Regarding Midwest region meeting for KTA and KTA2 members



Dear Ms. Hamlet,

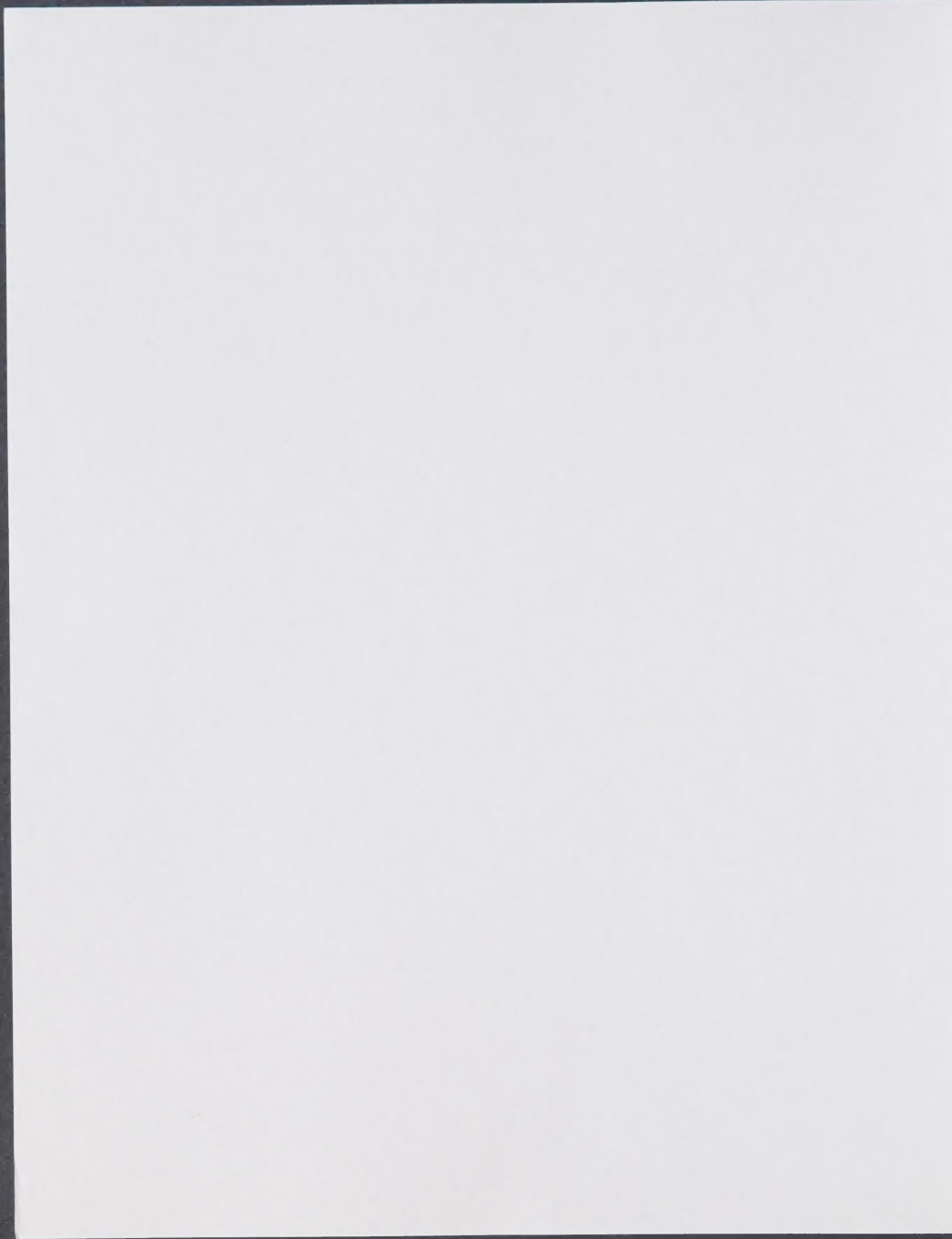
Thank you for your note about a Midwest KTA meeting.

