We would confirm to yourself the receipt of the additional works that you delivered personally into our warehouse yesterday, 17th July. We would also like to take this opportunity to thank you for the cheque that you left for the amount of £670.00. As agreed this was worked on an estimated price that was given to yourself for guidance purposes only.

Now that we have the works altogether within our warehouse we have been able to assess correctly the pack that will be required for these works with the necessary amount of foam etc., within the case to enable safe carriage.
