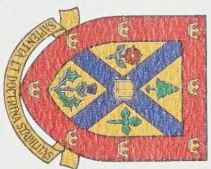



## *Honorary Graduands*

### *Malcolm Peat*

Dr. Malcolm Peat has over thirty-five years experience in international development, education and research. During this period he was advisor for ten years for the Foreign and Commonwealth Office and Ministry of Overseas Development of the British Government. He was Advisor to governments in Burma (Myanmar) and Philippines and also Consultant in Education in Rehabilitation in India, Thailand and Hong Kong. This function was at the senior policy level and was related to the development of university and government programs and policies. He was awarded MBE by the British government for contributions to international development.

Dr. Peat has been the Director of a number of international programs in the Caribbean, Central America, South Asia, and Eastern Europe. He was also Director of the Queen's-CIDA program in promoting community based rehabilitation in the Balkans from 1993 to 2005.

Malcolm Peat completed undergraduate and graduate qualifications in rehabilitation and education in the United Kingdom (Bath and Glasgow) and MSc and PhD (Anatomy) degrees at the University of Manitoba, Canada. Dr Peat has held positions with the Government of the United Kingdom, the World Health Organization and has extensive international experience in leading projects in university education in rehabilitation and community development including countries in transition, developing countries, and those in conflict and post-conflict reconstruction. He held faculty positions in the Universities of Manitoba and Western Ontario prior to his appointment at Queen's University, Kingston. Dr Peat was the Associate Dean (Rehabilitation) and Director of the School of Rehabilitation Therapy at Queen's for the period 1985 to 1997. Since 1991 he has also been the Executive Director of the International Centre for the Advancement of Community Based Rehabilitation (ICACBR), Faculty of Health Sciences. Dr Peat is a Professor Emeritus in the School of Rehabilitation Therapy and has held cross appointments in the Departments of Family Medicine and Anatomy. He has published extensively on education, basic sciences and community based rehabilitation in developing countries and as a peace-building strategy.

In 2004 Dr Peat was recognized by the Canadian International Development Agency through the award *Canadians Who Make a Difference* and by Queen's University through the *Distinguished Service Award* program. Dr Peat is the recipient of a number of Government and University Awards internationally for his contribution to rehabilitation. In 2006 Dr. Peat received an Honourary Doctor of Medicine Degree from Riga Stradina University in Riga Latvia.

## *Honorary Graduands*

### *Isabel Louise Bader*

I was born in New Liskeard, Ontario on November 1, 1926, the second daughter of Stella and Herbert Overton. My father was an Englishman who had immigrated to Canada in 1906, settled in Northern Ontario and married my Canadian mother in 1920. Both my parents were very interested in Bible study, loved music and wanted a good education for their children. Upon graduation from Kirkland Lake Collegiate and Vocational Institute, I won an Ontario Scholarship to Victoria University in Toronto from which I graduated with an honours degree in History and Foreign Languages in 1949. That July I traveled on the S.S. Franconia from Quebec City to Liverpool and on the fifth day of the journey met Alfred Bader.

Nine days later he proposed to me in Green Park, London. I was in a quandary. I was just beginning my "dream" of living in England. I had not thought of marriage and I had never considered changing my religion, which would have been most important to Alfred. After long consideration I decided it would be best for me to stay in England where I had accepted a position in a private school in Bexhill-on-Sea in Sussex. I then taught for twenty-eight years in the Bexhill Grammar School for Girls which eventually became a Sixth Form College. From my first months in Bexhill I helped the drama teacher, Mrs. Portch, with the school drama festival and joined her local drama group. I had always taken part in school plays and was glad of her offer of professional training. In the autumn of 1951 we began the Thalia School of Elocution and Drama. I eventually took my teaching qualifications and became particularly involved with making costumes for our productions over the next thirty years. In 1972 the Bexhill Borough celebrated the 1200th anniversary of the granting of land for the building of the local parish church. At the request of the local Council we offered to prepare a costume exhibit, which proved so successful, we were asked to reopen the next year. Staffed entirely by volunteers, the Bexhill Costume Museum has been open each year since, from Easter to the end of October.

