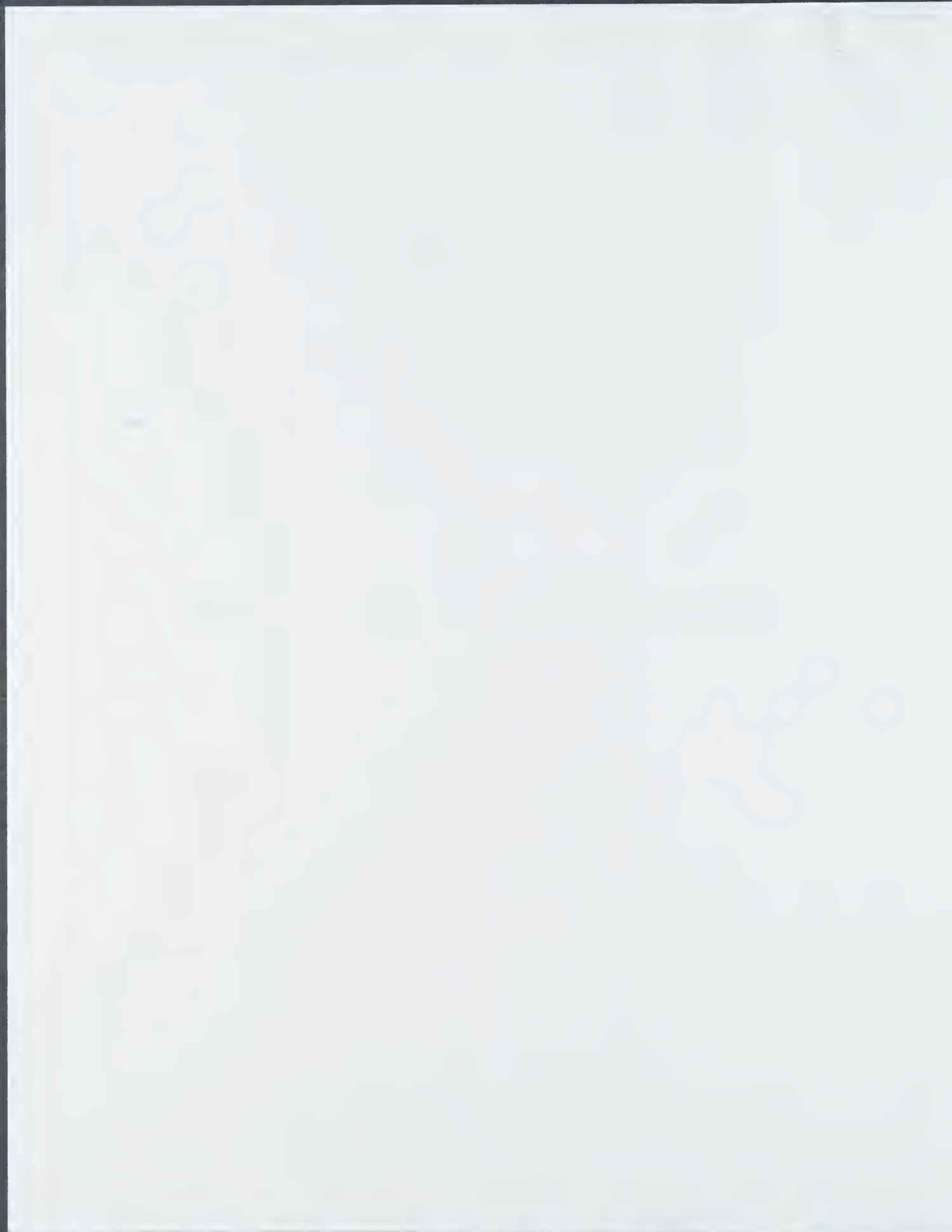
May I suggest 12:00, meeting at the hotel. Probably you will know some comfortable restaurant nearby.

