Thank you so much for your beautiful family card with that lovely photograph with the entire family.

I am so happy that we bought our first painting together, and I want to thank you for your invoice for my half-share of £79,106.25. This payment will be due on March 8, 1996, and I will make certain that my check drawn on my English bank will be with you well before that date.

Alfred Bader Fine Arts is registered for VAT in Britain, and my VAT number is 629-0266-40.

Of the total invoice of £158,212.50, a total of £2,712.50 is for VAT.

Could you please guide me what to do about my VAT accounting? If I had bought the painting alone and then taken the painting with me to Milwaukee, <u>Christie's</u> would have refunded me the £2,712.50. Christie's will do this as of last June; before that I would have had to file with Customs & Excise for the VAT refund, and the government would have refunded that amount a few months later.

If, on the other hand, I had bought the painting in full and then left it, say, with Clovis Whitfield on consignment for sale, then my British accountant would have filed for the VAT refund of £2,712.50 and the government would have put this into my account a few months from now.

Eventually, I would have had to advise the British government what has happened to the painting. If Clovis Whitfield had sold it in Britain, then I would have had to pay VAT on my profit. If Clovis had exported it, say to Switzerland or Japan, then there would have been no VAT to be paid by me.

In my many years working with other people, I have always found that speaking frankly and sharing everything I know is the best policy, particularly when you want to become a friend of the person - such as I hope you and I will become.

I was both happy and unhappy when you called me last week to discuss the sale of our beautiful still-life.

I was happy that you sold it so quickly, and the fact that we will not be paid until the end of June is no problem at all.

You will recall that before the auction, I brought the painting to your attention, and I had the impression that you had not really looked at it before and might well not have been bidding had I not brought it to your attention. We agreed to bid to somewhere between £300,000 and £400,000, simply because it is such a beautiful painting, certainly one of Melendez' best.

Yet now you have sold it for somewhat less than we were willing to pay, but, of course, a quick sale at a reasonable profit, particularly to a potentially good buyer, has a good deal to recommend such a sale.

But if Dr. Sam Segal in Amsterdam had not recommended the painting to your customer, you would, in time, just have sold it to someone else, probably at a higher price. Hence, of course, I query the wisdom and necessity of the payment of DM 20,000. Surely, there could not have been any doubt in anybody's mind about this being a masterpiece by Melendez.

Allow me to ask a few questions about your invoice, No. 154, just received:

Over the years, I have bought a great many paintings with other dealers, with the exception of Otto Naumann, mainly in London. In none of their calculation were costs for travel, advertisements, fairs or catalogs ever charged to me, but considered the gallery's overhead.

There is, of course, no question that I should pay for half of the costs of frame, restoration and photography, and so I enclose my check for £2,165.54, representing the first three items of your invoice.

We are burdened by a fussy accountant and suspicious IRS agents, who often want documentation for everything. At your convenience, please send me copies of the invoices for frame, restoration and photography.

I have not yet received the catalog of Christie's April London auction, but as soon as I have received that, I will telephone you to discuss that large Italian landscape and also your thinking about expense allocation. It is far easier to discuss such problems verbally than to write.

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
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