Alfred came back into my life in April, 1975 and we were married in Milwaukee in January 1982. Since then we have worked together on Alfred's four jobs, collecting and dealing in art, investing and working with chemical companies, writing and lecturing and philanthropic work as we try to help others.

## *The Jock Harty Arena*

1970 - 2007

Jock Harty Arena is now in its third incarnation. The original Jock Harty Arena was built in 1922, with the money for its construction being largely supplied by friends, family, and classmates of John Joseph Harty. It was located on Arch Street, where Humphrey Hall now stands. It burned to the ground only two short years afterwards, and a second Jock Harty Arena was built on the same location in 1924. The arena remained there until 1968, when it was torn down to make way for the new psychology building. The third Jock Harty Arena was opened on the north side of Union Street in 1970.

John Joseph Harty was born in Kingston in 1874. As a young man he attended Kingston Collegiate and then Loyola College of Collège Ste-Marie in Montreal. While studying in Montreal he indulged his passion for hockey and when he returned to Queen's to study Medicine his hockey skills were a boon to the Queen's team. In addition to many other victories, the team became known in 1897 as "The Conquerors of Yale".

After graduating from Queen's in 1897, Harty did a medical internship in New York. While he was there, he played for the New York Crescents. Eventually he returned to Kingston to take up a job with the Canadian Locomotive Company, and in due course became President. Jock Harty maintained his link with Queen's and with hockey as a coach. He coached the Canadian Locomotive Company team and the Queen's team, leading the Queen's team to a victory over Ottawa in the 1909 Allan Cup. Sadly, Jock Harty died in the prime of his life while on a business trip in England. He contracted the Spanish flu and died of septic pneumonia on February 23, 1919 at London's Savoy Hotel.

As well as serving as the home for Queen's sporting events, the Jock Harty Arena is also fondly remembered by students as a venue for concerts and dances, as an exam hall, and since 1971 as the home of the Spring Convocations.

The demolition of the Jock Harty Arena in the summer of 2007 will open a new chapter of Queen's history – the construction of the Queen's Centre. A celebration to mark the Queen's Centre groundbreaking was held in the Jock Harty Arena on March 2, 2007. The \$230 million Queen's Centre is an ambitious three-phase project which will more than double the capacity of the existing facilities. A warm invitation is extended to all to return to visit what will be a spectacular new home for athletics, recreation and student life at Queen's in the years to come.



### *The Academic Hood*

The hood as an academical vestment is distinctly British and is worn by graduates of English speaking universities all over the world. In its original form it was the upper part of the cowl worn by the Monks and Friars of the middle ages. The hood covered the head during inclement weather and in the draughty cloisters when taking exercise. If not needed for this purpose it could be pulled off and allowed to hang behind over the tippet. The tippet was the lower part, a short cape, reaching to the elbow and forming a very welcome article of clothing in the monasteries and hostels which were still unglazed at the end of the 15th century. Indeed, it would appear that glass was not in general use until 1650, for three years later an order was issued to all students at Oxford to "keep his chamber windows in repair after they have once been glazed by the college". The cowl still forms part of the dress of the religious orders, but the hood, separated from the tippet now denotes a graduate of some British or American University or similar institution while the tippet is worn by certain dignitaries of both the Roman and the Anglican church. A smaller type is also used to distinguish Diocesan Readers.

