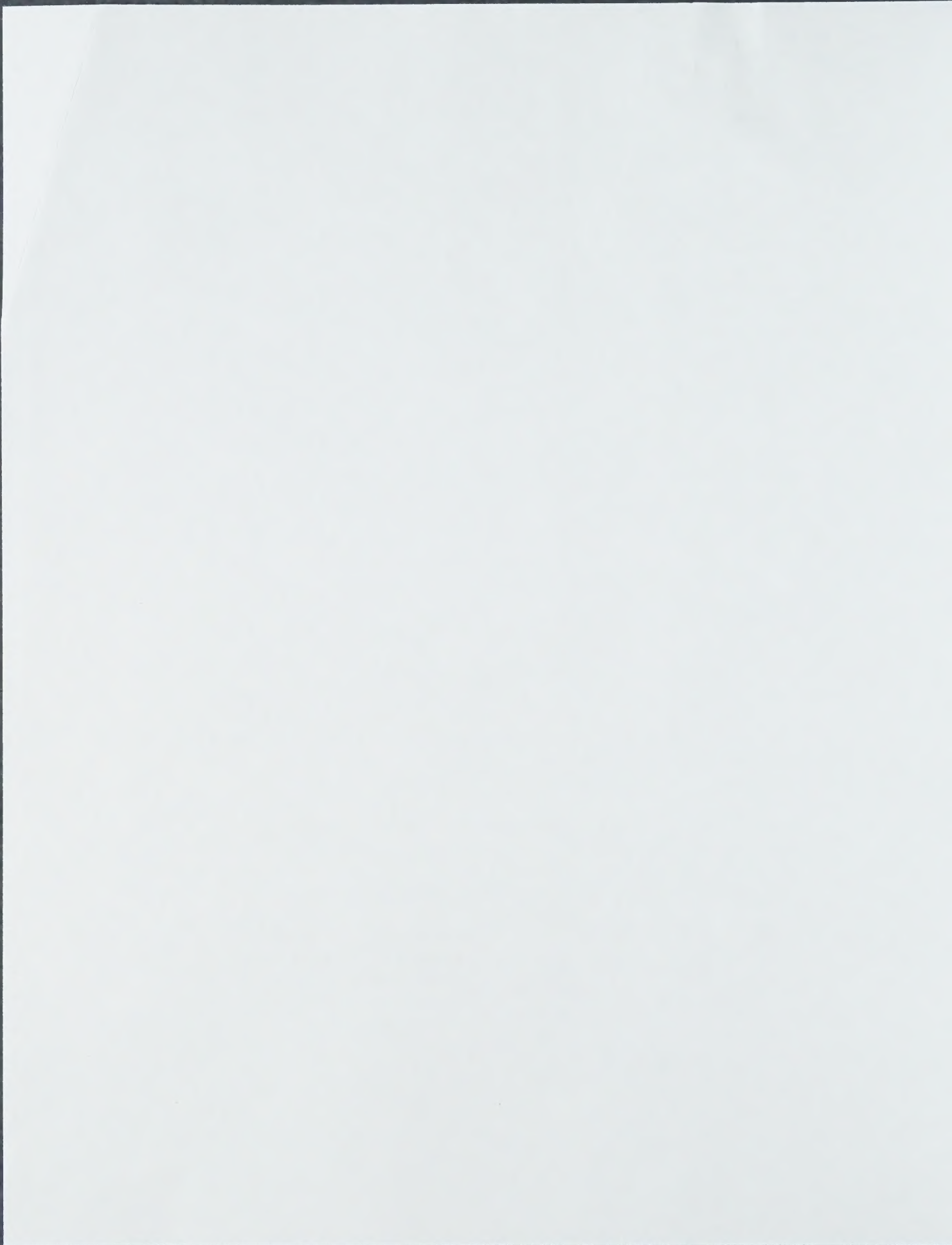
Dear Carl:

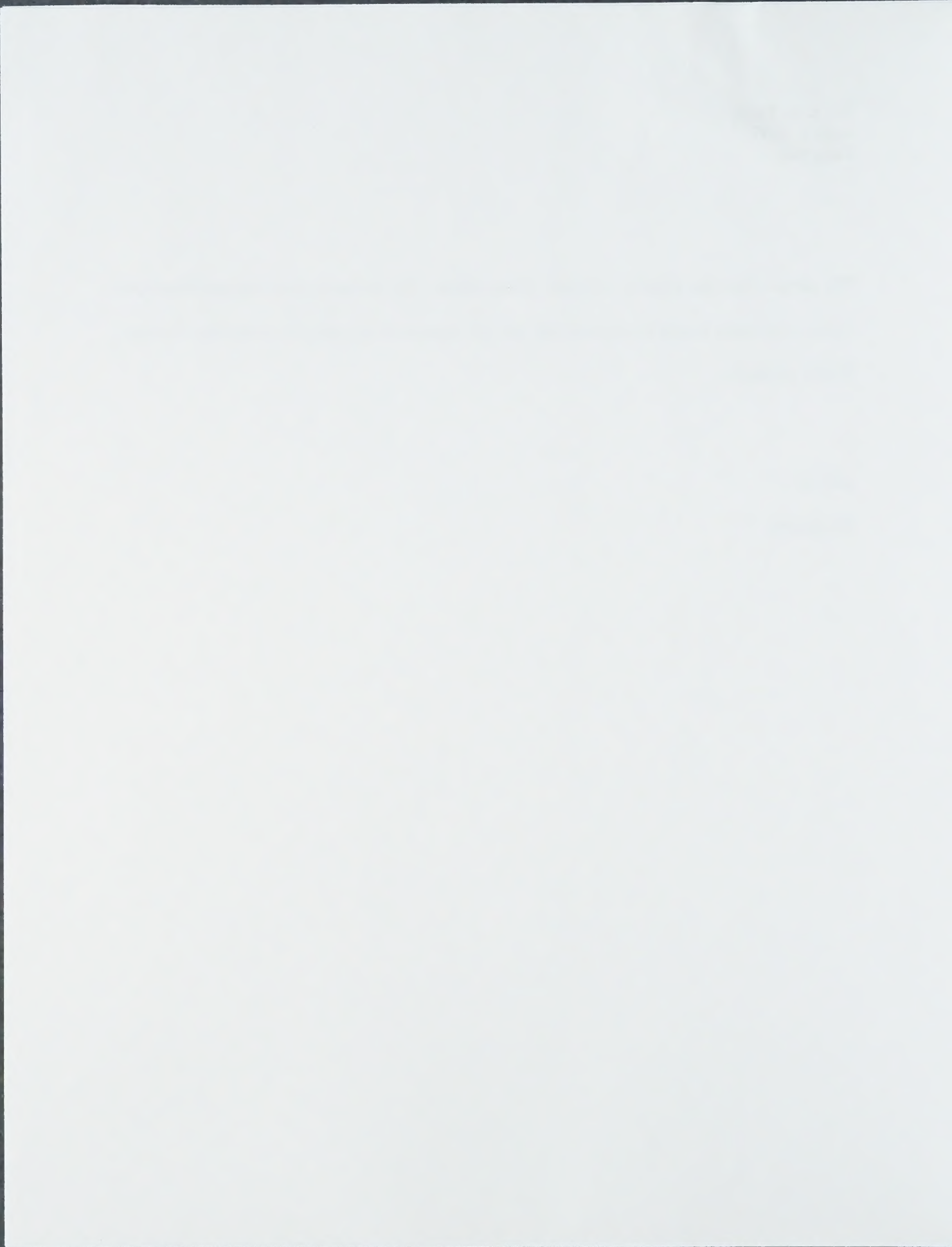