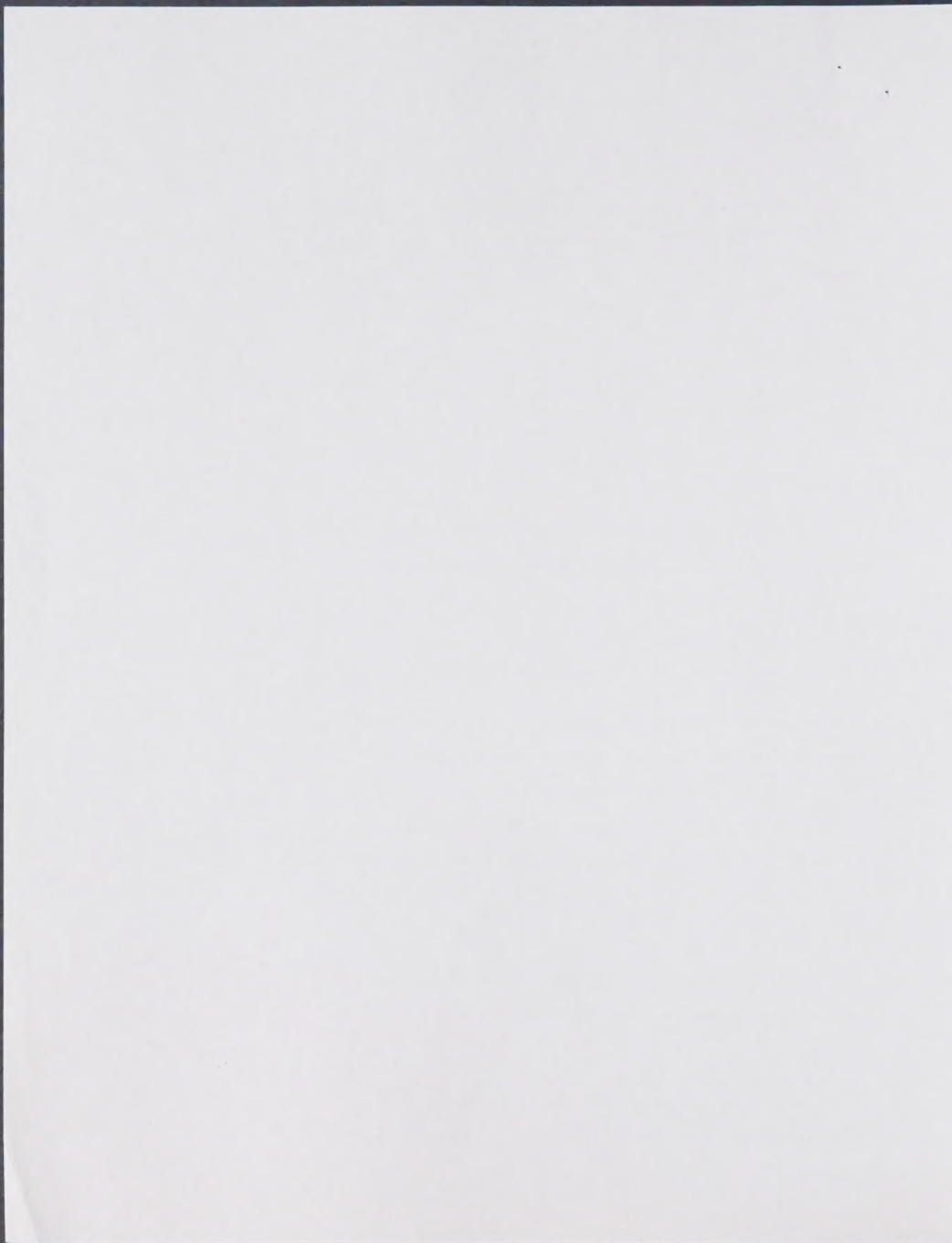
Rose Bechhoefer, author of "Rosa's Child", for a discussion on "The challenge of our changing identities."