### *The Coat of Arms*

The Coat of Arms of the University that hangs behind the Chancellor's dais, is based on that of Edinburgh University, the institution after which Queen's was modeled. The Coat of Arms consists of a gold shield with red edges, divided into four triangular compartments by a blue, diagonal St Andrew's cross, which represents the university's Scottish origins. A golden book, symbolizing learning, sits open at the centre of the cross. In each of the four compartments is an emblem of the university's Canadian and British origins: a pine tree for Canada, a thistle for Scotland, a rose for England, and a shamrock for Ireland. The red colour of the border is a mark of cadency, indicating that Queen's is younger than Edinburgh University. The border is decorated with eight gold crowns, symbolic of Queen Victoria and the university's royal charter. The official heraldic description of the coat of arms is: "Or on a Saltire Azure between in chief a Fir tree eradicated in base a Thistle stalked and leaved in fesse a Red Rose barbed seeded stalked and leaved all proper and a Trefoil Vert an open Book of the first a Bordure also Gules charged with eight Ancient Crowns Gold". The shield is underlined by the Latin phrase "Sapientia et Doctrina Stabilitas" which is translated as "Wisdom and Learning shall be the stability of thy times".

Although the Coat of Arms has been in use throughout the 20th century, it was not until 1953 that it was sanctioned by the College of Arms of England and subsequently registered through Letters Patent, dated 27 November 1981, and recorded in the Public Register of All Arms and Bearings in Scotland, that is the Court of the Lord Lyon, Edinburgh, Scotland. On 30 September 1991, during Queen's Sesqui-centennial Celebrations, the Coat of Arms was registered in the Canadian Registry of Flags, Arms and Badges.

The countries of citizenship of the graduating class are represented by national flags placed on both sides of the stage.

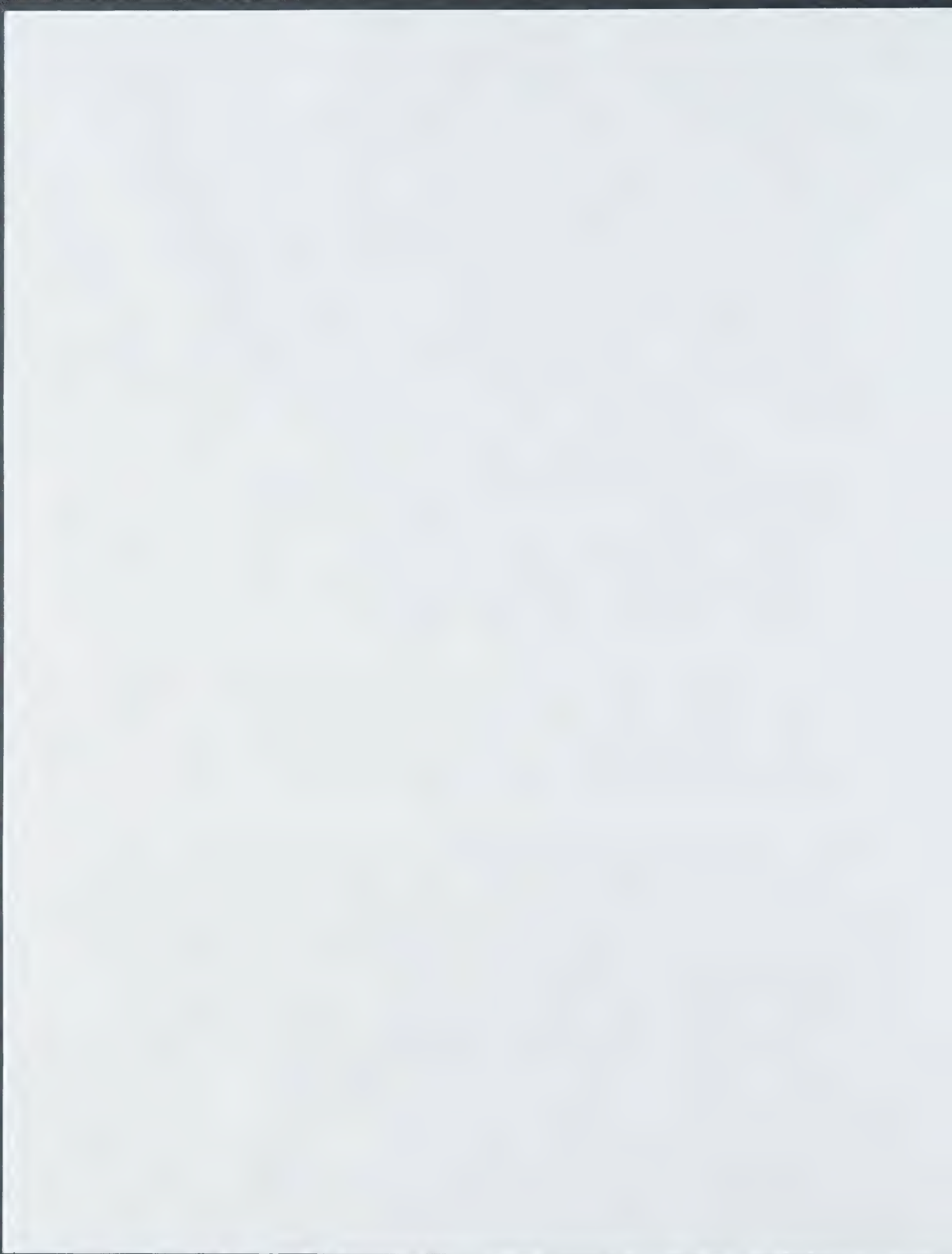
MADAM PRINCIPAL, MR CHANCELLOR, FELLOW GRADUANDS,

