I have always worn baggy trousers, but didn't acquire a briefcase until long after 1941.

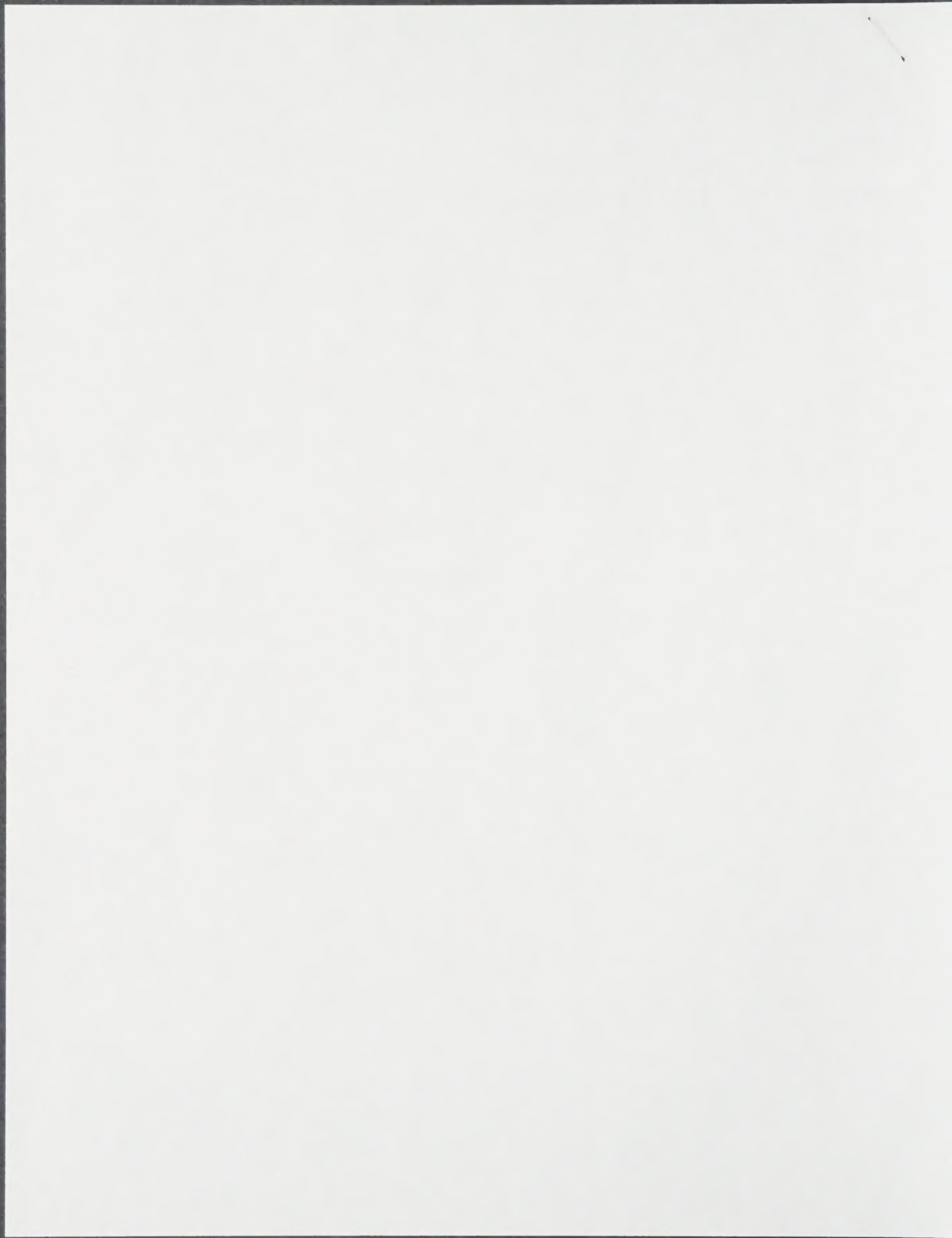
Where do you believe that we met?