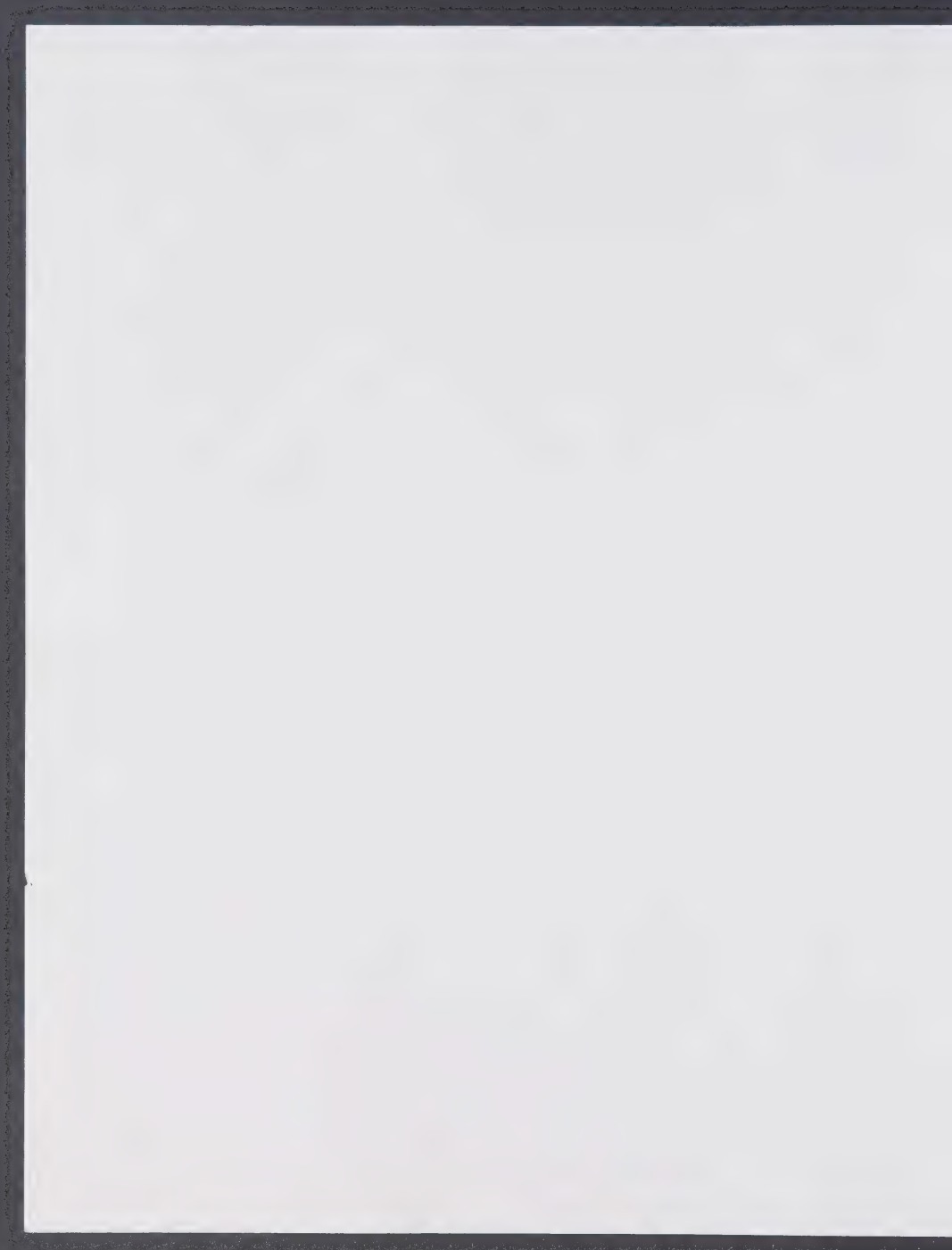

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