



Thank you so much for your card, from which I learned with pleasure that you had no difficulties bringing the painting home. Sometimes Dutch Customs can be very ornery.

I would just like to confirm that you have an option until the middle of November to purchase the landscape by Karl Paul, signed and dated lower left 'December 25' for U.S. \$800. Karl Paul was a German artist who studied in Dresden, born in 1890. A snapshot is enclosed. The painting is light and in a sturdy frame. Hence, as I explained, I could take the painting to England in November and then send it to you by parcel post. Coming from England, you should not have to pay any duty, though I don't know about VAT.

Next time you visit, do bring your wife, both for our pleasure of seeing her and for ease of picking paintings.





The cost to you here in Milwaukee is \$700.00. There will of course be no charge to take it by hand to England, nor for the packing, but only for the parcel post charges from Bexhill to Velp.

I believe that you have a U.S. account and would much appreciate your sending me a dollar check for \$700.00 plus postage after you have received the painting.

Dutch dealers come here quite often and usually take some paintings with them. But then when they pay in dollar checks drawn on Dutch banks, I lose somewhere between \$25 and \$60 per check! And you know how careful I am with money.
