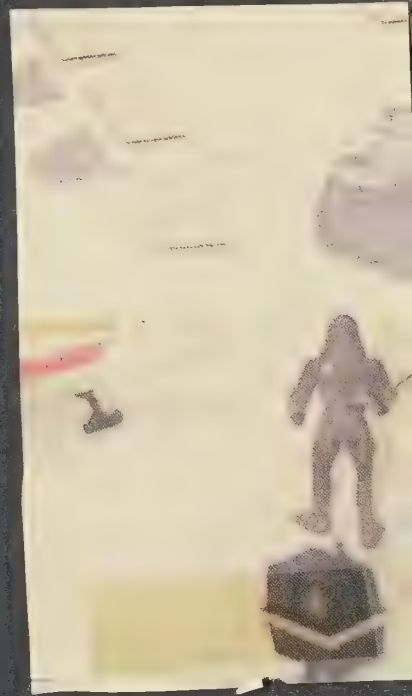
Isabel and Alfred Bader to be honored

Guest From History Theodore Herzl To Appear Friday March 8th For Dinner



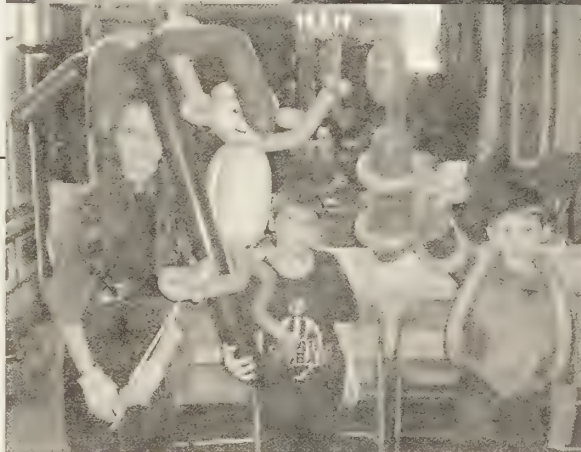
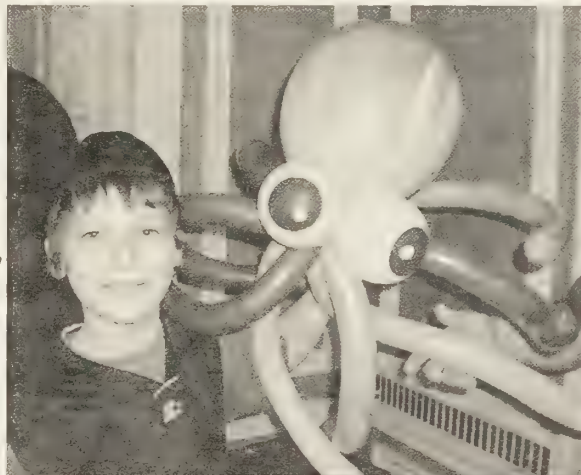

From the Rabbi

In Memory of Lucy Cohn

Lucy Cohn, a dear friend to many members of our congregation, passed away Monday, Feb. 25th. Her burial will be delayed and take place at Arlington National Cemetery, so I'd like to take this space to share now a short reflection about Lucy.

Two summers ago I was buying coffee inside a gas station in some small Minnesota town when a man walked up to me. (Yes, this is going to be a true story.) The man was raggedly dressed, unshaven, and otherwise seemed down on his luck. He said to me, "Today I'm having a good day," as if it is completely natural to say that to a stranger.

I probably replied that's good to know or something to that affect, and so he continued. "Every day for me is a good day. Do you know why?" Seeing that I had no choice, I asked how he does that. He said, "Every day is a good day because I won't let myself have a bad one." Obviously he wanted me to compliment him and tell him that he had a good attitude, so I did. Then he smiled at me, I believe a bit condescendingly, as I finished in the gas station and left.

Lucy was truly the embodiment of a good attitude. But not in a superficial way like this man, rather in a manner much deeper and more true.

Lucy didn't pretend that every day was a good day. In her life she suffered tremendous hardships, heartbreak, and loss. She had plenty of bad days and recognized them for what they were. She knew that suffering can't be wiped away with artificial smiles or made to vanish like stains in the wash.

Lucy's attitude was that while we have no choice about what life deals us, we can choose how we comport ourselves in the presence of others. And Lucy decided that no matter what suffering or sadness was visited upon her she would spread joy, optimism, and happiness to people around her.

Lucy also had remarkable peace of mind and clarity about her. I remember sitting with her about a year ago in the cafe at St. Johns on the Lake as she gave me an update on her medical condition and treatments. She knew exactly what she wanted. 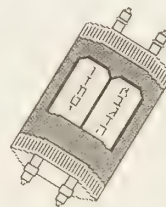

Dr. Shalom Sabar to Speak About Rembrandt, The Bible, and the Jews of Amsterdam



Sunday evening March 17th at 7 PM Dr. Shalom Sabar of the Hebrew University of Jerusalem will speak about Rembrandt: the Bible and the Jews of Amsterdam. The talk will be at Eastcastle Place, 2505 E Bradford, in Lindsay Hall.