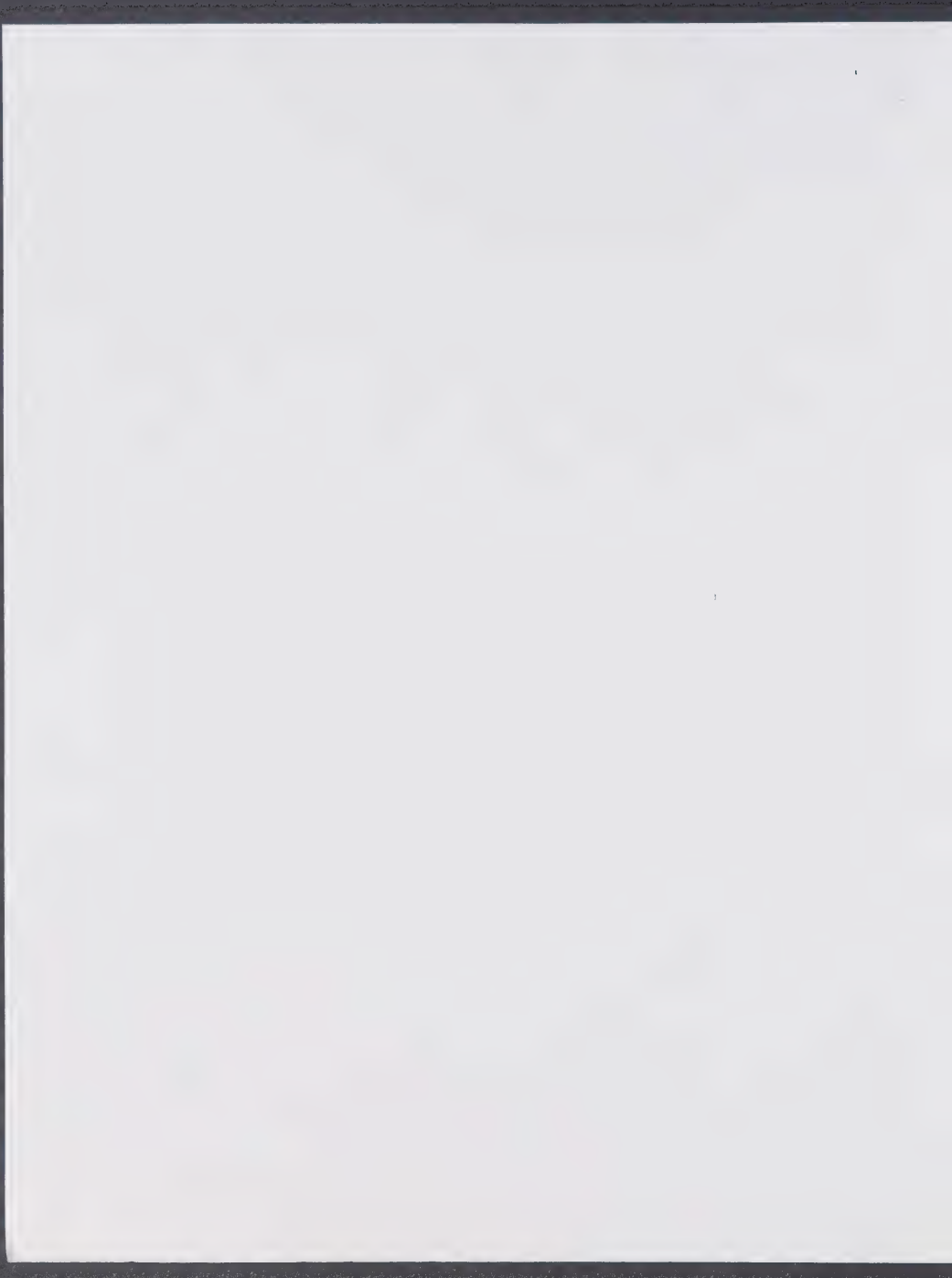