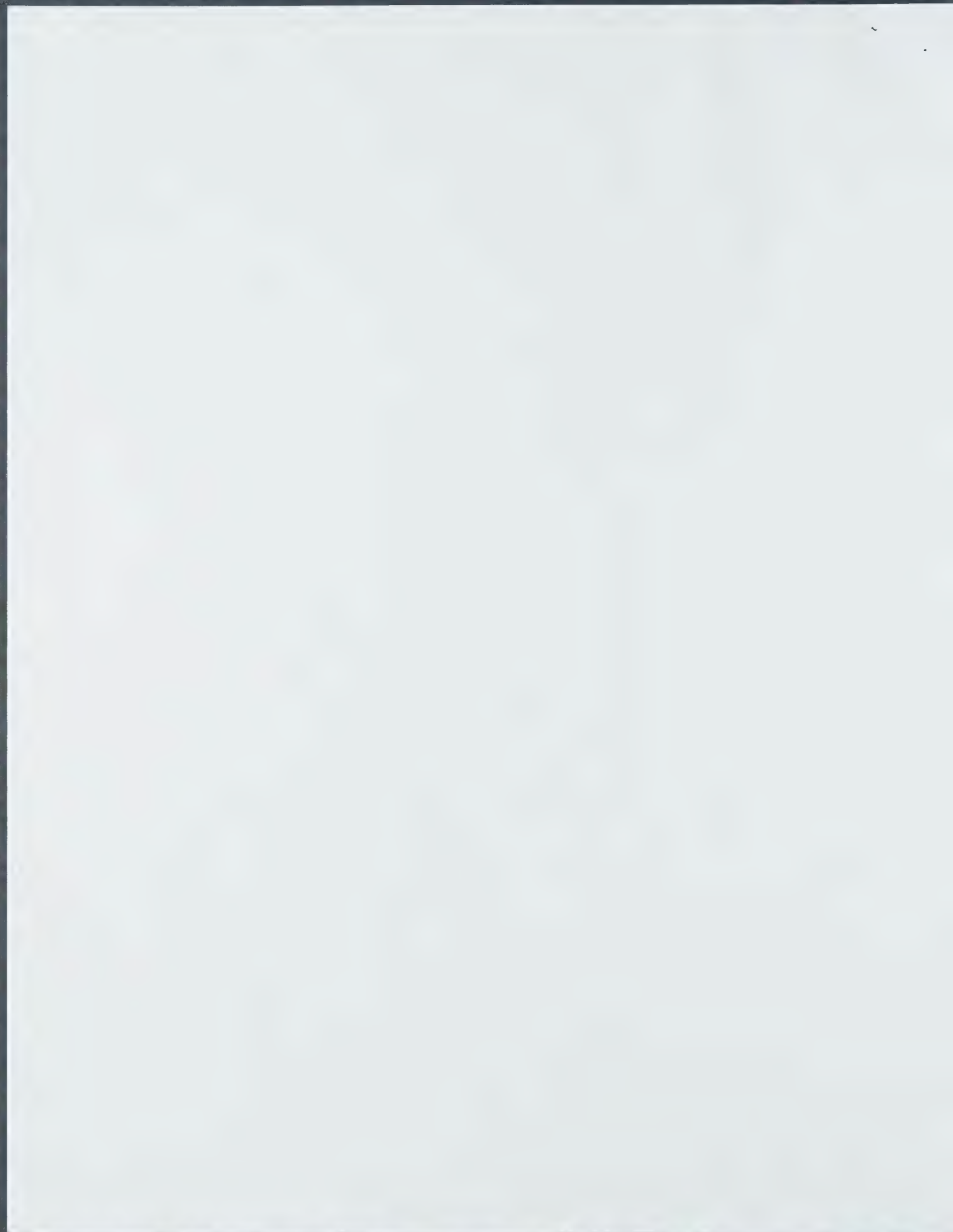
We come to Vienna once a year and look forward to being there again next June. It would be great if we could meet again.

Sehr geehrter Herr Dr. Bader,

vielen Dank für Ihre Schreiben. Wir haben mittlerweile intern über eine mögliche Neuaufstellung zusammen mit Sigma bzw. Ausgliederungen von Sigma unsere Entscheidungen gefällt. Eine Entscheidung ist uns allerdings mittlerweile nahezu abgenommen worden, denn der Diagnostikteil wird ja wohl nun an einen anderen Kandidaten verkauft.


Nichtsdestotrotz hätten wir wahrscheinlich auf eine Akquisition von Sigma Diagnostik verzichtet, da unsere firmeninterne Ausrichtung sehr stark hätte geändert werden müssen, um diesen Konzernteil zu integrieren. Das wäre auch gegenüber unseren Investoren schwer erläuterbar.