Shalom Sabar is a Professor of Jewish Art and Folklore at The Hebrew University of Jerusalem. Born in the neo-Aramaic speaking Kurdish-Jewish community of Zakho, Professor Sabar earned his Ph.D. in Art History from UCLA, writing on the illustrated marriage contracts of the Jews in Renaissance and Baroque Italy.

His research unites the disciplines of art history and folklore. It

highlights issues pertaining to the folk nature of Jewish art and Jewish material culture, visual materials and objects associated with rituals in the life and year cycles, and the evidence these materials provide about the relationships between the Jewish minorities and the societies that hosted them in Christian Europe and the Islamic East.

Professor Sabar is a visiting professor and lectures widely in universities, museums, and public institutions in Israel, Europe and the United States. He also guides traveling seminars to Jewish sites in Europe, North Africa and Central Asia.

There will be no charge for attending this lecture and dessert refreshments will be served. Co-sponsored by Friends of the Hebrew University and the Israel Center of the Milwaukee Jewish Federation.

I am most pleased to contribute a few words about the professional achievements of Professor Leonard Parker on the occasion of the 2003 annual dinner of the Lake Park Synagogue, at which Leonard and Gloria Parker are being honored.

Earlier this month, I had the distinct pleasure of publicly thanking Professor Parker at the UWM Service Award ceremony for his 35 years of distinguished service to the Department of Physics at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee. As Leonard noted at that ceremony, when he came to UWM in 1968, he was the *only* faculty member at our university with research expertise in theoretical physics exploring cosmology, gravitation, and quantum field theory.

I am extremely pleased that this early isolation from nearby colleagues with a similar research interest did not dissuade Professor Parker from staying at UWM and leading the development of a vibrant theoretical physics program at our institution. In the ensuing years, Leonard has established an international reputation as a distinguished theoretical physicist: he is an elected Fellow of the prestigious American Physical Society; he has been a member of the Editorial Board of the *Journal of Mathematical Physics* and Editor of the *International Journal of Modern Physics*; and he has received consistent, long-term funding for his research from the National Science Foundation.

The achievements of Professor Leonard Parker, for which he has been so justly honored, are a source of great pride to the University he has chosen as his professional home. And they are a source of great pride to me personally, as Chancellor of UW-Milwaukee. Thank you, Leonard, for your far-reaching contributions to scientific knowledge and for your devotion to the students and faculty of our university.

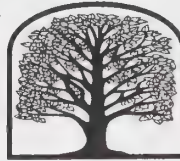

Dear Leonard and Gloria:

It is a genuine pleasure to be asked to contribute a few words on the occasion of your both being honored for your many years of devotion and commitment to the Lake Park Synagogue.

I have long believed that academic departments experience unique and defining moments in their histories that determine largely the long-term success and achievements of the department. Summer 1968, when Leonard was first appointed as Assistant Professor at UWM, was certainly one of those defining moments for the Department of Physics. At the time of his appointment, UWM boasted no expertise in the important theoretical research fields of gravitation, quantum-field theory, and cosmology. We were, however, extraordinarily fortunate in having many farsighted colleagues in the department at that time who understood the importance of the appointment of a scholar of Leonard's potential and who, it was hoped, would be the founding member of a research group in these critical fields.

We know now, of course, that Leonard has fulfilled that early promise many times over. In the 35 years since his initial appointment, Leonard has achieved international recognition for his work in theoretical physics. A testament to Leonard's early prominence in his field is evidenced by his being invited to pursue his research in the early 1970s at The Institute for Advanced Study at Princeton University. Other indications of Leonard's prominence include his selection as a Fellow of the American Physical Society in 1984 and his long service as editor of the *International Journal of Modern Physics*. Leonard's career research productivity has resulted continuous research funding from the National Science Foundation since 1970. This astonishing funding record is especially remarkable for a theoretical physicist. Finally, under Leonard's leadership our relativity research group is recognized as one of the strongest in the nation.

In addition to his research accomplishments, Leonard is regarded as a gifted and dedicated teacher. I experienced a small example of Leonard's commitment to his students about a year ago while touring the department's assigned space in the Physics Building. Although the tour was designed focus on groundwater-leakage problems in the experimental labs in the basement, Leonard made a special point of inviting me to visit the department's teaching computer laboratory so that he could show me first hand the need to upgrade the teaching software in that lab. His concern that our students have the best possible instruction was both effective and touching.

Leonard, your accomplishments during your distinguished career have conveyed an enormous gift to the advancement of science, to your colleagues and your students, and to the College as a whole. I know I speak for the entire faculty of the College of Letters and Science when I say that we are proud and grateful to you and Gloria are our colleagues.

Finally, I want to thanks the members of the Lake Park Synagogue, for the opportunity to join with you in celebrating these two remarkable members of out communities.

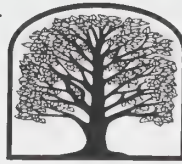

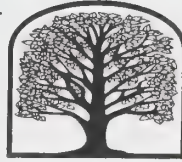

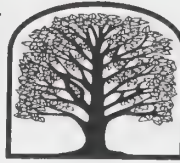