WE ARE A COUNTRY OF IMMIGRANTS WHO CAME AND ARE STILL COMING HOPING FOR A GOOD LIFE, A BETTER LIFE. SOME CANADIANS LEAVE FOR THE SAME REASON, BUT I BELIEVE MANY MORE ARE ALMOST INSULAR. 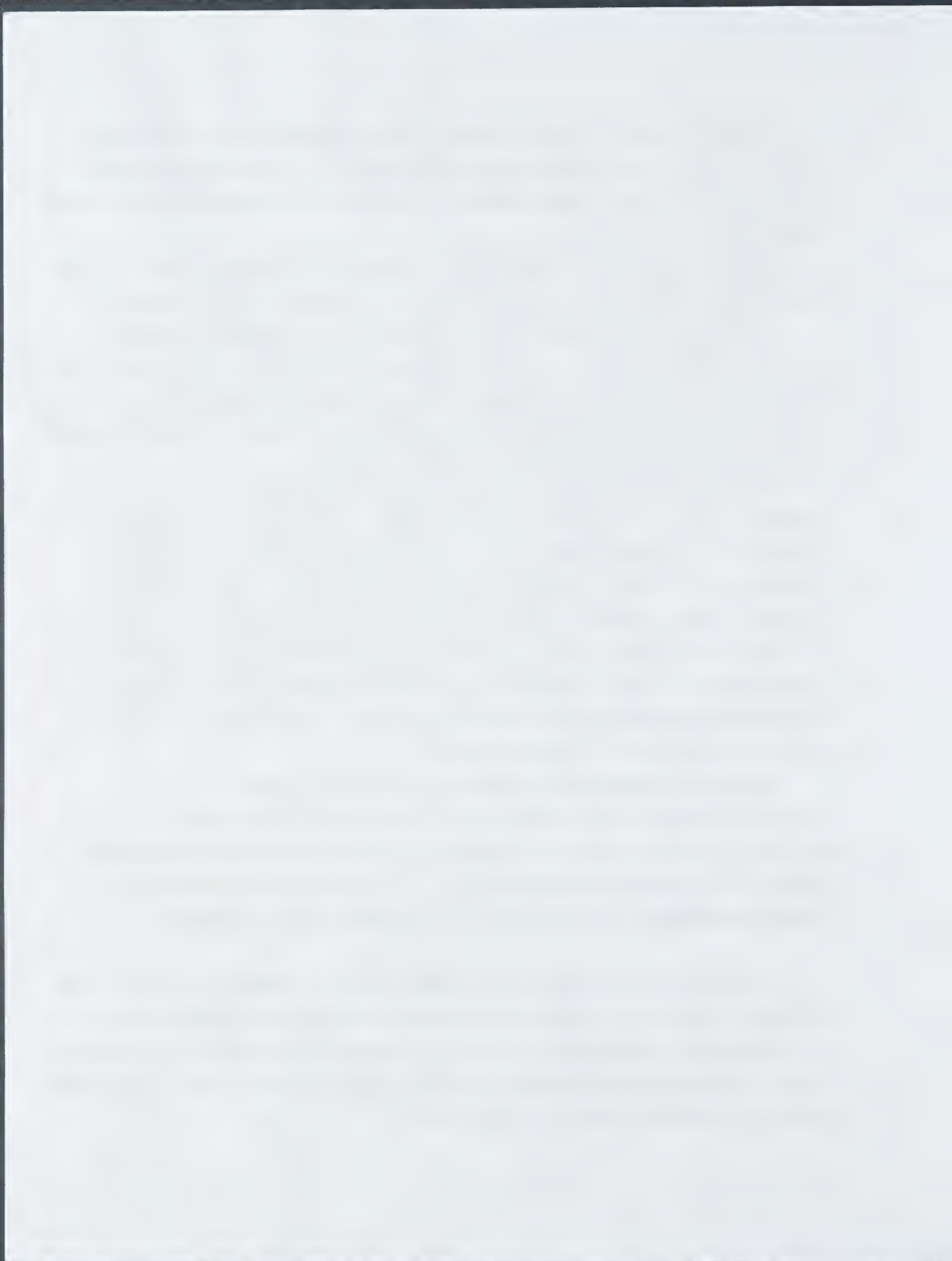

