Dear Dr. Collat:

Thank you so much for taking such good care of Isabel and me during our stay in Anaheim. You must have realized how very much we enjoyed the Parsons Award dinner and ceremony and everything relating to it.

I noted that with the Parsons Award of \$3,000 come travel expenses not to exceed \$1,000.

My travel expenses, totaling \$1,048.30, require some explanation and possibly amendment by you.

Isabel and I traveled from Milwaukee to Los Angeles and thence to Vancouver and Edmonton, where the Canadian Institute of Chemistry had agreed to pay for 1/2 of our travel expenses, and of course, I should cover Isabel's expenses. My own total airfare cost was \$809.33, and so I have put 1/2 of that (\$404.66) onto the enclosed expense report.

I am not at all certain that my ACS registration fee of \$85.00 should be included, and if not, please just delete it. The cost of meals was, of course, just the cost for me and excludes the cost of meals for Isabel.

Of course, the cost of the hotel was for the room shared Isabel and me, but I believe that had I been there alone, it would at most have been less expensive by just a few dollars.



In any case, please correct this statement as you see fit, and I'll then look forward to your check.

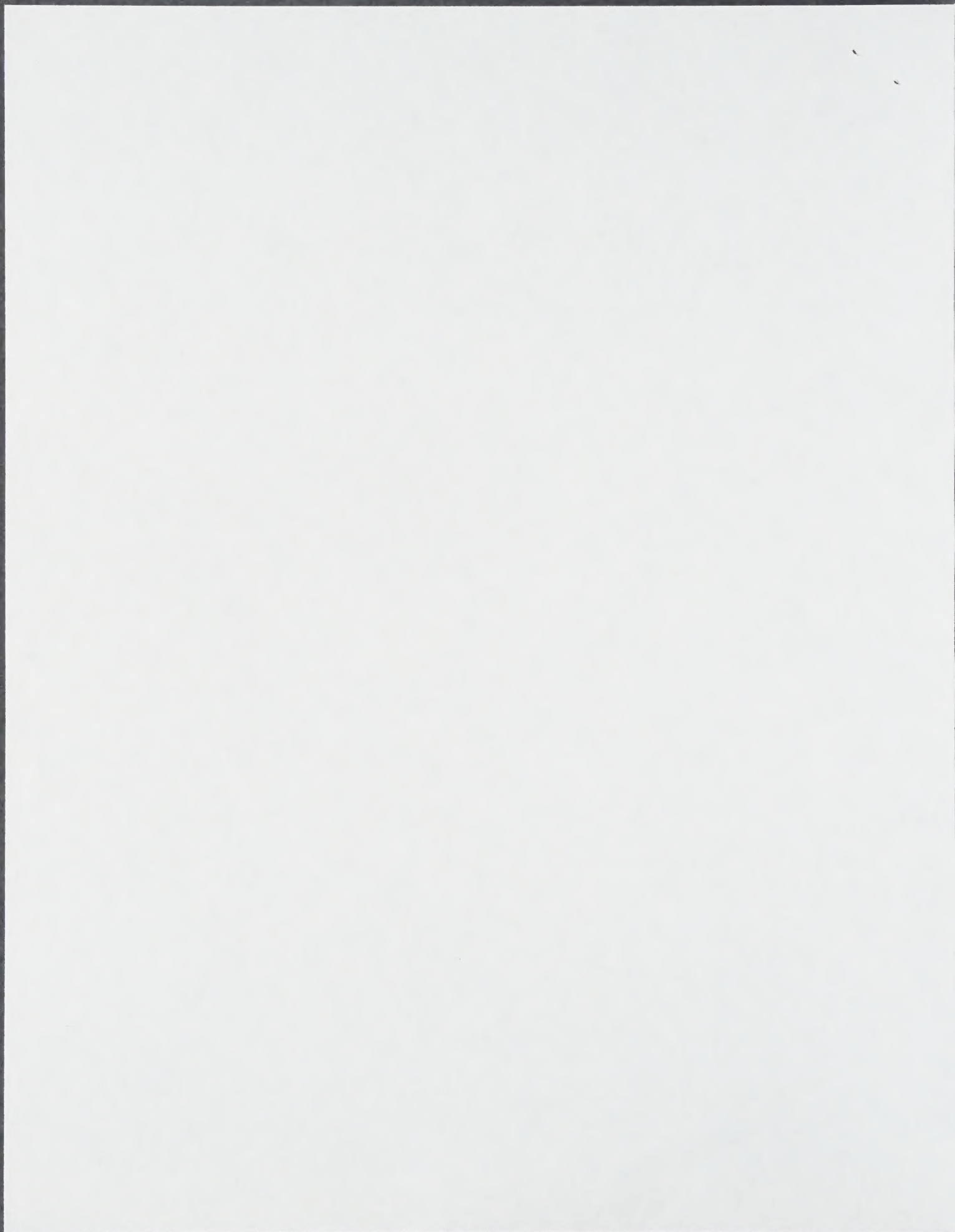

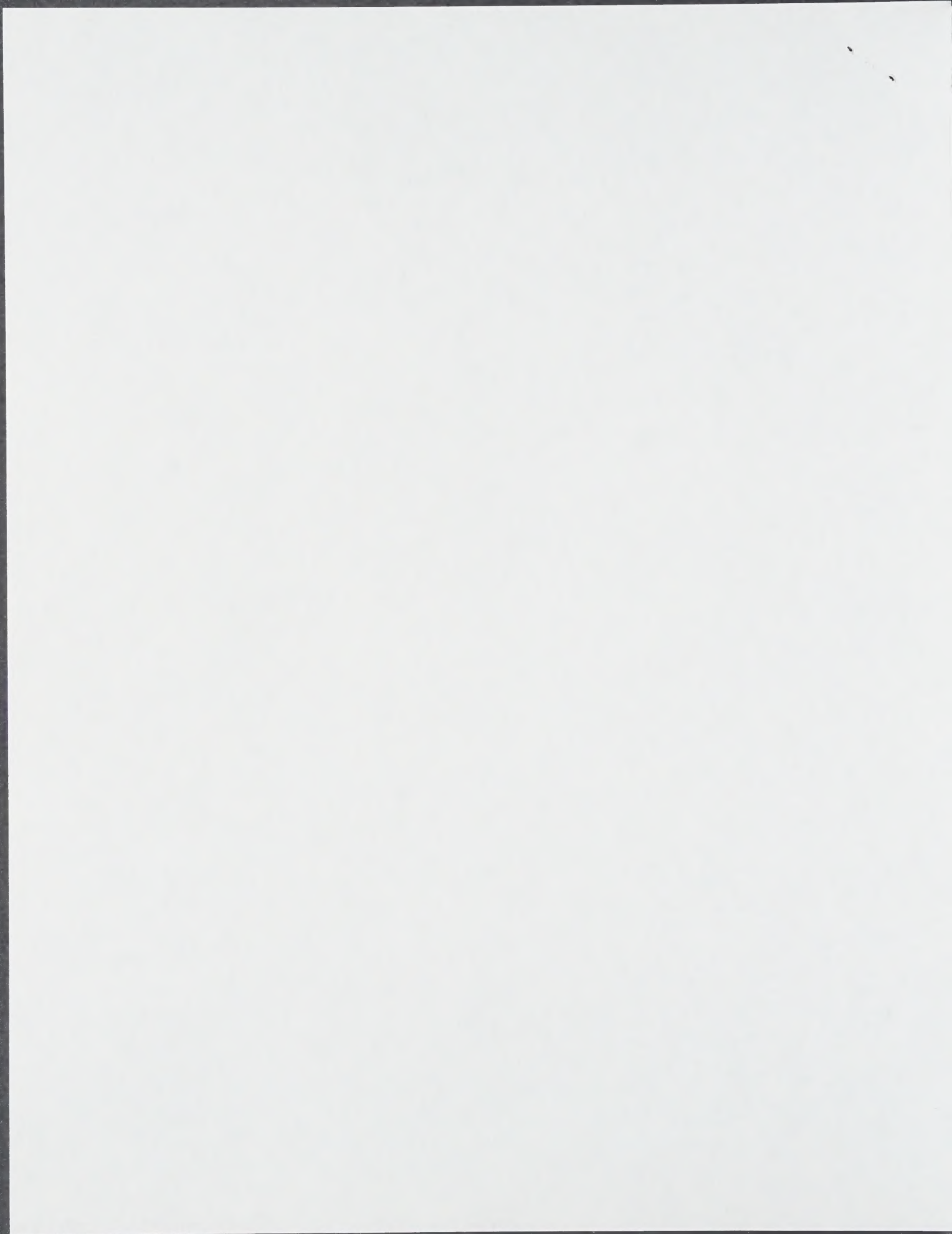

Dear Dr. Bader:


