masterpieces.
Life of Christ (see 12 1951 life
had colored reproductions). Fine double
stairway to rich upper room of
great painting illuminating

in side chapel with Tintoretto's
great Crucifixion. ^{Some very}
powerful paintings - ^{San Rocco's - with Titian}
^{to Tintoretto's morals in}
Frightfully hot - all night. ^{white with a blue cape.}

After late dinner at al Gressa took ferry
at Rialto + saw preliminary illumination
of Palaces + bridges + towers, one palace
had glistening chandeliers lit in upper hall
visible from canal. Ferry crowded
stood both ways.

Sat Aug 16 Venet. - went to Accademia
via Santo Stefano huge church with
equestrian statue to Don Contarini over
wood inside. He was one of Reformatori
who appointed babies to Padua

The Accademia very fine ceilings +
stair + inlaid marble floors + an
amazing collection of great paintings.
Titians St J - the Baptist; + Presentation
of Madonna at temple as a little
girl in long blue dress climbing steps
to Temple where High Priest awaits
her (very beautiful); Pieta - wonderful.
Many fine Tintoretto Bellini + Veronese.
walked back via San Marco - a
USA naval ship at anchor off Piazzetta.
Explored Rialto district + hunted coloured
cards + sat at Piazzetta till 6³⁰. It is Festival
of Lights - Festoons of lanterns by Rialto
+ bridge flood lit green with top arch red

Bank Stiles red, others along canal
red yellow or green - Barges + gondolas
with lanterns - chairs by canal at
200 lire each! I sat on stone steps
for an hour watching gondolas +
people.

Sun Aug 17 Dripping hot.
Went to St Marks at 10 am - High
Mass in chancel worshippers in N transept
but crowds coming + going elsewhere - Organ
+ choir fine. Got a table about 11¹⁵ on
shady side of St Mark sq, + drank lemon
ade - real pressed lemon - + wrote to family
+ talked to 2 British for people on an
excursion tour to Capri. hated Labour Gov.
Very sultry wrote + read + slept. Thunder

+ rain about 3. Set off at 5 for
S. Giovanni e Paolo to E. over many
bridges + through many alleys. It is
a huge early gothic 10 store pillar
walls of brick 1200-1400 - Burial
place of Doges - In square outside
is grt equestrian statue of Barthol-
omewo Colleoni by Verrocchio (d. 1488)
said by Ruskin to be unsurpassed
in the world! * Then down right left
+ eventually came out at Arsenal
+ water front E. of San Marco
walked east to Park + back
to St Marco. in late + cooler, aft.
grey clouds, some sun, refreshing
after 5 days of heat.



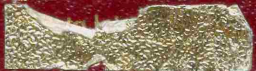
