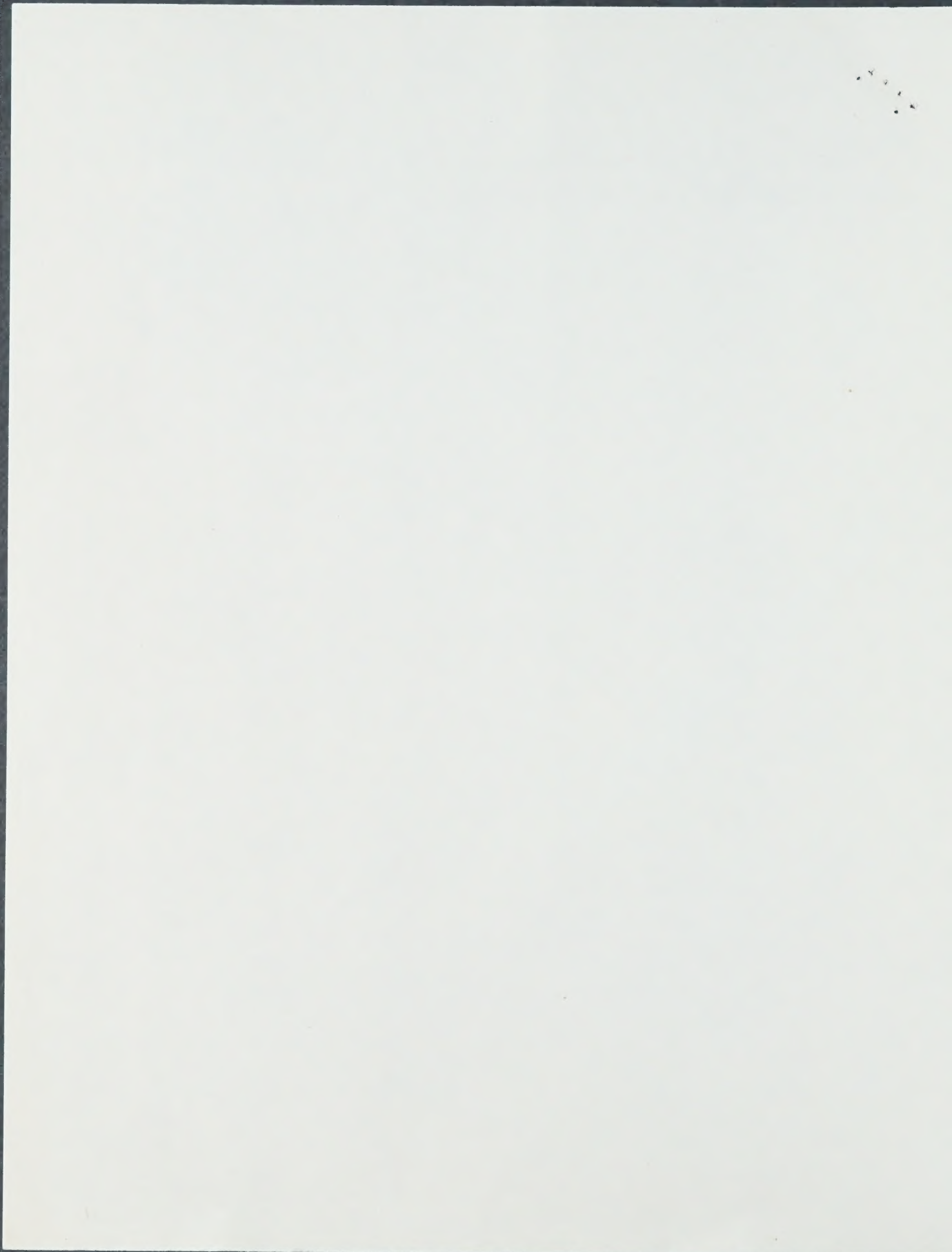

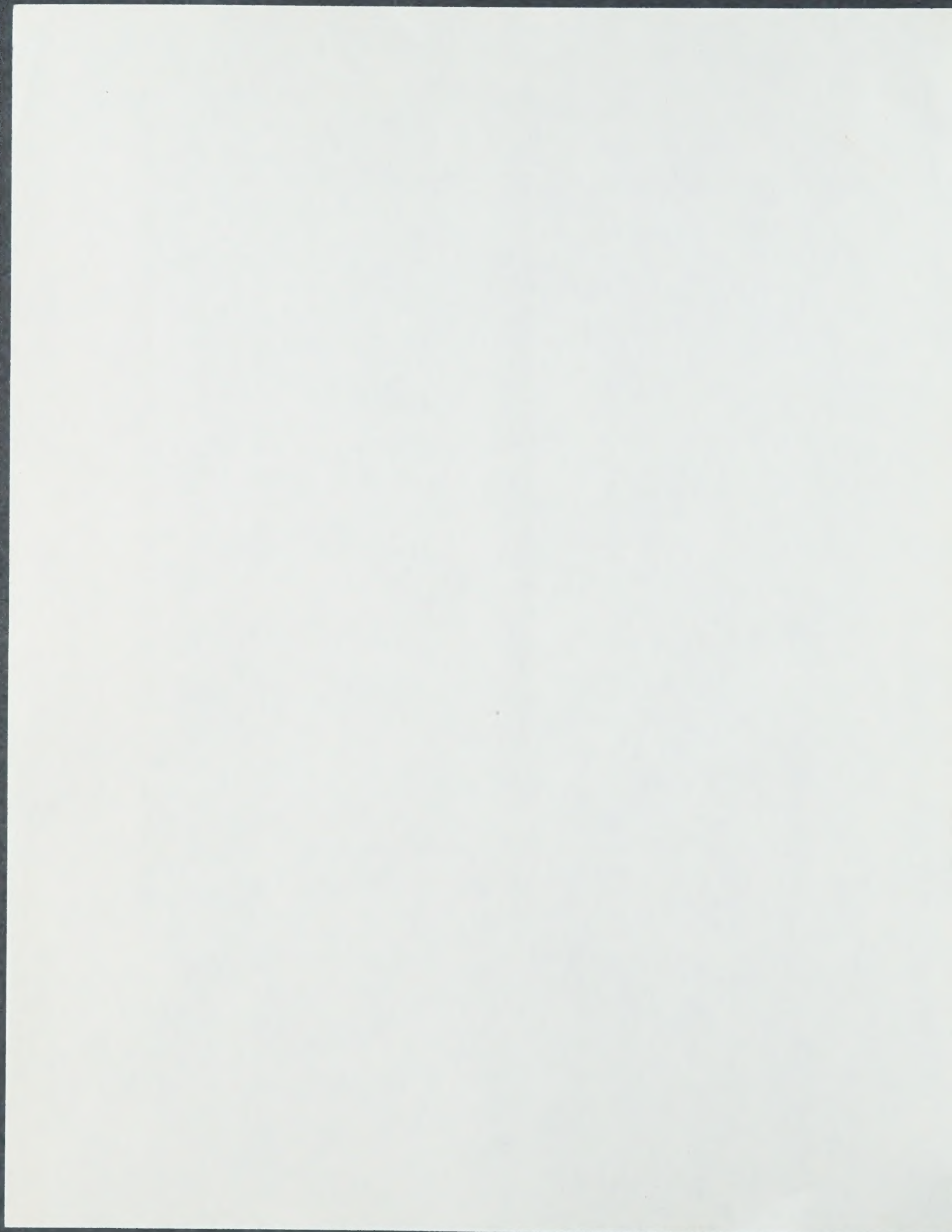
I so enjoyed meeting you and your wife a few weeks ago.

rest of the year.