Ein wesentlich größeres Interesse hätten wir jedoch an dem Teil von Sigma, der Genesys heißt und der nahezu perfekt zu unserem Unternehmensteil peqlab GmbH passen würde. Beide Unternehmen sind biochemische und molekularbiologische Zulieferer und Händler und könnten sich in sehr guter Weise ergänzen und unterstützen.

Sollte sich aus Ihrer Sicht also eine Möglichkeit ergeben, Gespräche zu initiieren bzw. mir zu signalisieren, ob generell ein Interesse an einer Zusammenarbeit bzw. an einer Übernahme besteht, so wäre ich Ihnen sehr dankbar.

Ich möchte mich noch einmal ausdrücklich für Ihre Bemühungen bedanken und völlig unabhängig davon auch für das sehr angenehme Treffen mit Ihnen und Herrn Noe in Österreich. Vielleicht lässt sich ein derartiges Treffen ja bei Gelegenheit wiederholen.

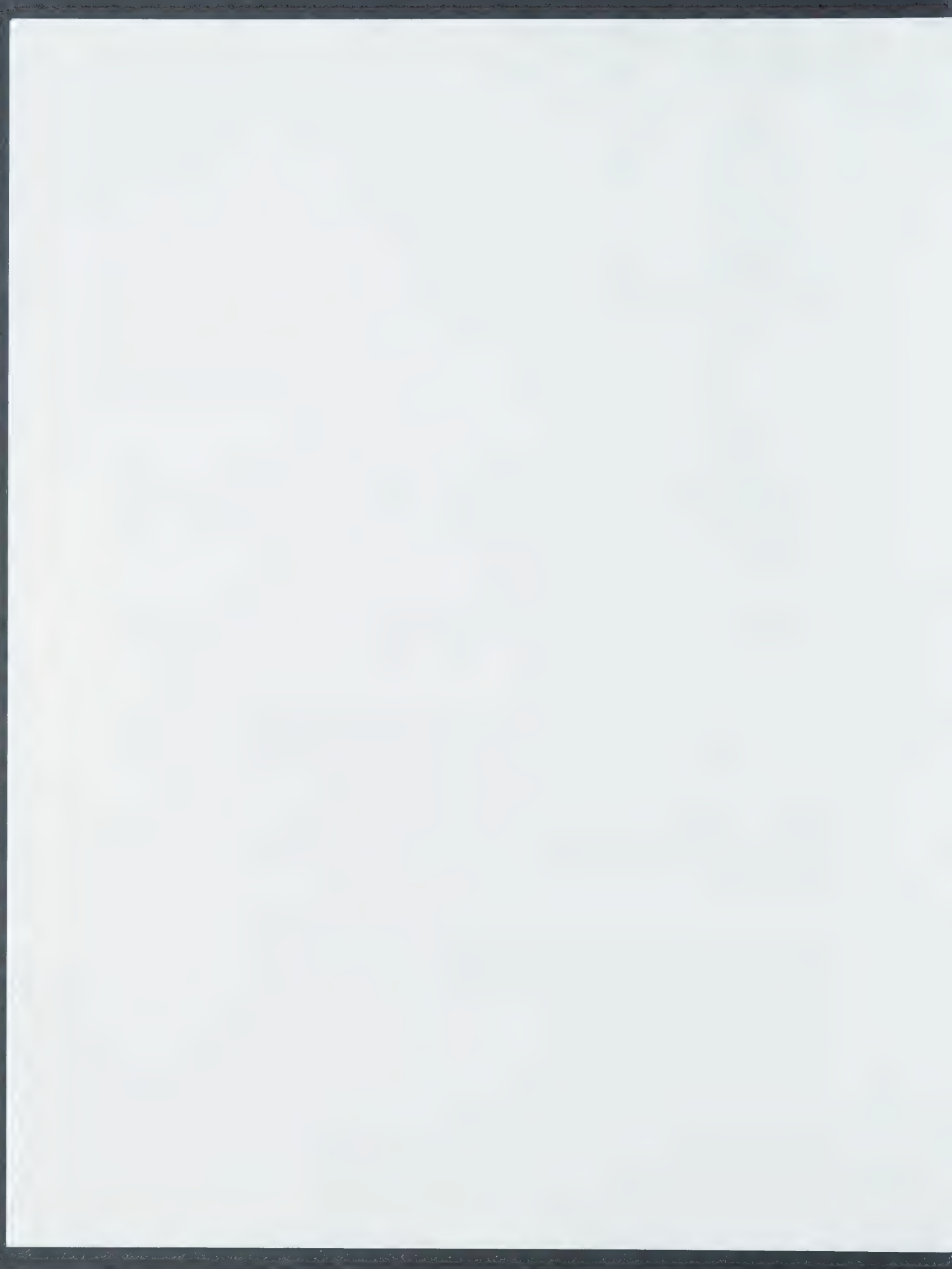

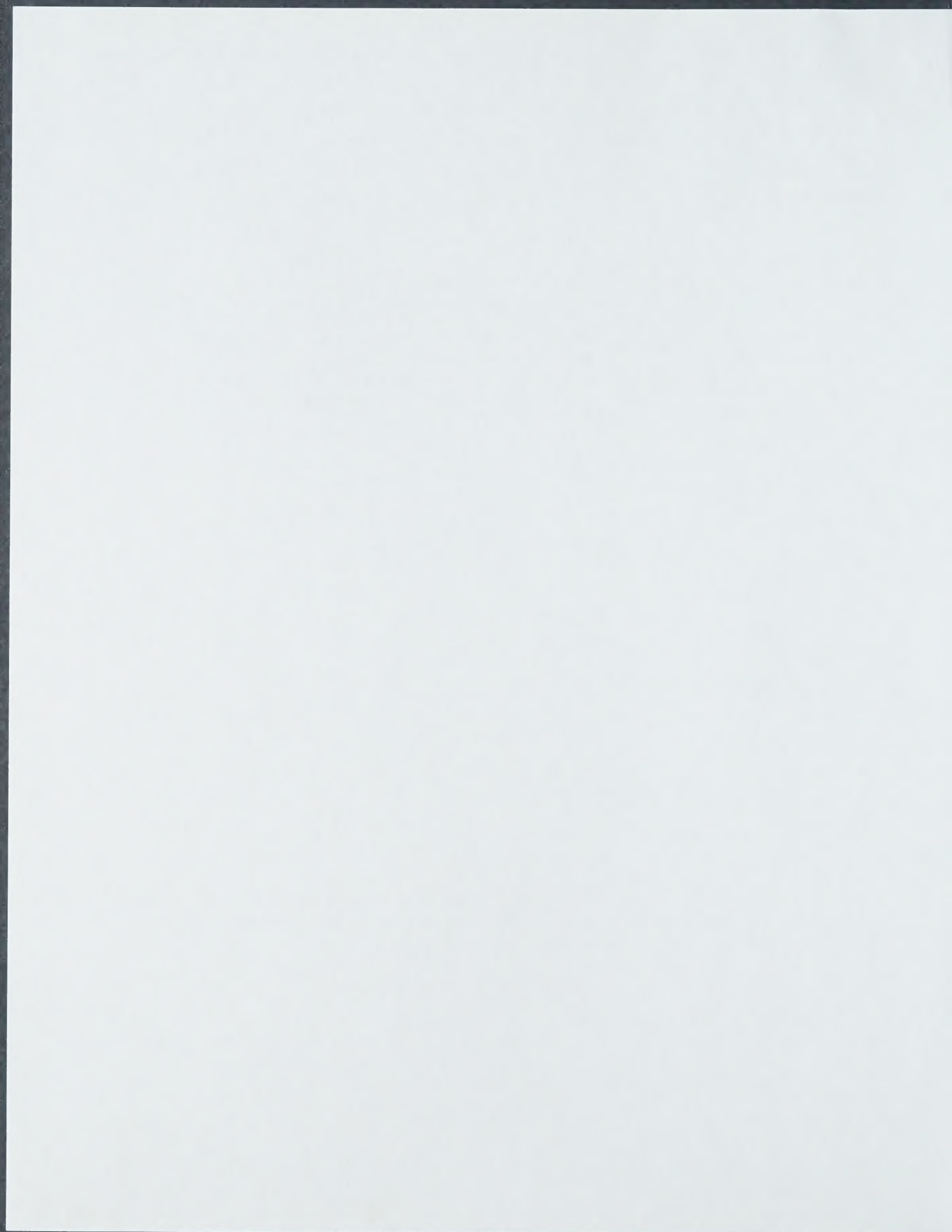
