**How to use this book.**

1. The consumer's name and address must be written (in BLOCK LETTERS) in the space provided on the reference leaf (page V).
2. When this book is issued to a child between the ages of 6 and 13 years the declaration on page V should be signed by the parent or guardian, "A" being struck out.
3. In order to buy any food that is rationed you must register with a retailer who sells that food.

**How to register with your retailer.**

4. Write the names and addresses of the retailers with whom you intend to register in the spaces inside the front cover. Write your name and address (in BLOCK LETTERS) and the date on the counterfoil at the bottom of the pages of coupons numbered 1, 3, 4, 5 and 6, then take this book to the retailers from whom you mean to buy your butchers' meat, bacon (including ham), butter and margarine, cooking fats including lard and dripping, and sugar. The retailer for each of these foods will write his name and business address on the counterfoil which he will cut off and keep.

**Purchases and coupons.**

5. Every time you buy rationed food you must hand your ration book to the retailer and he will detach the appropriate coupons. You must not detach coupons yourself. If you do, they will be useless.
6. Coupons not used in the week to which they relate cannot be used later.

**Depositing whole pages of coupons with retailers.**

7. To save trouble you may tell your retailer to detach a whole page of coupons by cutting along the line x.....x. If he does this he must write the words "page deposited," the number of the page and the date below his name and address inside the cover.

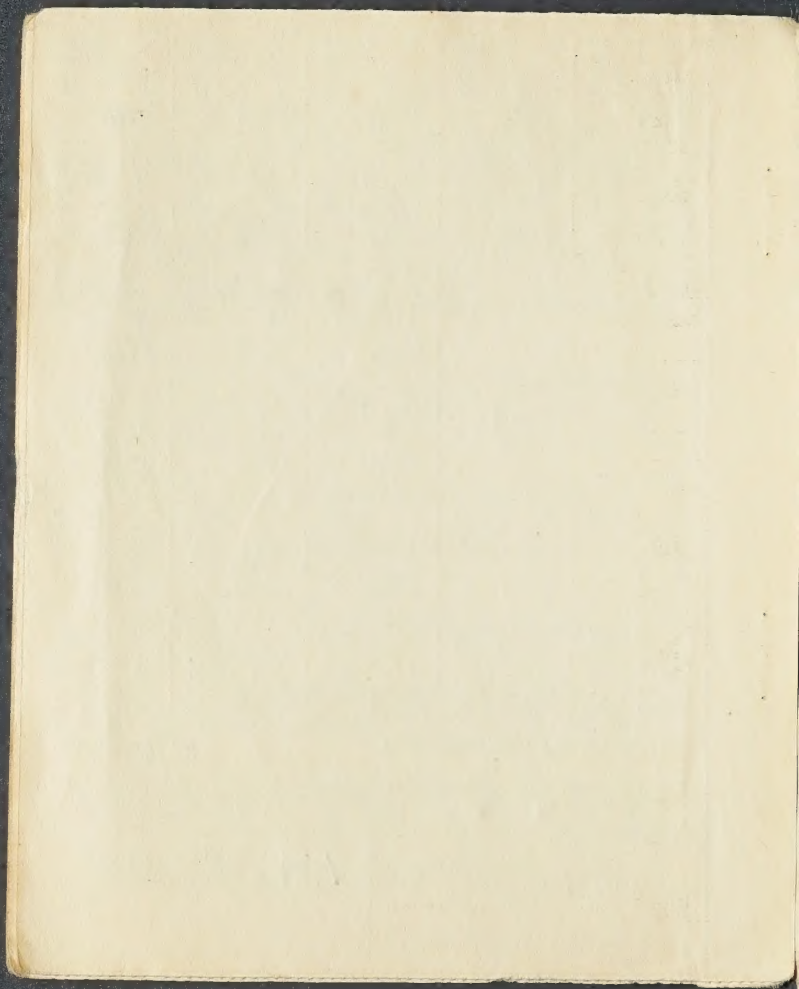
8. Do not have a page detached if you expect to go away from home on holiday or business. Do not have a page detached if you want to buy cooked meat for lunch or dinner away from home.

**Meat meals away from home.**

9. Half a meat or bacon coupon may be used to obtain a cooked meal of rationed meat or bacon in a hotel, restaurant, cafe, tea-shop, etc. The half-coupon must be detached from your ration book by the person serving the meal.

**Cooked Meat.**

10. You may purchase cooked rationed meat at cooked meat shops, but only on surrender of a coupon or half-coupon. The coupon or half-coupon must be detached from your ration book by the person supplying you.

## NOTICE TO THE HOLDER OF THIS CERTIFICATE

1. You are not permitted to travel more than five miles from your registered address without a Travel Permit from the Police of the district in which you are registered. (This does not apply to persons resident within the area comprising the Metropolitan and City of London Police Districts, making journeys within that area.)
2. You are not permitted to change your residence (from the last address shown in this Certificate) unless you have previously received permission to do so from the Police of the district in which you intend to reside; if you have received such permission you must, before you move, report the actual change to the Police of the district in which you now reside and, if your new residence is in another Police district, to the Police of the new district immediately on your arrival.
3. If you are absent from your registered address for a continuous period exceeding twenty-four hours you must report each 24 hours to the nearest Police Station and you must report your return to your registered address to the Police of the district where you are registered.
4. If you stay at an hotel, lodging-house, boarding-house or other place where lodgings are provided for payment, you must, *on arrival*, write your name, nationality, the number of this Certificate, and the address from which you have come, and, *before leaving*, must write the address to which you intend to go on the form provided for the purpose.
5. You must report to the Police of the district where you are registered, within 48 hours, any change in any of the personal particulars given within (including profession or occupation), also marriage, divorce, or death of husband or wife.
6. Your children, if not British, must have separate Certificates when they reach the age of 16.

Failure to comply with any of the above requirements, making any false statement with regard to registration or with regard to this certificate, altering this certificate or any entry upon it, refusing to produce this certificate when legally required to do so, or having in possession or using without lawful authority any forged, altered, or irregular certificate, passport, or other document concerned with registration, will render the offender liable to be detained in custody and to a fine of £100 or six months' imprisonment.

1. This Identity Card must be carefully preserved. You may need it under conditions of national emergency for important purposes. You must not lose it or allow it to be stolen. If, nevertheless, it is stolen or completely lost, you must report the fact in person at any local National Registration Office.

2. You may have to show your Identity Card to persons who are authorised by law to ask you to produce it.

3. You must not allow your Identity Card to pass into the hands of unauthorised persons or strangers. Every grown up person should be responsible for the keeping of his or her Identity Card. The Identity Card of a child should be kept by the parent or guardian or person in charge of the child for the time being.

4. Anyone finding this Card must hand it in at a Police Station or National Registration Office.

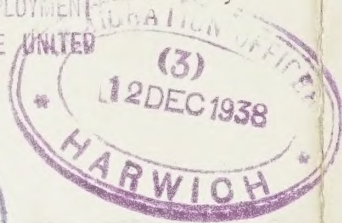
