

Re: Settlement - class action suit

Further to this morning's telephone conversation, enclosed are photocopies of the two forms (and one copy of the text that was included with each), received from "Auction Houses Litigation" re the recent settlement of a high-profile class action lawsuit brought against Sotheby's and Christie's auction houses in New York.

Works of art acquired from these auction houses by the AEAC are listed on these forms, and I am currently having our database searched for any other works acquired from these auction houses during the period covered by the settlement. Once the search is completed, I will prepare a file for each work with photocopies from the relevant auction catalogue, as well as copies of invoices to us and records of payment by us.

My understanding of these documents is that per the terms of the settlement, the AEAC is qualified to receive compensation for premiums paid on these purchases. I would be grateful if you could review this material and let me know what I should be doing next, and what my expectations should be.