LET ME GIVE ONE EXAMPLE OF A TECHNICAL CHALLENGE IN CANADA. THERE IS AS MUCH OIL IN THE ALBERTA TAR SANDS AS IN SAUDI ARABIA, BUT SEPARATION OF OIL FROM THE SANDS IS VERY DIFFICULT. PERHAPS WITH THE HELP OF CHEMIST'S FROM QUEEN'S THIS WILL BE SOLVED. WHAT A BOON THAT WOULD BE. I'D RATHER DEPEND ON ALBERTA THAN ON SAUDI ARABIA.



THERE IS A MORE DIFFICULT CHALLENGE WE ALL HAVE TO FACE. ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT COMMANDMENTS IN THE BIBLE IS: "YOU SHALL NOT STAND IDLY BY THE BLOOD OF YOUR NEIGHBOUR." THIS TAKES REAL COURAGE.

LET ME GIVE JUST ONE EXAMPLE OF A CANADIAN FAILURE. MANY OF YOU KNOW THE STORY OF THE THREE INUIT FAMILIES, WHO IN 1953, WERE FORCED BY THE GOVERNMENT TO LIVE ON ELLESMERE ISLAND, PERHAPS THE HARSHTEST AREA EVER INHABITED BY HUMANS. FORTY YEARS LATER A ROYAL COMMISSION CALLED THIS ONE OF THE WORST HUMAN RIGHTS VIOLATIONS IN THE HISTORY OF CANADA. HOW MANY WHO KNEW ABOUT THIS WERE STANDING IDLY BY?

KEEP YOUR HEARTS AND MINDS OPEN. IF YOU SEE NEED BECOME INVOLVED. THE DIRECTOR OF THE SCHOOL OF REHABILITATION THERAPY AT QUEEN'S DID JUST THAT IN THE 1990'S. MALCOLM PEAT, WHO THIS MORNING RECEIVED A MOST WELL-DESERVED HONORARY DOCTORATE, TOOK TRAINED AND DEDICATED QUEEN'S STUDENTS INTO THE TURMOIL OF WAR-TORN SARAJEVO TO BRING REAL HELP, LEADERSHIP AND INSPIRATION TO THE SUFFERERS.

YOU DON'T HAVE TO BE POWERFUL TO BE SIGNIFICANT. JOHN.F.KENNEDY SAID: "ONE MAN CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE AND EVERY MAN SHOULD TRY". I URGE EACH OF YOU TO BE A QUEEN'S GRAD WHO TRIES.