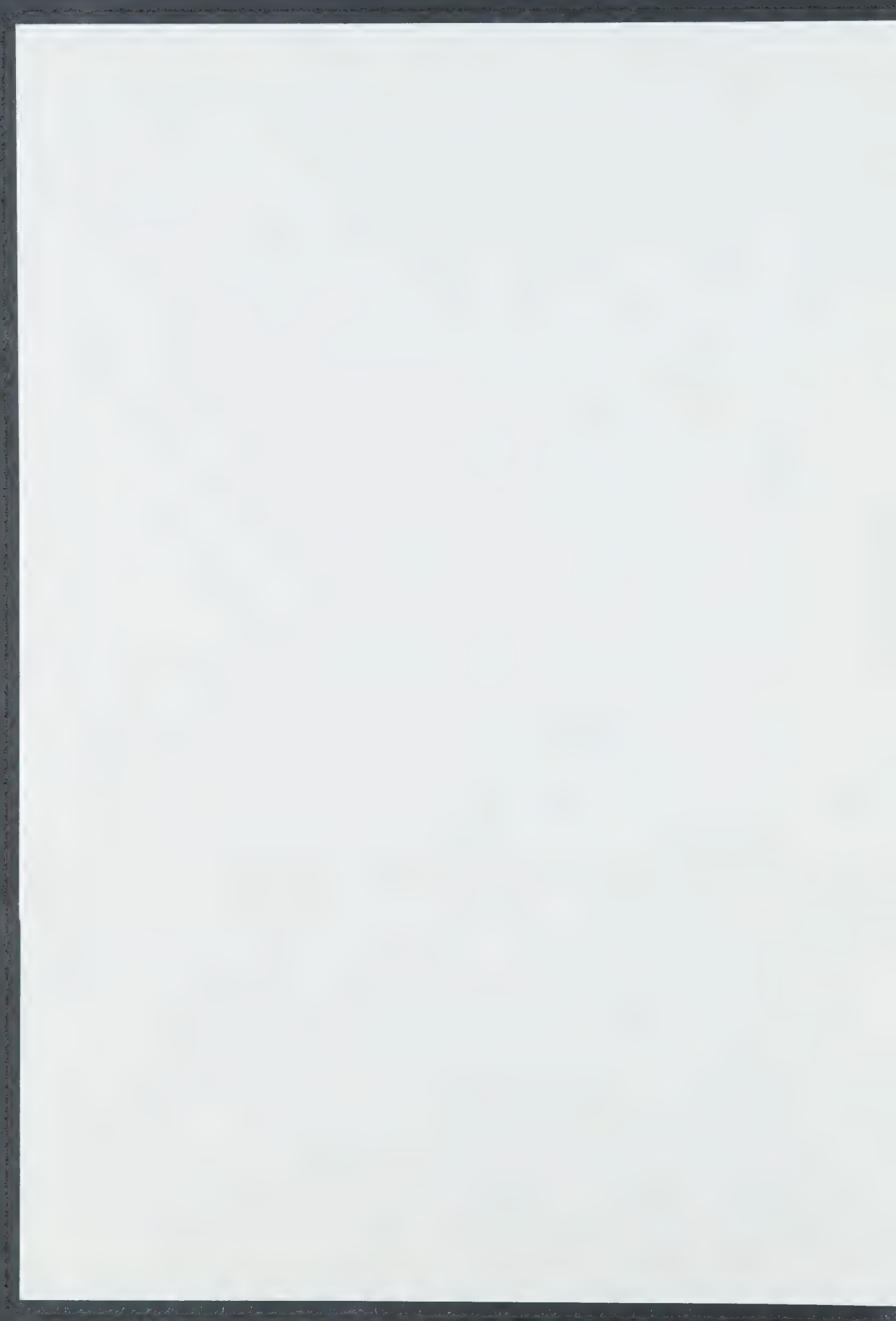
My wife and I enjoyed very much meeting with