The carved Canadian goose is beautiful. Many thanks. Do you know anything about the artist?

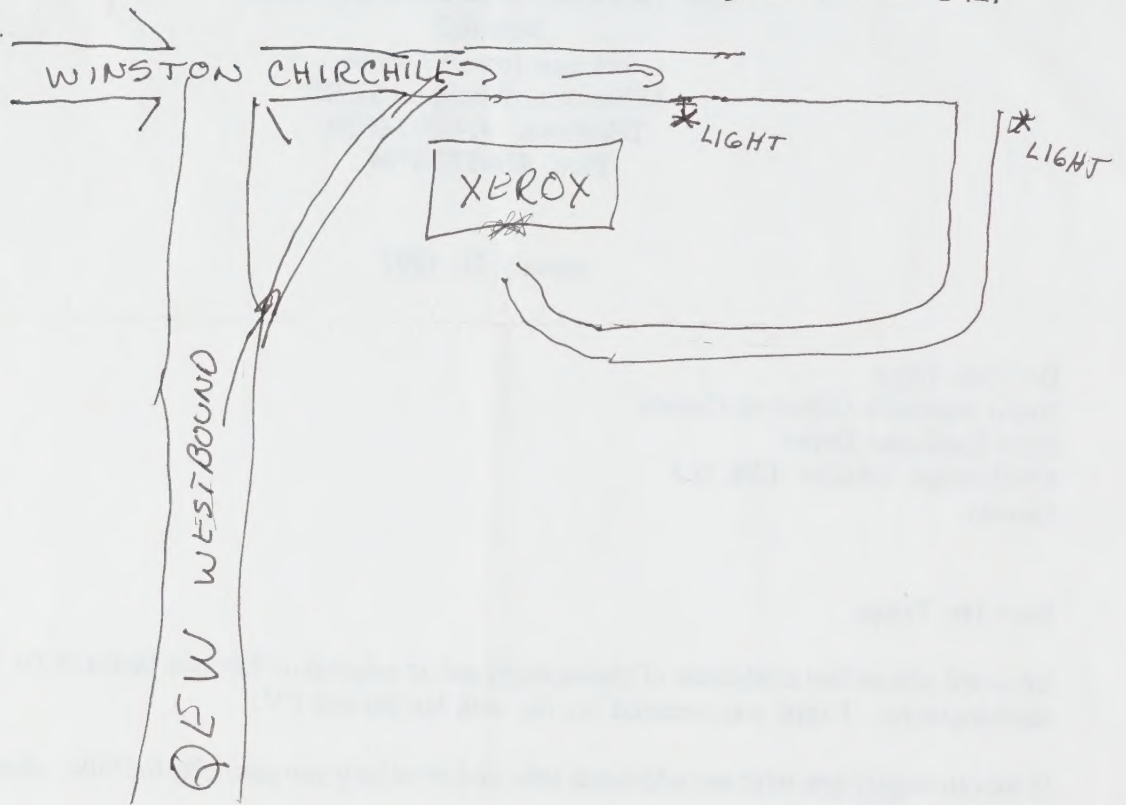

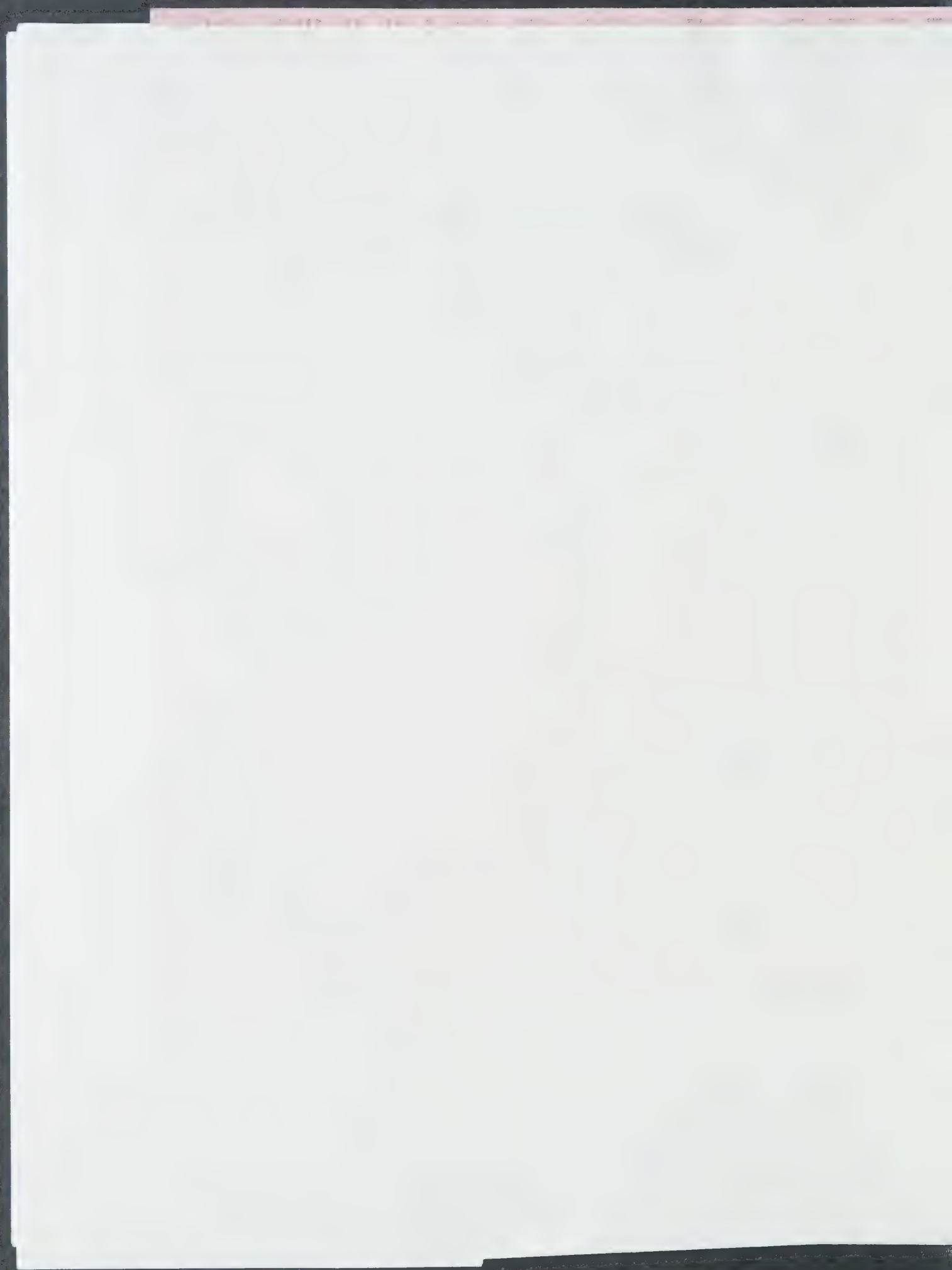
