Your instructions on Calvary payment were loud and clear. Balance in your personal account is \$1,597,626 per Noelle yesterday.

We will transfer \$1.7 million from Marshall Fund and \$500,000 from your personal account into ABFA checking when the check is presented.

\$66,667 will remain in ABFA after the check is presented and we have 6,642 currently in the account for a \$73,300 balance

To follow your instructions, we need a total of \$99,000 in order to maintain \$20,000 in both ABFA and Marshall accounts and cover Clovis' check. B&K will be able to transfer about \$23,000 into ABFA on 7/31, after we pay the property taxes which are due on 7/31. July 25, 2000--Overall results: Sigma-Aldrich Corporation is pleased to report increased sales and

earnings per share from its chemical business for the second quarter and first six months of 2000. For

the second quarter of 2000, diluted net income per share from chemical operations rose 18.4% to \$.4 per share from \$.38 in 1999. For the six-month period, diluted earnings per share from chemical operations were \$.90 compared to \$.77 for 1999, a 16.9% increase. Operations of the B-Line System

metal business, which was sold to Cooper Industries on May 1, 2000, added \$.03 and \$.11 to diluted

Chemicals: Excluding the impact of currency exchange rates, sales grew 7.6% for both the second quarter and first six months of 2000. As reported, sales increased 4.5% to \$267.8 million in the second quarter and 4.4% to \$551.8 million for the first half of 2000. Overall price and volume gains in the second quarter were consistent with those achieved in the first quarter of the year and an improveme of levels achieved in 1999. Laboratory and life science products, which represent 75% of total chemic sales and are used in both life science and other high tech research, had above average sales gains from increased prices, proactive customer contact by sales forces, increased electronic orders and the distribution of new cell signaling and life science catalogs in the second quarter. Enhancements in and active promotion of e-commerce capabilities increased the electronic order rate to over 7% of our U.S. research sales and 3.5% of worldwide research sales at the end of the second quarter. Improved demand from pharmaceutical customers provided low double-digit volume gains in fine chemical sales Competitive pricing and fewer instrument placements reduced diagnostic sales.

Pretax income of 20.5% of sales in the second quarter and 20.9% of sales for the first half of 2000 ar in line with expectations. Benefits from price increases and costs eliminated through restructuring and ongoing process improvement activities were offset by the cost of the new catalogs, higher levels of sales efforts with both existing and potential customers and efforts to continually upgrade our award winning web site and internal operating systems to maintain service levels that distinguish Sigma-Aldrich. Interest expense reduced the otherwise reportable pretax gain by \$1.4 million and \$3. million for the three and six-month periods ended June 30, 2000. Net income from continuing operations reflects investment for enhanced growth of the Company which is expected to continually increase overall internal sales growth from current rates to 10% by the end of 2001.

Metals: The sale of the B-Line Systems metal business to Cooper Industries, Inc. was completed on M 1, 2000. At that time, the initial purchase price of \$425.2 million was received. The buyer is reviewing purchase price adjustment, which is expected to add approximately \$6 million to the initial price to reflect recent performance for this business prior to sale and other sale agreement adjustments. The gain on the sale, which includes this purchase price adjustment, is \$171.8 million. Results for this discontinued operation also added \$.03 and \$.11 to total Company diluted earnings per share for the second quarter and first six months of 2000, respectively.

Share Repurchase: The previously authorized repurchase of 20 million shares of Common Stock was completed early in June 2000. At that time, the Board of Directors authorized the purchase of an additional 5 million shares. At June 30, 2000, a total of 20.3 million shares had been acquired and 80. million shares are outstanding. Additional purchases in July 2000 bring the total shares repurchased t date to 20.6 million shares at an average purchase price of \$30.08. The Company expects to continue share repurchases to acquire the remaining 4.4 million shares, but the timing and number of shares repurchased will depend upon market conditions and other factors.

Working Capital: Cash received from the sale of the B-Line Systems business has been used to reduce outstanding borrowings and continue share repurchases. Short-term borrowings outstanding at June 2000 were also used to continue the share repurchase program. Progress on tighter management of other working capital items continued. Accounts receivable declined by \$7 million from first quarter levels while chemical inventories grew a modest 1.9% from their December 31, 1999 levels.

Outlook: Implementation of strategic plan initiatives to achieve an annual internal sales growth rate o 10% by the end of 2001 is progressing satisfactorily. Sales growth for the remainder of 2000 is expected to improve. We continue to strengthen the fundamentals and service associated with both Laboratory and Life Science products. Worldwide distribution of new cell signaling, life science and organic chemical catalogs will improve our market position, aided by new product launches in the fast growing areas of DNA purification and amplification, gene expression and cell growth and ongoing

strength in sales of synthetic DNA. Continued exploitation of our unique fine chemical manufacturing capabilities should provide continued above average gains in this business. We remain confident that longer-term sales performance will improve for our Diagnostic business as we pursue niche markets, point of care, and OEM opportunities.

Investments in our future will reduce second half profit margins for our underlying chemical operation below those achieved in the second quarter of 2000. We will continue to invest in growth with increas spending for research and development, expanded sales and marketing activities, continuing investm in information systems and other planned strategic initiatives. By using the full strength of our organization to control costs, we should partially offset these investments, resulting in otherwise seco half earnings per share for our underlying chemical operations equivalent to those achieved in the firs half of the year. But, interest expense to facilitate continued share repurchases and announced acquisitions will reduce these otherwise reported earnings in the second half by \$.02 per share, with share repurchases enhancing earnings per share growth.

