10:00 a.m. Mrs. Flinn left. She sent an email on the 17th. The Dosa landscape was perfect in size, but she didn't care for the dead tree. She will pick up the Erickson portrait tomorrow at 2 pm to see how it looks in her home. Have you a frame that is more ornate which would compliment the painting? (at additional cost, of course). Any background information would help also (used to file and all photographs are gone). None of the others were the right measurements. Galle vase and pedestal were of no interest whatsoever.

10:30 a.m. Mrs. Flinn threw me a curve ball just when she called. I have my fingers crossed that I handled this in the same way as Alfred's stuff here were he here:

She wanted the price on the THYPTICHI. I quote her \$25,000 and told her I had to verify it with you. She will take it along tomorrow as well. ASAP for the sake of my printing is ok. My feelings will not be hurt if you discuss the price. Also, provided background information - as much as we could get together since we do not file.

She liked the yellow chrysantheum by 1/2 size D because it was smaller and was the perfect size, so I tried to show within her price range and quoted her \$12,000. I guess now we'll find out if I'm learning from your work on left field. She is not sure whether she will take that one along tomorrow or not.

Here comes the sticky part - she is bringing in a painting less than 2 hours. Probably the ones from another gallery, which she has paid. I told her we did not sell on consignment and she asked if we might be interested for the moment, but then outright. This will, of course, be up to you. Alfred's gallery, contrary to what I was not interested that would be fine. She was in a very awkward position that the sale of the triptyc hangs on your decision. I trust how you feel about this, but I would not jeopardize her interest in the triptyc by saying no.

Tim Cobb had the painting here by 8:15 am. She loved it, but cannot use the size.

I am scheduled to call you tomorrow at 4pm. If I do not call you previously, on the hour it means Mrs. Flint is still in the gallery and I am encouraging her to take more paintings along. In that case I will call you right after she leaves and give you a full report.

Her timing is to have the mover arrive at her home at 3pm, bring her paintings here about 3:30 and then take ours home with her.

Did you receive Dorotheum catalogue? Tomorrow's old master auction has a 17th century gorgeous *Flower Still Life*, ca. 1680 by Jan Brueghel the Younger. The jewelry auction on the 29th has a spectacular diamond ring that would look gorgeous on Isabel. Either you can call Dr. Wolff so we can bid on the internet from here if you wish.

Mail was light, mainly advertising pieces. I'll be here another hour if you need me.