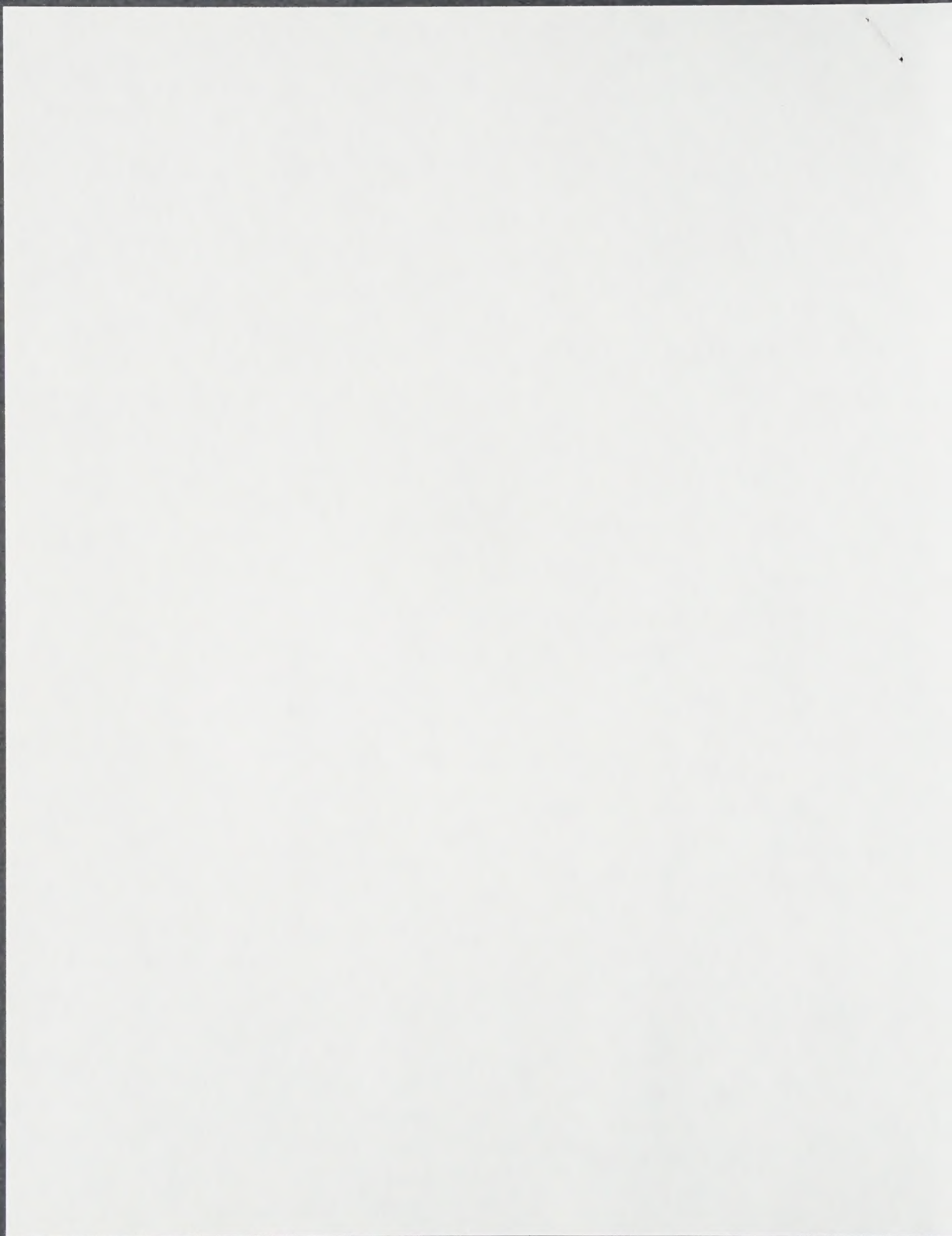
Dear Alf:
