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





FOREWORD

In 1938 the Canadian Government requested the National Gallery to accept responsibility for the Canadian Section of Fine Arts at the New York World's Fair. At the time it was proposed to devote a large proportion of the Canadian Building to this purpose and it was planned to transfer the "Century of Canadian Art" exhibition, then at the Tate Gallery, London, to New York. When later it was found impossible to secure space for more than 75 pictures, a change of programme became necessary. It was therefore decided to confine the exhibition to the work of contemporary artists, and, in order that a comprehensive review of Canadian art might be presented, to hold a series of exhibitions each lasting six weeks. In arranging these the National Gallery has received the co-operation of the five chartered art societies of the Dominion:—

The Royal Canadian Academy of Arts
The Canadian Society of Painters in Water Colour
The Sculptors' Society of Canada
The Canadian Group of Painters
The Canadian Society of Graphic Art

The Trustees of the National Gallery of Canada wish to thank the officers and members of the foregoing societies for their active and effective collaboration in this important undertaking. While each organization has been responsible for selecting the works in its particular exhibition, it has not confined the selection to its own membership.
