Lacknowledge your letter of March 30, 2005 and thank you for your generous gift which should be forwarded to Beth Israel Congregation of Kingston, 116 Centre Street, Kingston, ON K7L 4E6 ATTN Richard Kizell, Treasurer.

Forgive me if I offended you in any way by suggesting the naming of rooms. It was not my intention in any way to diminish the act of freely making a gift.

In our last telephone conversation I did mention that I was unable to speak with the Treasurer as to some questions that you raised and I would for the record, just provide the following background.

- 1. The Barrie Street Hillel was sold in March of 1975 and the proceeds left for the benefit of Jewish students at Queen's was \$68,800.00 and is invested in GICs. Income generated has been used to pay an annual rent of \$8,000.00, insurance on contents, subsidies to students for out-of-town events, part-time co-ordinators and short falls from time to time in annual student activities. Notwithstanding these payments, this trust fund has been able to grow to some \$140,000.00. As you are aware, interest earned the last 5-6 years has been rather meager and growth has been stagnant.
- When Beth Israel entered into the agreement in the early 1990's with the Province for Otterburn House (Hillel House), the work required to meet necessary improvements and the Province's criteria amounted to \$450,000.00.

A Provincial Grant was obtained in the sum of \$120,000.00 and the balance of some \$330,000.00 was left to be raised by the members of the Congregation.

3. In early 2000, there was extensive renovation to the Beth Israel social hall and other main floor offices and amenities totalling some \$375,000.00.


The members have been most generous and from these two campaigns there remains some \$75,000.00 only in outstanding pledges.

Dear Dr. and Mrs. Bader,

Thank you very much for your recent contribution of \$100,000, to help in our work of raising Jewish conscience, knowledge and observance throughout the community. The contribution in the form of matching funds is particularly praiseworthy, as the Talmud states: ארול המעשה יותר מן העושה *- He who causes others to contribute is greater than the one who donates himself (Bava Basra 9:1)*. That is, of course, in addition to our double benefit, ultimately resulting in greater productivity.

Our gratitude to you for your latest contribution, as well as for your help in bringing us to where we are today.

As life honored members of Lubavitch of Wisconsin and partners in our work, I deem it my duty to share with you the effect of your contributions in the overall Lubavitch of Wisconsin's 'state of the state'.

After four years of rigorous reorganization, as forecasted, we have practically doubled our reach in many areas of programming. The past year in particular has, thank G-d, been one of great opportunity and tremendous growth.

The following is a brief description of the growth in preexisting programming and the initiation of new programs:

- The adult education offerings and attendance has more than doubled. By consolidating our classes and manpower and creating the *Jewish Literacy Institute* catalogue, we have enabled people to take advantage of a wide variety of subjects in all areas of interest of Torah and Judaism.
- The ongoing attendance of both The Shuls has more than doubled in the last year.
- After a lengthy arduous road we have succeeded in getting together with our long lost Mequon operation, in addition to the *Kiddush Hashem*, which is in itself is the mission of Judaism it has already resulted in greater service to the community, and in particular, utilizing the manpower of the joint forces in the beginning of Hillel Academy reorganization. (I am confident that there will be other tangible results from the reunification).



- With the help of grants from the Helen Bader Foundation we have initiated and broadened numerous youth programs: The Teen Circle for 11th and 12th graders; Torah High for 9th and 10th graders; Bar and Bat Mitzvah Clubs; The Friendship Circle, a program engaging teens in helping children of special needs, and increased programming on the UWM campus, all of which brought new life and encouragement to the youth in each of these groups.
- We responded to the need and rose to the occasion of helping and managing Hillel Academy. We are in the process of doing a thorough reorganization of its educational, marketing, financial and all internal systems. Our vision is to bring Hillel Academy to its rightful state as envisioned by its astute founders as the leading provider of education, Jewish and secular, to the Jewish community's elementary school children; to be a springboard for a Jewish High school, as well as an instrument to educate and impact on the Jewish growth, learning, experience and commitment of the constituent families, and beyond.
- Not being able to delay it any longer, we began the renovations of the Mikveh, which, even before completion has already aroused great interest, and also involved some families in the actual observance of this vital mitzvah.
- Finally, as a result of all the above and more, Thank G-d, Lubavitch has attained the unprecedented esteem and moral support of the community, which will, with G-d's help, also result in greater participation, as well as financial support.