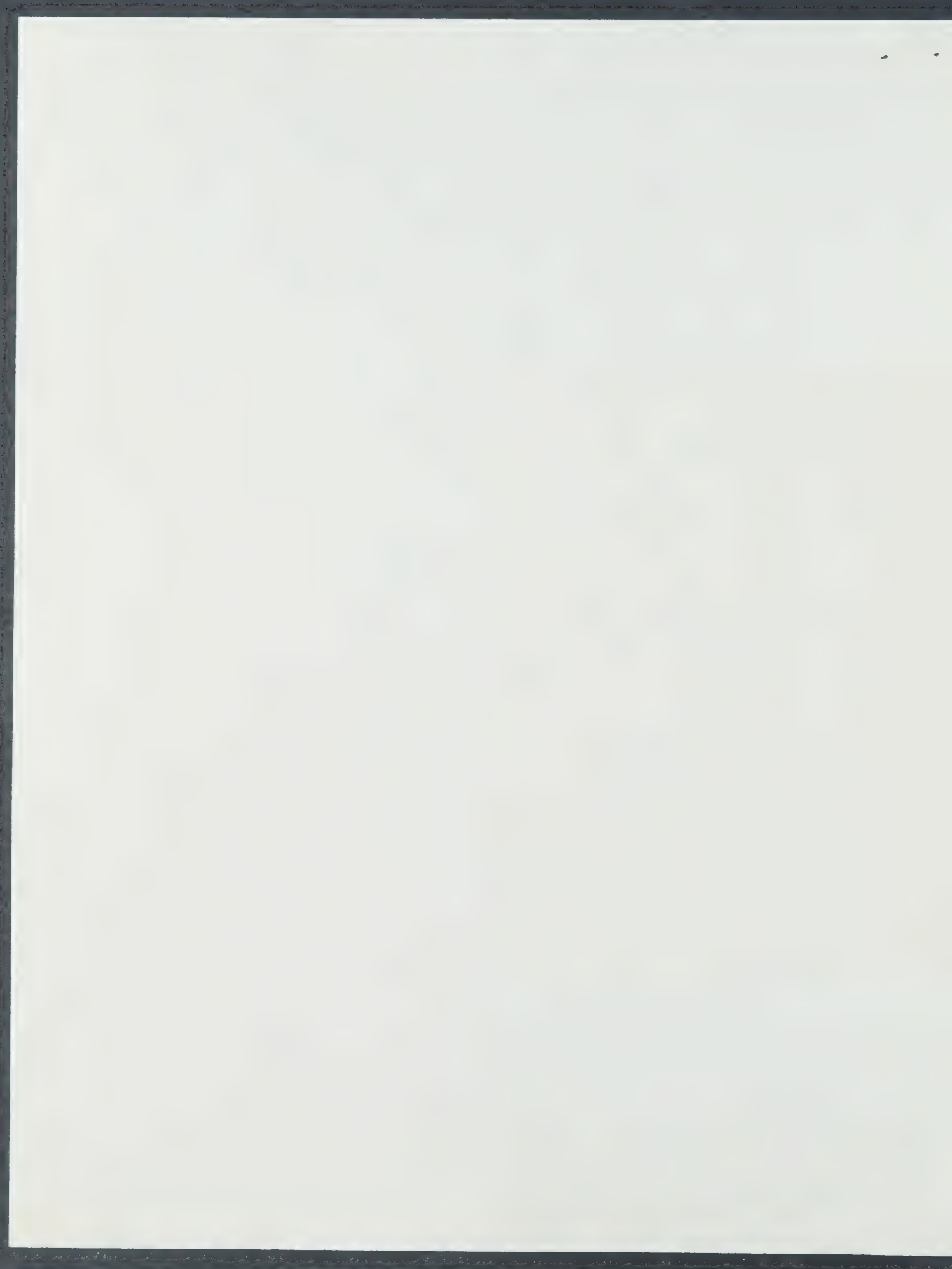
You know so very much about Czech works of art, and so I am wondering whether you could help me with the following:

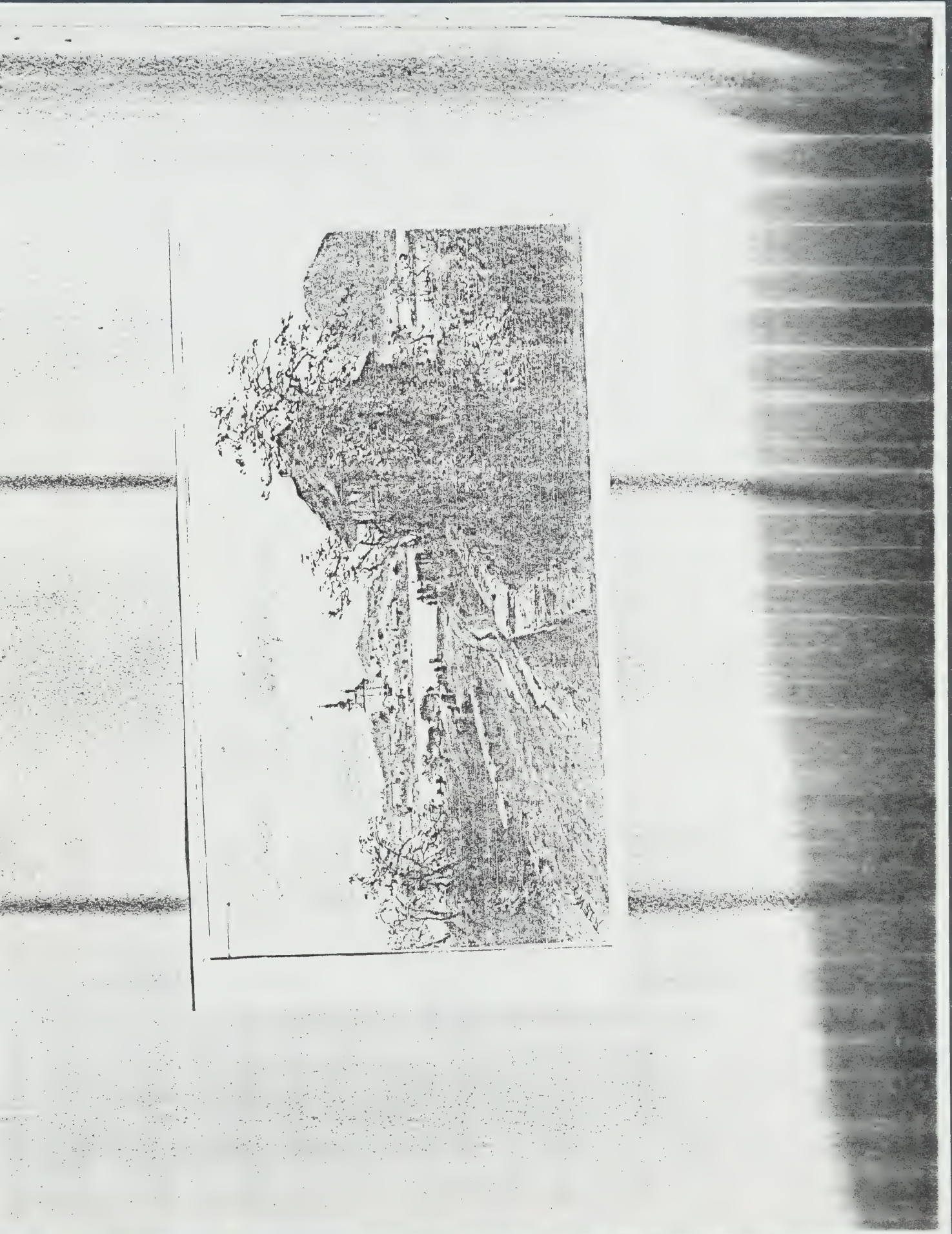

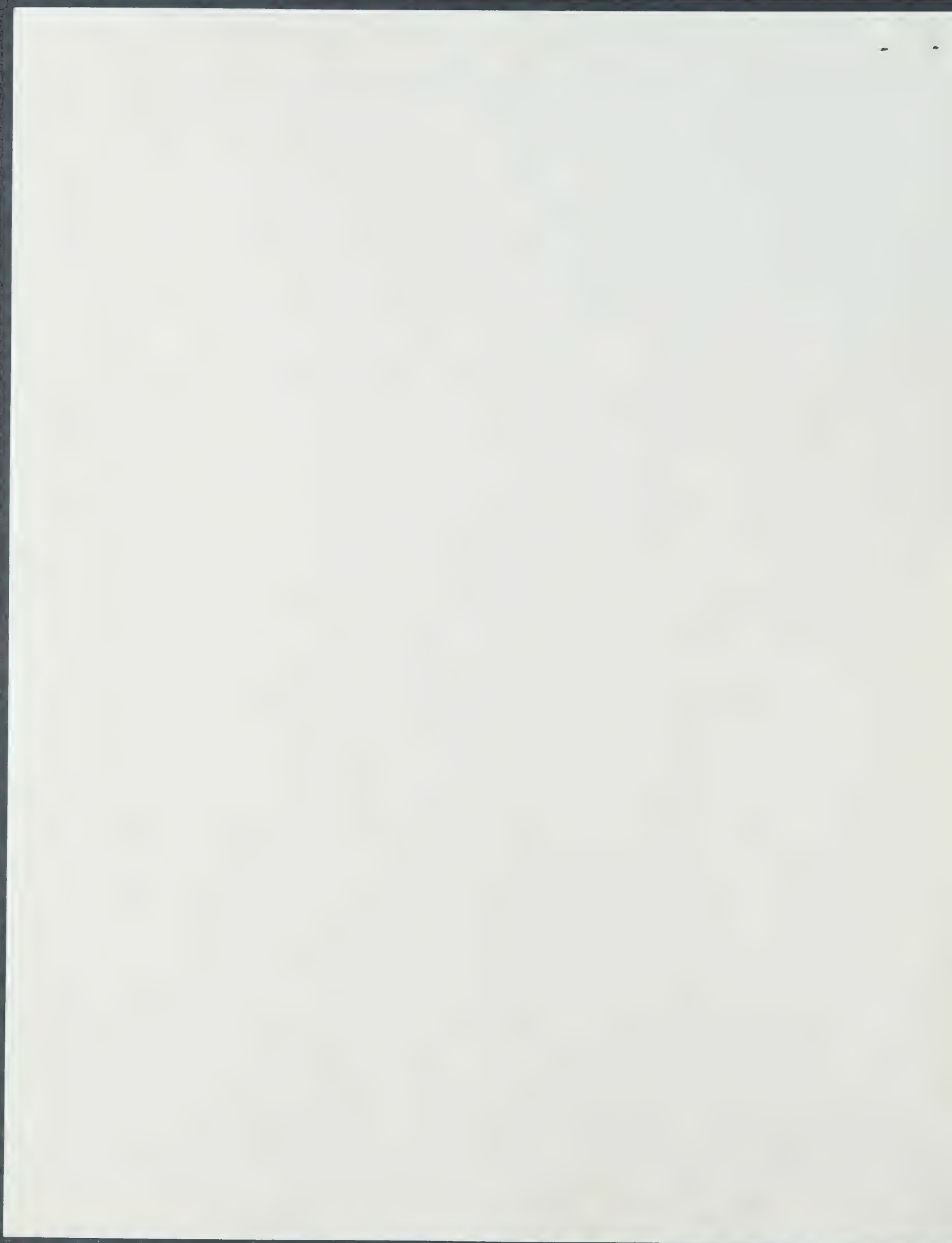

Dear Dr. Kyncl:

You will have realized how very much Isabel and I enjoyed your visit, and we very much hope that you will be able to join us again soon, on a day when we will have somewhat more time.

Could you visit us on Saturday or Sunday, September 23rd or 24th, joining us for drinks and a discussion about paintings, around 4 o'clock in the afternoon, and then going out for a simple supper.

This is to confirm that you took with you that oil painting on canvas, 36 x 24 inches, depicting the skulls in Sedlec in Kutna Hora in Bohemia. The painting is signed and dated 1888 in the lower left, and I enclose transcription of that made by my restorer.

We agreed that you would take the painting on consignment for sale and sell it at the best price you can get above U.S. Dollars Five Thousand (\$5,000.00). You will keep a 20% commission and remit the balance.

Thus, if you receive \$10,000.00 for the painting, you will send me \$8,000.00; if you sell it for \$5,000.00 you will send me \$4,000.00, the agreed minimum.

To signify that this corresponds to your understanding, please do return one copy of this letter.

I much look forward to seeing both of you in September.