Furthermore, as announced on July 24, 2000, marketing and development costs associated with the acquisition of First Medical, Inc. will further reduce projected earnings for Sigma-Aldrich in the last hal of 2000 by up to \$.04 per share. For additional details on this acquisition, see our July 24, 2000 relea "Sigma-Aldrich Acquires First Medical, Inc. To Enhance Position In Cardiac Assessment And Expand In Point Of Care Diagnostics". As a result of all of the above, overall earnings per share for the second ha of 2000 may be up to \$.06 per share lower than those achieved in the first half. A special charge for purchased research and development in process will result in an additional one-time, non-cash charge in the third quarter of 2000 of \$.02-.05 per share.

Now you get direct service.

I spent the weekend studying the user's guide. It contains 25 pages of clearly worded explanations, written flawlessly. But still-25 pages

I pored over the manual, and now I'm

ready-I think-to climb on the bandwagon of electronic telephony.

Shall we give it a try?

First I have to dial the number that gives me access to the system (say, 285-7887). But from my house that's a long distance call, so I have to

dial 0-514-285-7887, plus 19 for service in French. Then I have to punch in my Bell calling-card number, another 14 digits. Are you still with me? At central messaging, they ask for both my mailbox number (say, 1259) and password (say, 8891). Let's recap: 0-514-285-7887-19-23432547-9088-71-1259-8891.

Nice and short, isn't it? But a

recorded message informs me that I've entered the wrong access code. The wrong access code? Right. I forgot to press the pound (#) key after entering my password. So I start over: 0-514-285-7887-19-23432547-9088-71-1259-8891-#. Hurray!

"You have two new messages. Message number 1, received at 2:06

p.m. To listen to your message, press 2; to go on to your next message, press 6; to return to the previous message, press 4..."

"What?"

"For more information, press the star key."

"The star key? Okay, the star

key."

"You are now at the main menu. Several options are available to you. To reach the caller, press 9; to answer, press 71; to send one message to several subscribers at the same time, press 74; to transfer the call to another phone, press 73; to erase, press 76; to review op-

tions, press 7, then the star key...

As I was saying, I used to have to call the switchboard operator.

"Hi Mary, any messages for me?"

"Yes, you've got two."

Occasionally she'd ask me, "Is it snowing up there?" or "How are the cats?" In short, I'd be wasting time.

Dear Mr. Kofuku,

Herewith I am enclosing a copy of Alain Goldrach's condition report on the painting by Golder. As you can read, he feels as I do that the Acrt de Gelder. As you can read, he feels as I do, that the overpainting is excessive, and the picture could look just as good or even better with less restoration.

Incidentally, his estimate for a complete restoration of the painting in the proper manner would be \$6,000 to \$7,500.

If you are very seriously interested in the painting, and you would buy it if the condition were acceptable, I would suggest that we go ahead and re-restore the painting, documenting the progress as we go, and you will then have a better idea of the true state of preservation of the picture.

You were probably able to see in the exhibition catalogue to the Aert de Gelder show that this painting is one of the artist's masterpieces. I am certain that this is one of the last chances that one will ever have of buying such a major picture by this master.

Condition Report, June 22, 2000:

The quite large canvas was relined with glue, probably in the nineteenth century. The painting was cleaned and restored quite recently; and one must admit that in regular light with the naked eye the painting appears to be in good state of preservation. However, under ultra-violet one can clearly see an extensive network of retouches or more aptly reinforcements, strengthening and outright reglazing. Below the retouches lay a very opaque layer of varnish that must have been applied prior to the retouching. One can confidently say that because of the boldness and free handling of the restoration, possibly few of the repaints cover actual damages, like tears or losses, but more likely cover some thinnesses and abrasions. One must also mention that in spite of the restoration the painting reads well. It is my opinion that a large portion of this restoration is cosmetic and unnecessary. One could accomplish the same effect with far less inpainting.

Dear Dr. Kofuku,

The painting by Arent de Gelder, Tobias in the House of Edna and Raguel, is still in my gallery. It had been unavailable for sale for over one year, while it was in the Arent de Gelder exhibition in Dordrecht and Cologne

last year (no. 29 in the catalogue). The price of \$850,000 has never changed.

As I'm sure you know, it is one of the most important paintings by this artist to come on the market in many years. When it was with Agnews in London in the mid 1980s, the price was 1.7 million pounds! This was ridiculous, which the former owner realized when he took it away from Agnews. Luckily, through an agent in Amsterdam, I came in contact with the owner and purchased the picture. I still make a profit at \$850,000, but not a huge one, especially if one takes into account the cost of money for the years I have owned the painting.

I have looked at the painting under the blacklight, and unfortunately there are quite a few areas of inpainting. However, I honestly believe that all of the inpainting is cosmetic. Most of it follows the forms, so I believe the last restorer was simply "sprucing up" the painting. According to the last owner, Agnews had the painting cleaned in London, and I can even guess who did it! In all liklihood, it was the Hume Brothers,

restorers who are notorious for overly inpainting pictures in excellent condition.

What I would suggest is that you get the report of a local restorer in New York before you proceed. I am confident that a good restorer will see that the painting is in a very good state of preservation. I would suggest Alain Goldrach, who works mainly for museums, or Simon Parkes, who does a lot of work for privates and Sotheby's as well as dealers.