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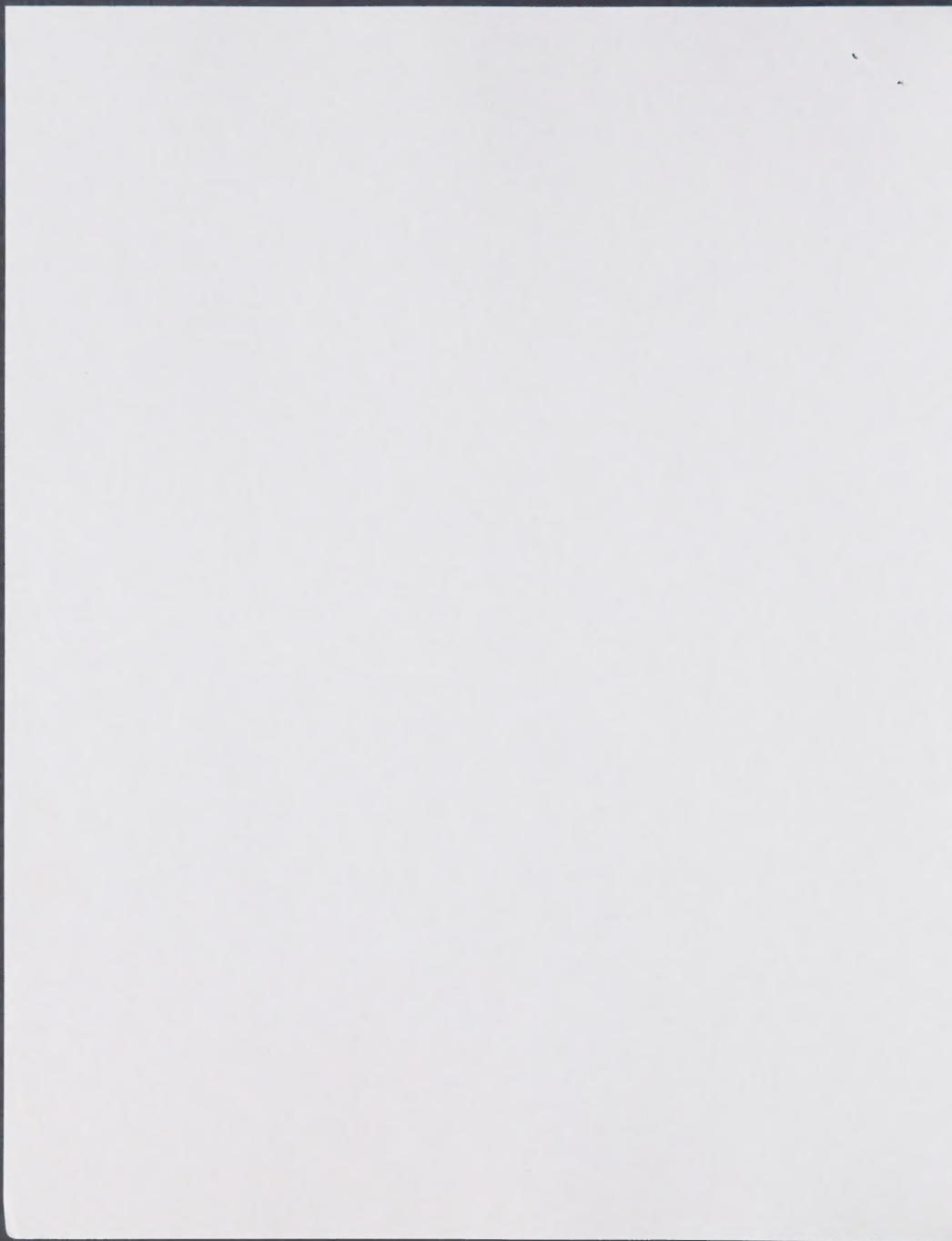
