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
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


Dear Dr. Bader,

Thank you for your kind letter of 13 April.

What happened is the following: when you circulated my letter to you in Sigma it also fell into Dr. Cori's hands. He asked Aron Fischer if he knew me because he thought that I could be a candidate for creating the Brazilian subsidiary of Sigma-Aldrich Corporation. Aron, of course, told him that he knew me quite well. They called me and invited me to St. Louis to talk about their ideas and as I had just retired from the company I had founded and directed for 22 years and was getting cabin fever staying at home, I accepted. I made a simple project with an action plan and a finance plan, it was approved and we started.