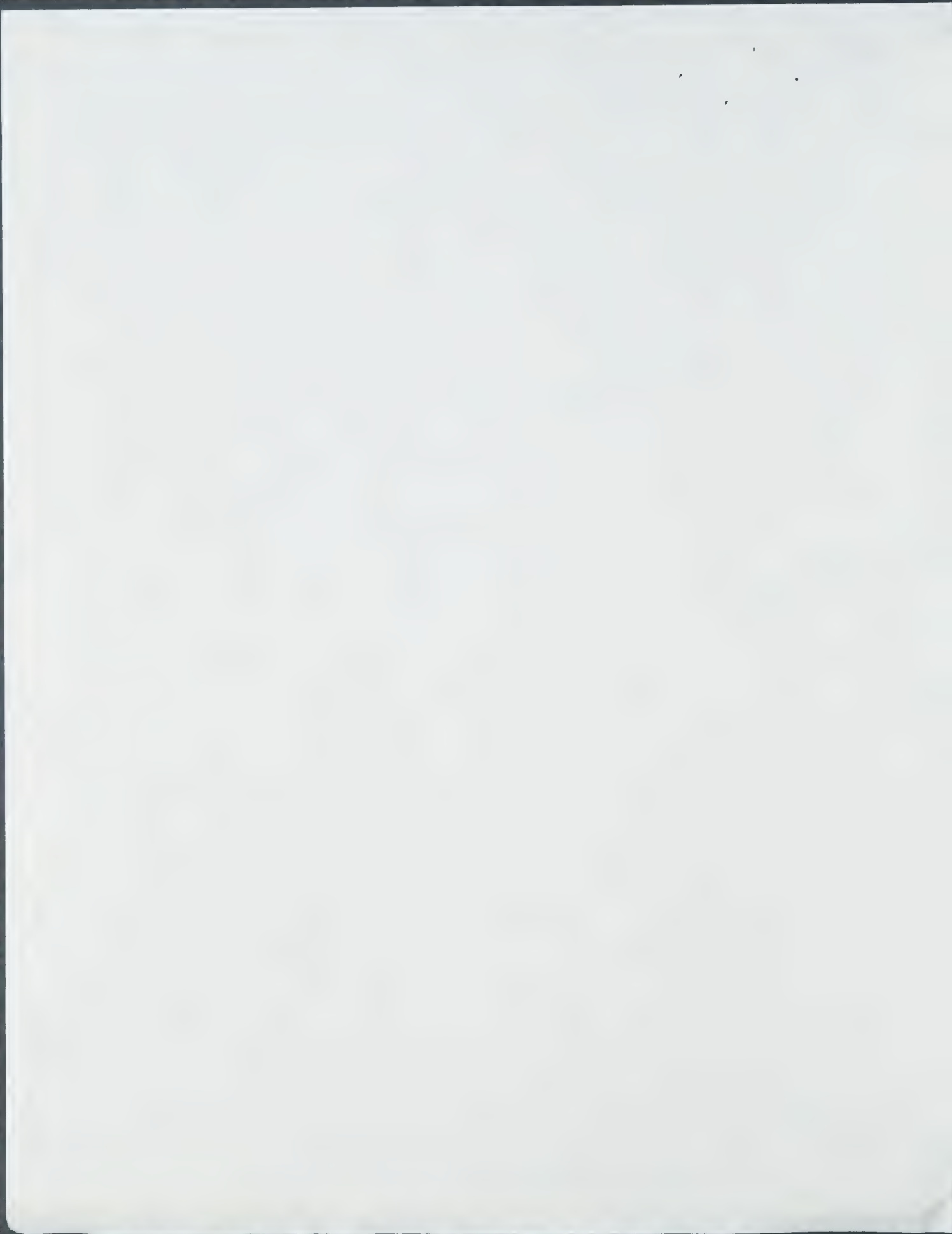

trying again

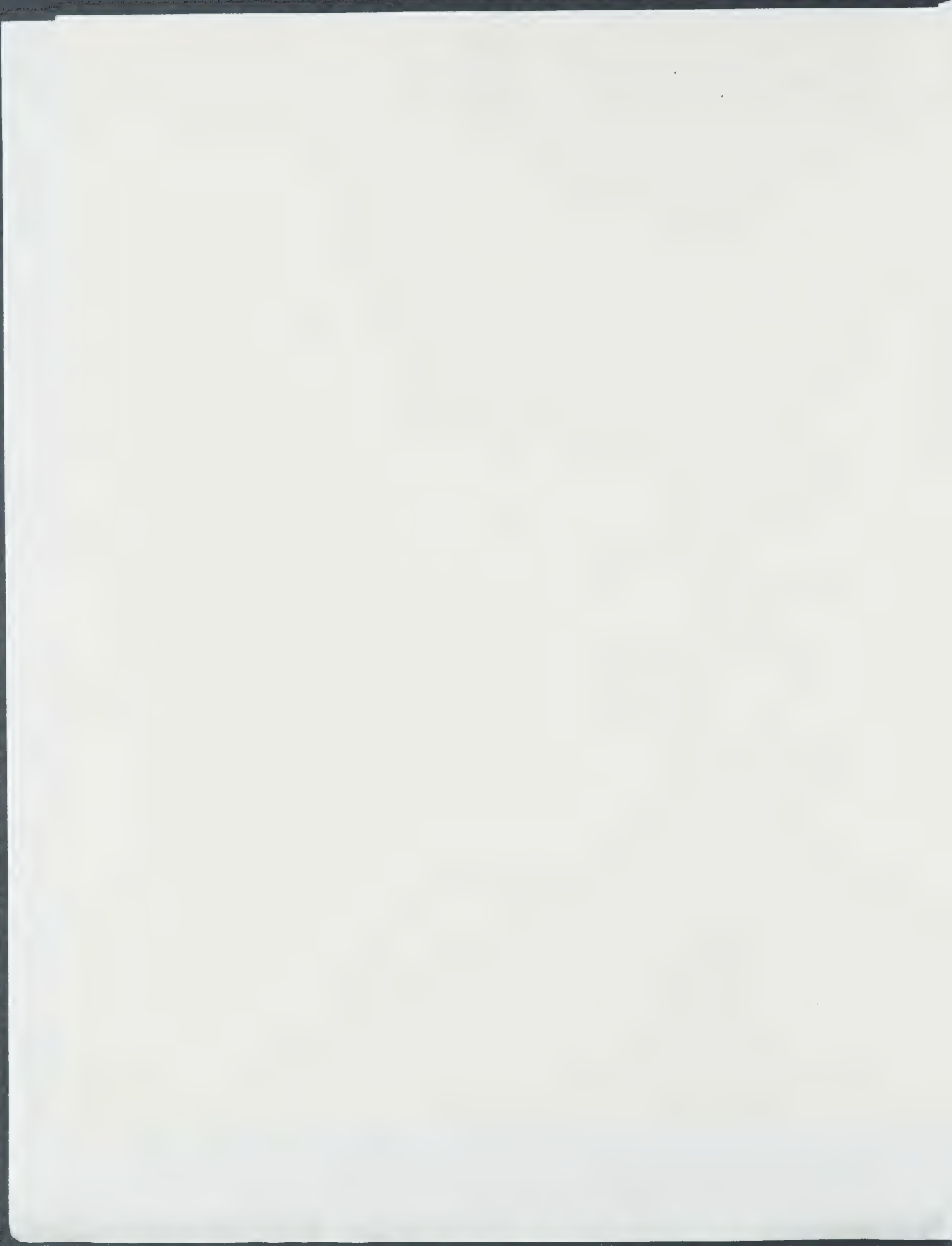

Dear Mrs. Flint,

I was happy to learn from Ann that you visited the gallery and are interested in some of our paintings. Then I was astounded – and now concerned – that you are considering the Flemish tryptic.