So much for the upside of our operation.

As far as our current challenges, after three and half years of extraordinary fundraising – first and foremost, through your generosity and motivation of others - to clear the deficit, while maintaining our ongoing program (from July 2002 through December 2003 we raised 5.5 million dollars in contributions), our 2004 plans called for it to be the year of developing normative, on-going financial support. Indeed, we succeeded in securing numerous multiyear pledges. However, we lagged behind in meeting the no deficit goal we set for ourselves.

The following, are factors that contributed to this:

- During the intensive campaign of the last two years, some of our largest donors contributed way above what they normally would (in great part due to the unique challenge grant that was presented), and in some cases, way beyond what they could write off in one year. Instead, they_structured their gifts as multi-year gifts effectively barring subsequent years' giving. Others simply relaxed their giving; some due to the economy; some having moved away, while some passed away. Hence, new funding sources need to be developed.
- Hillel Academy. Here some background is necessary.

As you know, we accepted very reluctantly the administration of Hillel. For three years, since 2002, when we were first approached by Armin Nankin to take over Hillel, we refused to act on it. However, Hillel's desperate situation, facing closing, left us no option but to step in.

For us, Lubavitch, the option of Hillel closing down and then opening a new school from ground up, in many ways would have been much easier and more attractive. However, that would leave the children currently attending Hillel without a suitable school for them. (In addition to the children's educational needs, its closing may very well have resulted in a migration of a number of families from Milwaukee, causing yet another crack in an already vulnerable infrastructure of the community.



Financially, too, we would have lost the Federation's support for many years.

A school like Hillel is vital, if our goal of a strong presence of *Yiddishkeit* and an informed, learned and involved Jewish community is to be achieved. (All this in addition to serving the needs and newly kindled thirst of the graduates of CLLLC and their families, as well as that of the affiliates of all the shuls and the general orthodox Jewish community, and all those who want to instill real knowledge of Jewish wisdom; Chumash, Tanach, ethics, etc.

As a result of being forced to become involved with Hillel at the last moment, we spent an enormous amount of precious time that would otherwise have been utilized to continue developing ongoing regular financial support.

- Unfortunately, as I believe you are aware of, some have also withdrawn their funding of Lubavitch of Wisconsin due to the clamor surrounding Hillel academy.
- Finally, after deferring the desperately needed repair of our roof for as long as we could (do to the overall more pressing needs), this became one of the most pressing needs and were compelled by our Board to deal with it, by borrowing \$350,000 placing us even more behind.

It is these factors that contributed to the shortfall of 2004, and which we hope to make up in the 2005 and 2006 fiscal year.

On a personal note I wish to share with you, Dr. and Mrs. Bader, some of the latest news in our family.

Just last week our daughter Henya, (who is working part-time in CLLLC, as a special project coordinator, and is also volunteering in the same capacity at Hillel) along with her husband (who while waiting for his desired position, is now teaching a couple of hours a day at Hillel and has, indeed, made a great mark on the students) have officially become *shluchim* to the Virgin Islands. For us it is a great simcha, as it is a fulfillment of a life's wish that our children become *shluchim*.

I wanted to share our state of the state with our partners, who did and will, no doubt, continue doing their share of financing Jewish life in Milwaukee, in the true spirit of *Yisachar* and *Z'vulun* (see *Rashi Bereishis 49:13 and 14; Devorim 33:18*).

I wish you a gezunten vinter un a freilichen tomid. Again I am grateful for your partnership.
