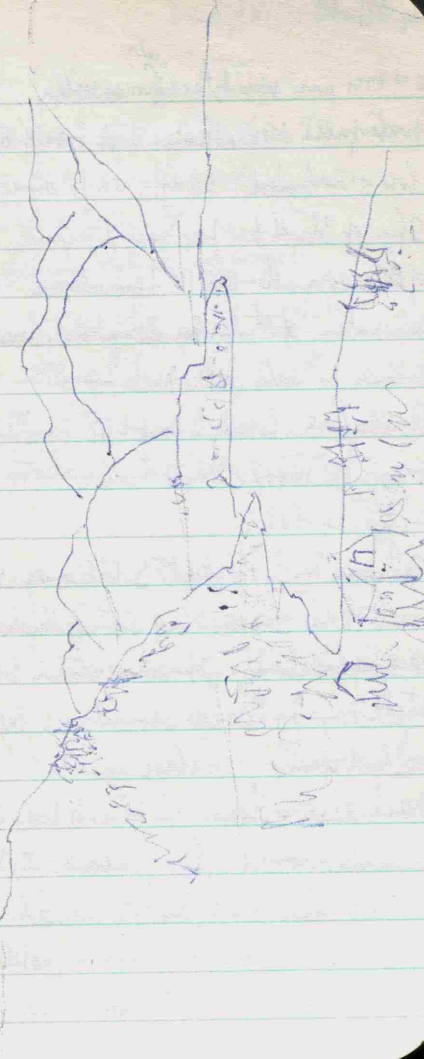

Near Ardchyle was most northern Roman outpost no. LIX. Lovely strath + views in Glen Lenny to Callander

Tonow for lunch - walked up road on other side of valley with hills + Bens + crines with fishermen - Rhododendrons.

Down through Lady of The Lake country to Callander. Saw at 2 pm to Sterling Castle - 7th battle of Stirling Bridge was at + Bannockburn Pitt the Bruce. Castle first built by combined Picts + Scots. Residence of the Kings James - one of whom murdered Earl Douglas in little ante room + his body thrown into the small garden. Wonderful sweep of view from battlements. The Ag. mines in Coliel hills to east + a Royal Mint at Stirling Castle + hence the standard Sterling silver after tea. back via Falkirk + Gravesmouth (IC) + Oil refineries + bakers factory + Forth bridges + so to Edinburgh. 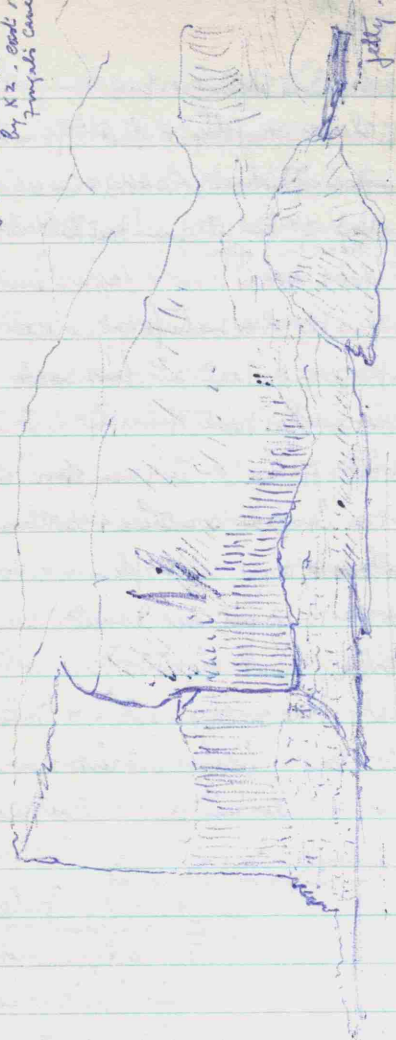
