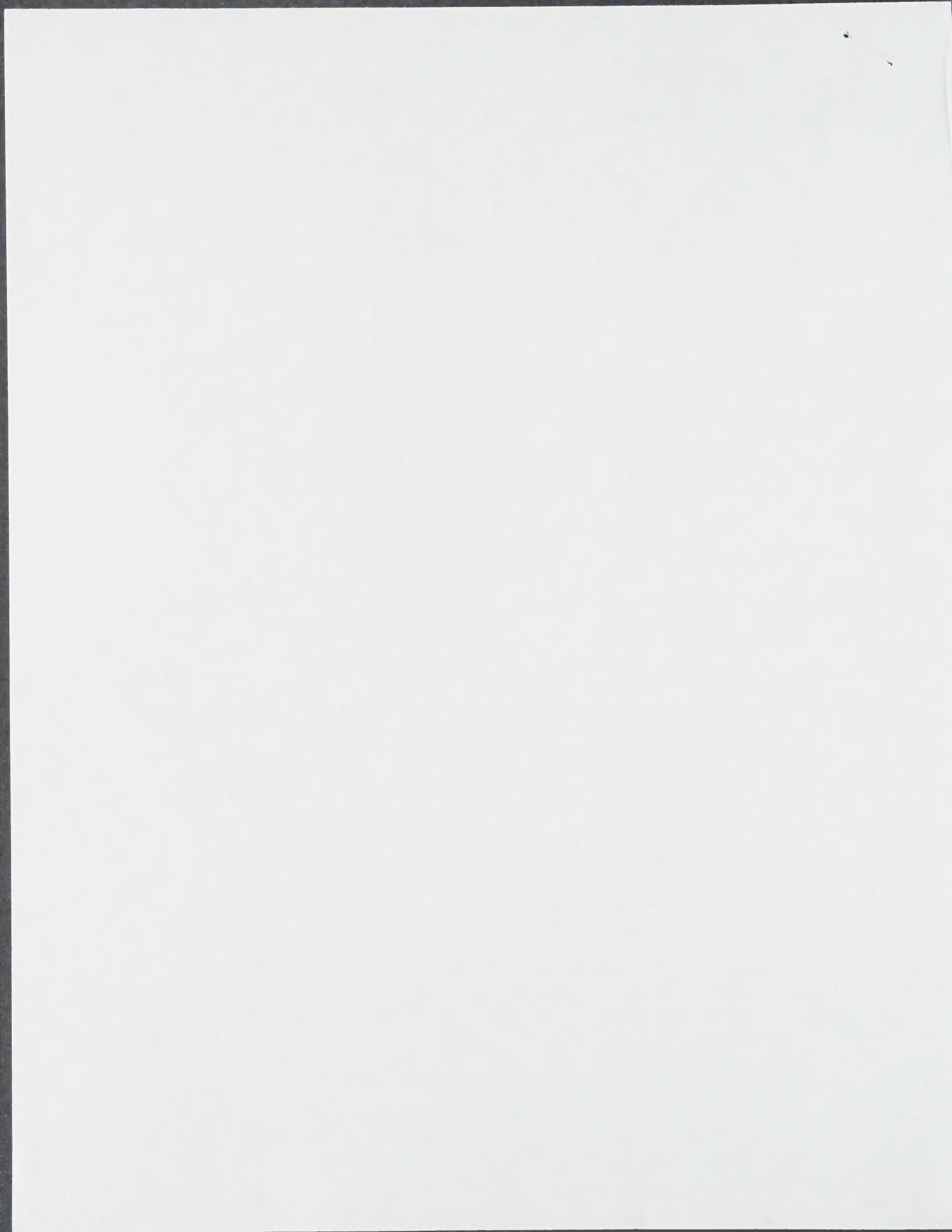
To turn now to the two days in Toronto:



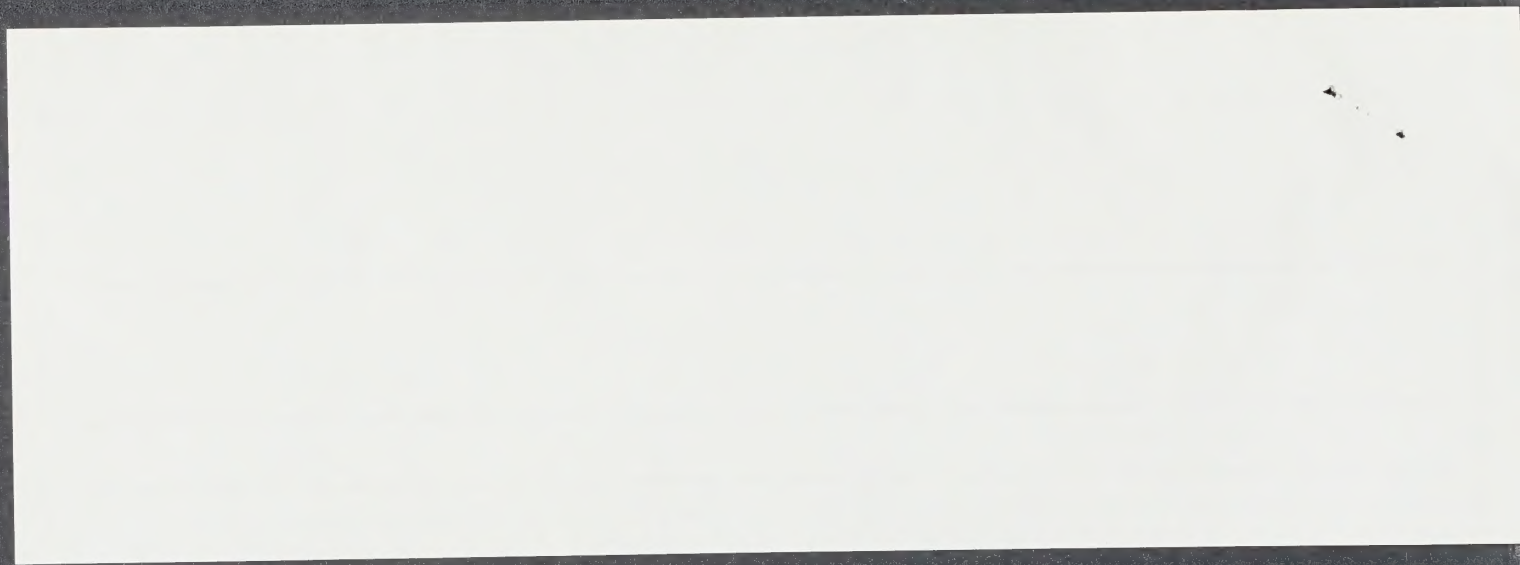

Dear Dr. Bader,

I am writing in response to the fax you sent to Florence Campbell earlier today. Florence is in meetings all day and has asked me to send you a reply on her behalf. We are delighted that your meetings with Queen's alumni in Vancouver and Edmonton went well and we look forward to the two upcoming events in Toronto and Guelph.

About 20 people in the Office of Advancement met on Monday afternoon to listen to your interview with Vicki Gabereau. We all thought it went very well. I hope you were satisfied with it. The university radio station, CFRC, taped the interview and already a number of people across campus have asked for copies of it. I will have a copy made for you and will give it to you personally when we meet at the Guelph event.

I have been organizing the Toronto Branch event (scheduled to take place on Wednesday, May 17) with Kari Andersen, the Development Officer responsible for fund raising for the Agnes Etherington Art Centre and Branch President, Rick Powers. This event will be for Queen's alumni and for prospects for the Art Centre campaign. We tried to hold the event at the Art Gallery of Ontario as you suggested but unfortunately it was previously booked for that evening. Because Mrs. Bader is receiving an honorary degree at Victoria University the following day, we felt that the next logical location would be the Alumni Hall at Victoria University. It is a lovely room with a reception area in the foyer. They will provide the slide projectors and screens. We thought this would also be very convenient since Alumni Hall is located at 91 Charles Street West, not far from the Park Plaza Hotel where you and Mrs. Bader will be staying. We would be pleased to have someone pick you and Mrs. Bader up at your hotel and take you to the reception. Please let me know if that is acceptable. Although you probably don't need it since Mrs. Bader is a graduate, I am also sending a copy of a map of the Victoria University Campus.








