

Following this page are the faxes for the three pages of the page-proofs which I received. You will note that the only corrections are putting the various titles into italics and adding one comma on page two after "importance of Herb Brown's hydroboration,".

As in your copy, the last four lines of the page-proofs are missing. Looking at the galley-proofs, the last four lines are fine. In fact, in the galley-proofs, the various titles are in italics and only the one comma is missing.