Concerned, because it is a cradled panel, and you should not keep it unless your house is humidified in the winter. In an unhumidified house in Milwaukee, humidity drops to 20 in the winter, and that causes paint films on cradled panels to blister.

We try to keep humidity above 40 and have never experienced blister problems. Other paintings I have sold you are on canvas, and present no problems.

Dear Ann,

Thanks for last night's fax, the first pages of which we received before we ran out of paper. We receive enormously long faxes from all and sundry.

I wonder Ann, if you could possibly change your schedule of hours in the office so that Alfred can keep in closer touch with you & affairs in Milwaukee.

As you know he works best in the mornings and gets in early in Milwaukee, but he also needs the 2-3 hours of business time left in England and on the continent.

By 10am the working day in Europe is over & by 11am it's finished in Britain.

So here he starts in his study shortly after 8 and works till 1 or 2, but of course that is 2am - 8am in Milwaukee so he can't speak to you. This is a real difficulty. It would be really so much better if he could contact you during the afternoon in Milwaukee.

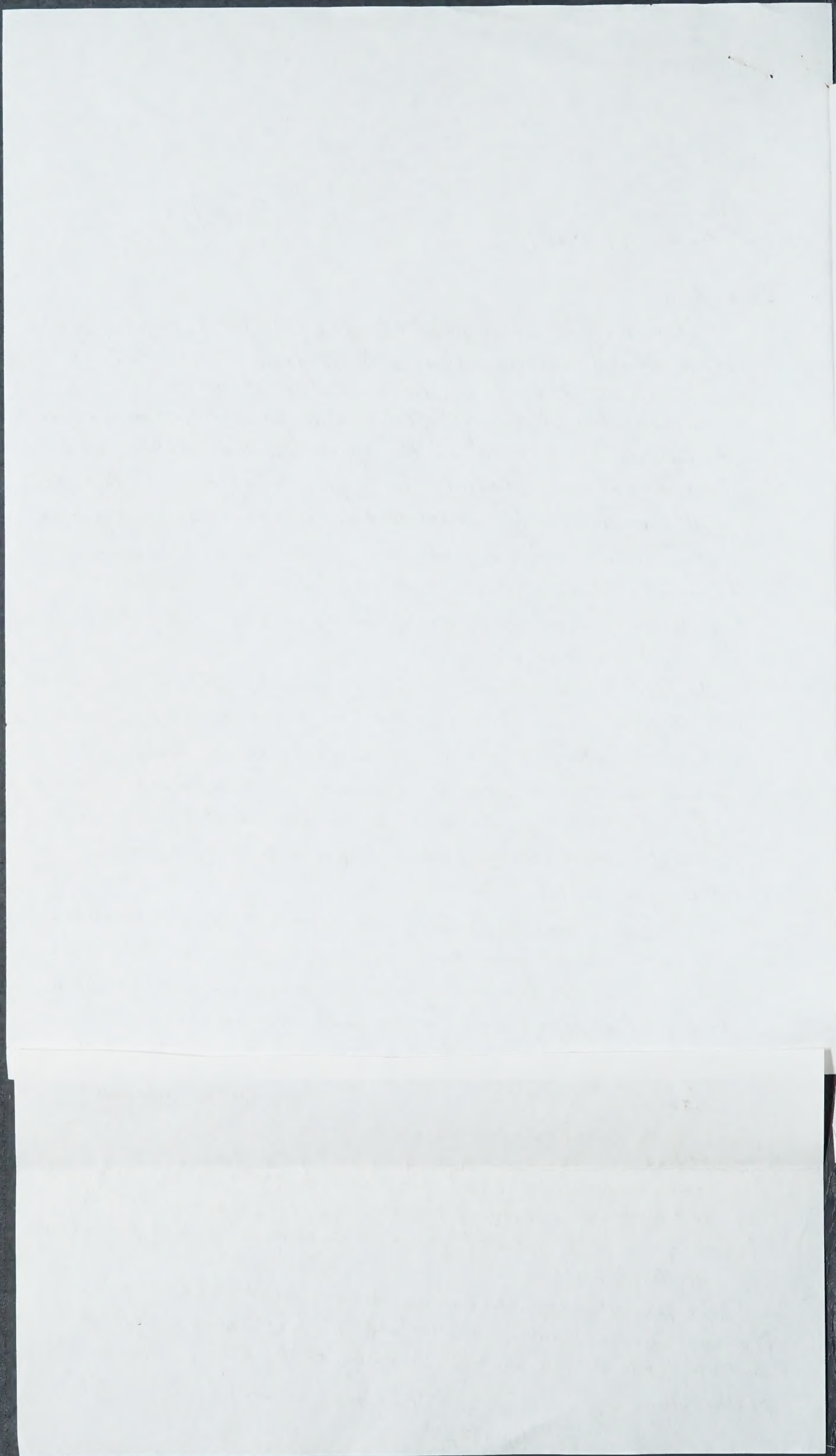
In your latest fax you say you will call at 3pm today, but Alfred asked if you could call at 4. He cannot be back by 9pm our time and he does want to speak to you.