We had originally intended to have a reception starting at 5:30 pm with you giving your presentation from 7:00 to 8:00 pm. In order to accommodate your wish to have dinner with the President of Victoria University that evening we could move the whole event forward by half an hour. Thus we would start the reception at 5:00 pm and have your presentation from 6:15 pm until 7:15 pm. This would give you time to set up your slides and still give you 45-60 minutes at the reception to meet alumni and then 15 minutes after your presentation to answer questions (I am assuming that your presentation will take one full hour).

We would be happy to invite President Runte along with the Kushners and Clarkes to join us for the reception and your presentation which they might like to hear. Your entire party could then leave at your joint discretion after your presentation to have dinner at President Runte's home. Please let me know if this is a suitable arrangement. Also if there is anyone else you or Mrs. Bader would like to invite to the alumni event, we would be happy to send an invitation to them.

We would like to confirm the name of the lecture you would like to give in Toronto so that we can print it on the invitations. You had mentioned the Rembrandt Project or the Chemist Collector. Both are equally fascinating lectures and would be very well received.

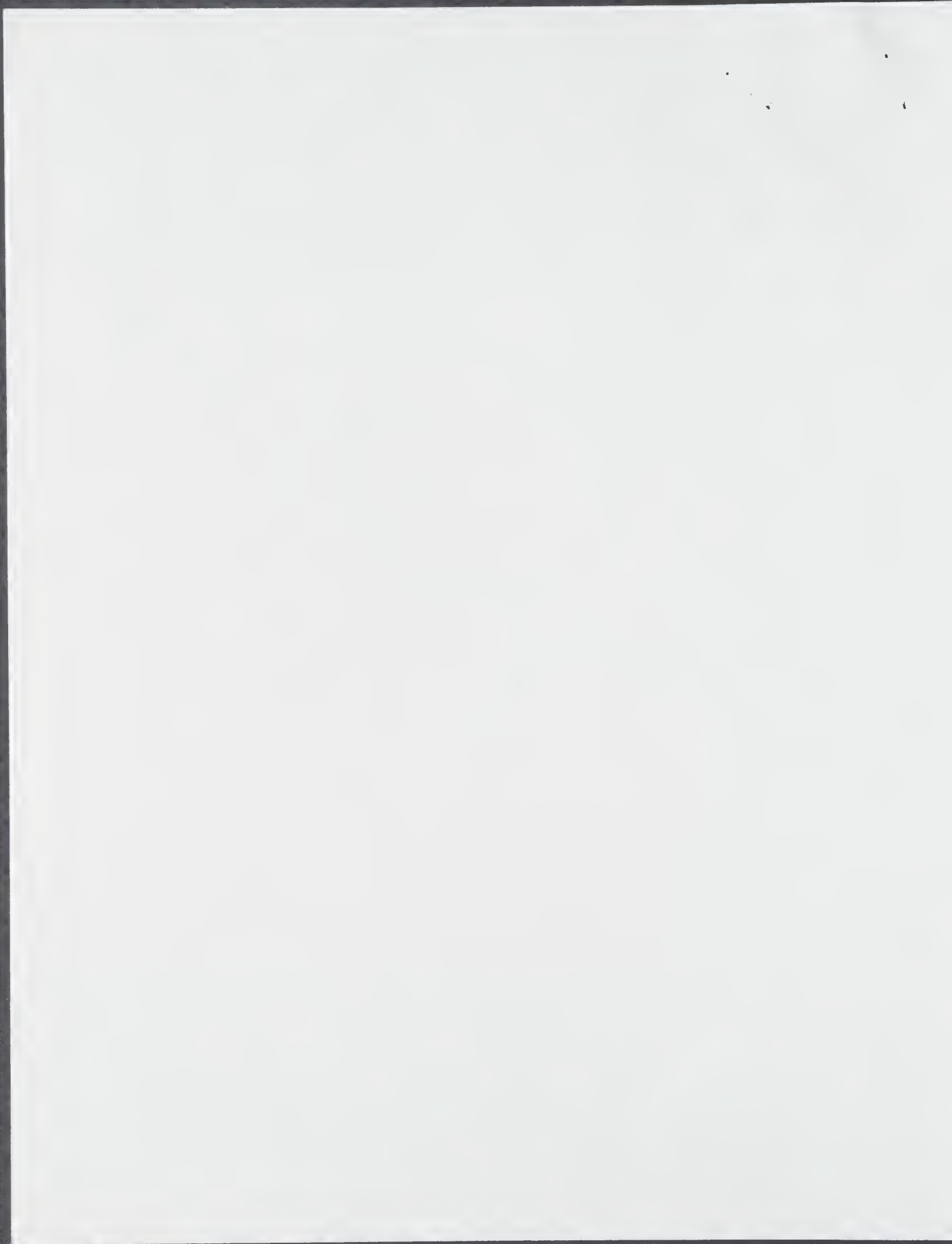

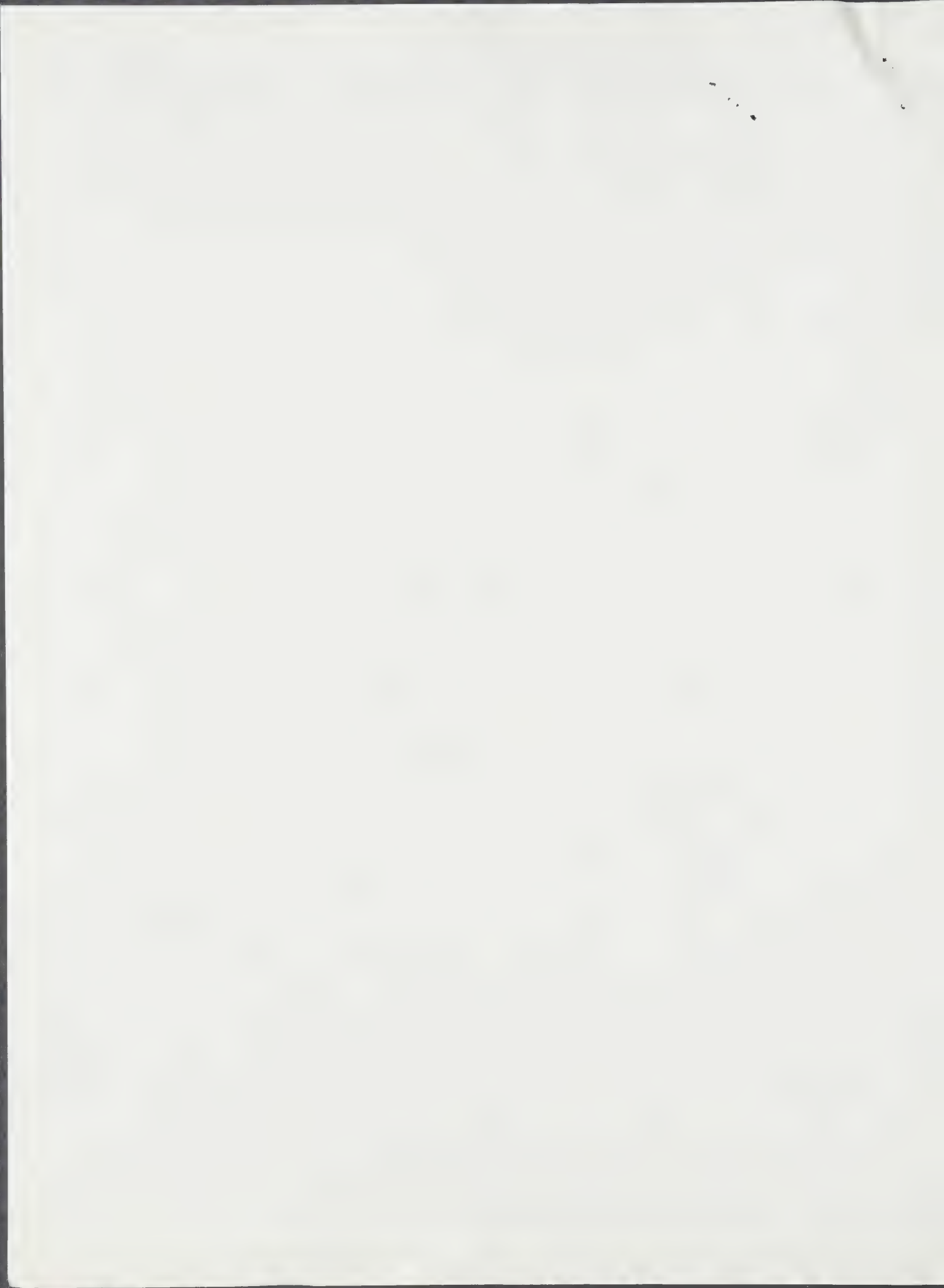

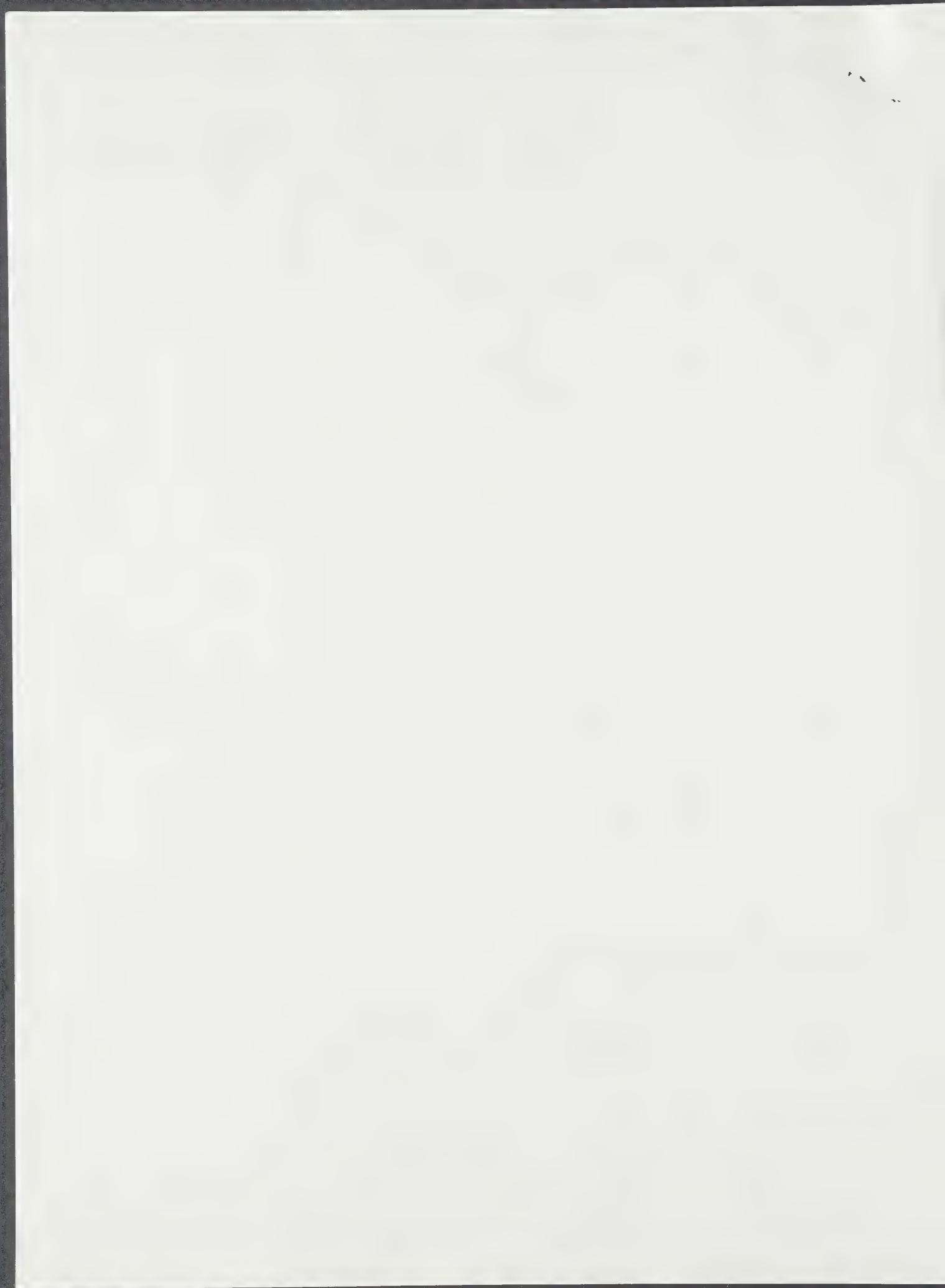
